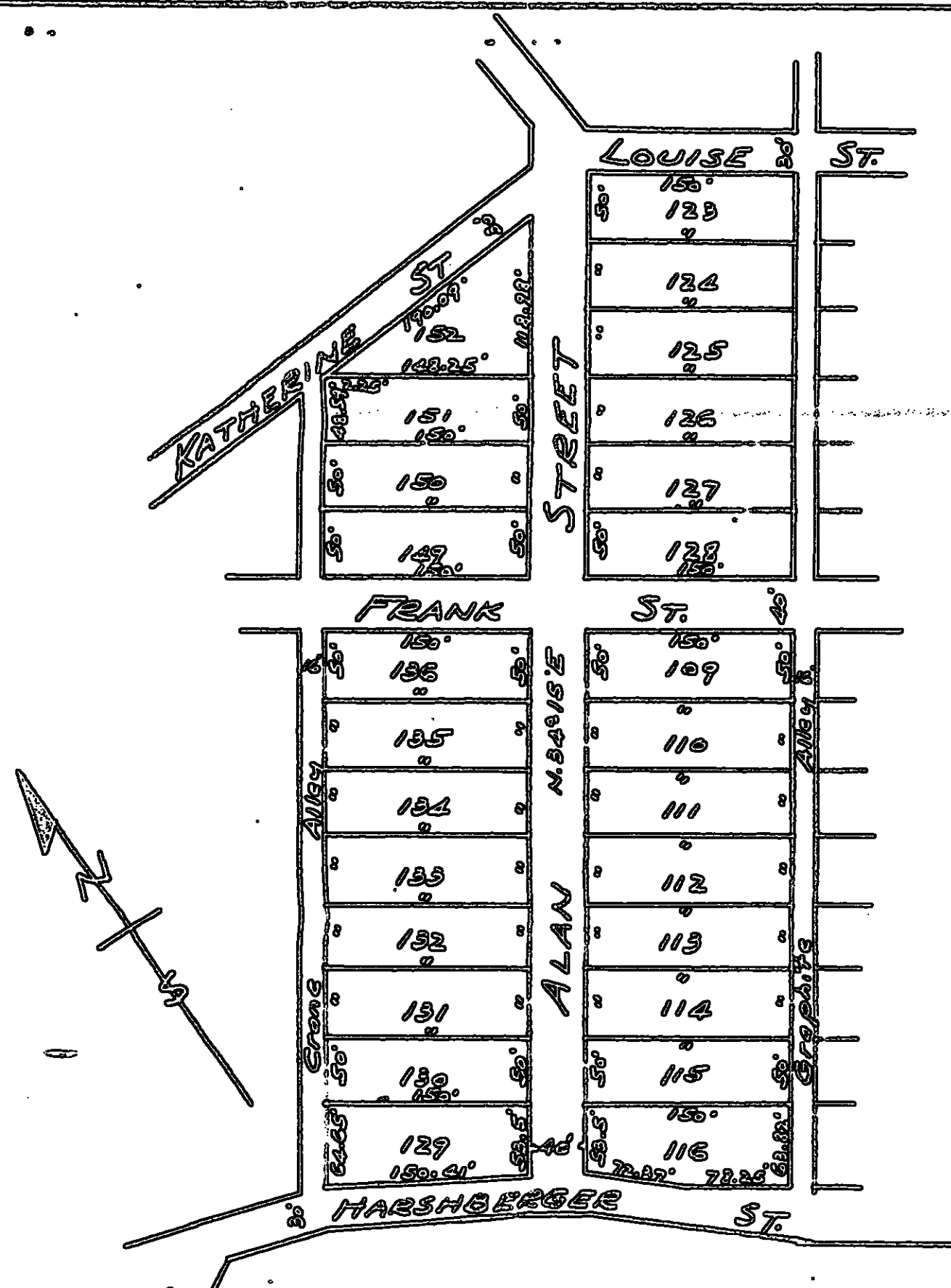

RESOLUTION

ACCEPTING ALAN STREET, A DEDICATED
HIGHWAY, AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN
UPPER YODER TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the Board of Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania requesting the acceptance of Alan Street on the Plan of Elim, in Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and duly recorded on the 21st day of February, 1910, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cambria County, in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 80; said Petition and Plan showing location of said Alan Street being hereto attached; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township to accept said highway in accordance with the Act of General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of May 21, 1943, P.L. 590 (53 P.S. 19093-1147), providing for the acceptance of dedicated roads, streets, lanes and alleys theretofore dedicated as public highways.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same that Alan Street, a dedicated highway forty (40') feet in width, as shown by print hereto attached and made part hereof, shall be and the same hereby is accepted as a public highway and as part of the road system of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and that a proper Petition shall be prepared and presented to said Court.
