REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,
we, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the
Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respectfully
report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of
the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the
records of the Court; that having given due public notice of the
time and place of meeting, by posting notices as required by law
along the route and at the termini of the said proposed new road,
as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto attached and by ser-
vice of said notice upon the Commissioners of Cambria County, the
Supervisors of Adams Township, and the Solicitor of Adams Town-
ship, evidence of which is shown by copies of said notices
hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met in
accordance with the notice given on the Twenty-eighth (28th) of
October, A. D., 1944, at 10:30 o'clock A. M., and proceeded with
the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route
of the proposed new road; that during the view several residents
and the Supervisors of Adams Township and all three Viewers were
present; that the proposed new road is now temporarily opened as
a private road and adjoins a plan of lots upon which six houses
are built and occupied; the location of which is shown in green
on the blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof; that
one of the terminus of said proposed road is at a point other
than in a public highway or place of public resort; that after
hearing all interested persons present at the view and the

Supervisors of Adams Township, we find that there is no objections to said proposed new road and having determined that said road is necessary, we proceeded to layout same as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Adams Township Road #316, a public highway in said township, said point being in a southerly direction a distance of 90 feet from the center of the bridge over Sandy Run; thence by the center line of the proposed new road N. $71^{\circ}57'$ E., 90 feet to a point $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet westwardly of the line of lots abutting on said proposed new road; thence by same and $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet westwardly therefrom N. 16° E., 74.5 feet; thence N. 34° E., 81.91 feet; thence N. 43° E., 81.73 feet; thence N. 46° E., 255 feet to the place of ending in line of land of Liberty Park. The total length of said proposed new road being 583.14 feet. The exact location of the place of beginning from the nearest intersecting public highway; namely, State Highway Route #53 leading from Johnstown to South Fork is at a distance of 1570 feet measured along the center line of Adams Township Road #316 in a southwestwardly direction from the intersection of said Route #316 with the center line of State Highway Route #53. The exact location of the place of ending is at a distance of 583.14 feet measured along the center line of the proposed new road from the place of beginning; that the six houses abutting on the proposed new highway belong to individual owners; that after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that said road as prayed for by the petitioners and laid out by us is necessary and convenient for the several property owners and houses erected thereon and that same will not be burdensome to the taxpayers of Adams Township. Therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

We have secured a Release of Damages, which is hereto attached and made a part of this report, signed by most of the abutting property owners, however, regardless of said Release of Damages, we assess no benefits and no damages to any of the abutting property owners.

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired, be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."


