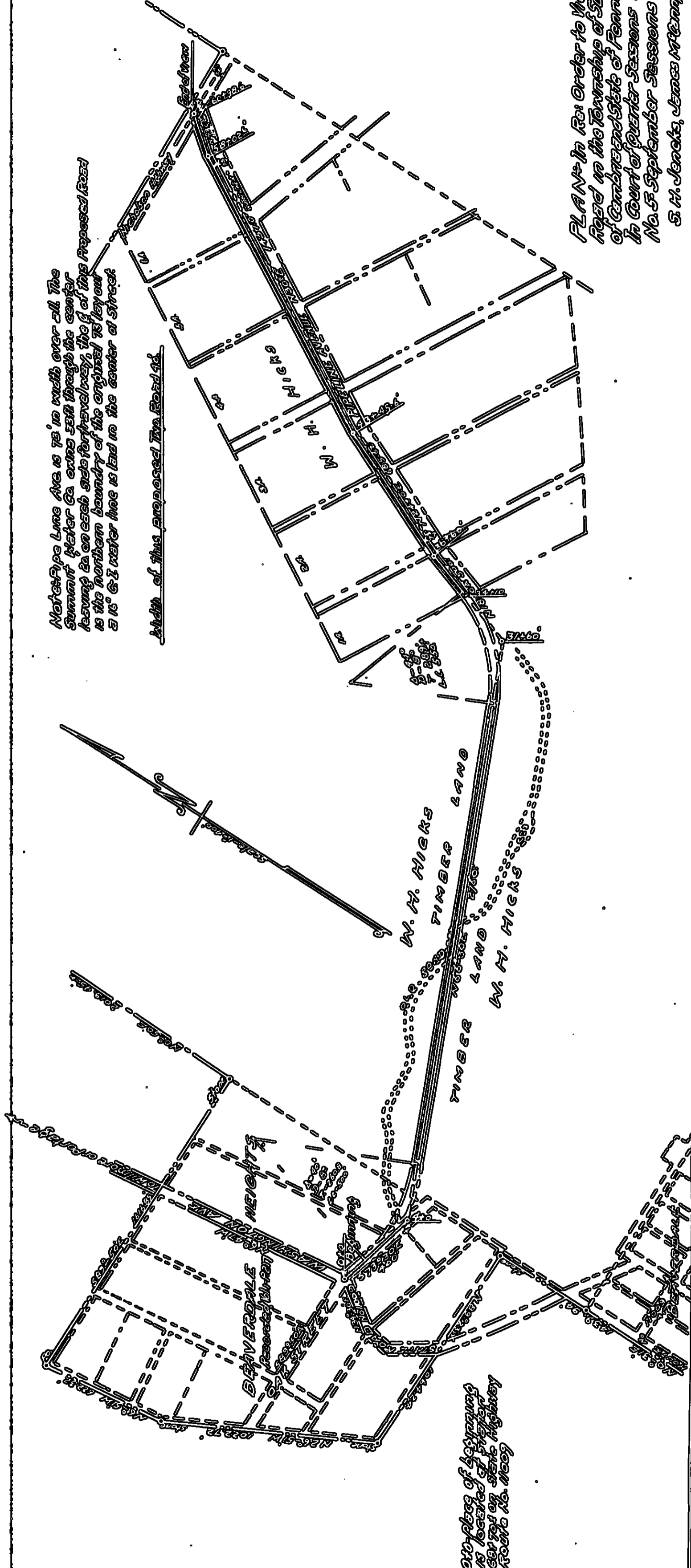

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court and directed to view the premises to determine as to the necessity for a public highway as prayed for by the Petitioners, beginning at a point at the junction of State Highway Route No. 160, also known as Washington Avenue, on Plan of Beaverdale Heights, and Oak Street on said plan, which plan is of record in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 217, and ending at a point approximately five hundred (500) in an easterly direction from the front of the residence of on Vernon Markel in said Township.

That having given due notice of the view and the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of said County, to the Supervisors of Summerhill Township, and to the public by printed hand bills posted at and in the immediate vicinity of the premises to be viewed for the proposed public highway, as is required by the Act of the General Assembly.

We met upon the premises in Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Penna., on ~~SATURDAY~~ January 4, 1945, at 9:30 o'clock a. m. to perform the duties of our appointment, together with the said Supervisors, none of the Petitioners being present.

The Viewers having agreed that there is occasion for a public road, on February 17th, 1945, laid out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for the road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners.

The courses and distances of the road as laid out, and as shown on the map attached hereto, are as follows: Beginning at Beaverdale Heights at the junction of Oak Street and Washington Avenue, the point of intersection being station 68 plus 70 on State Road No. 11009, thence South 73 degrees 30 minutes East for 400 feet; thence North 66 degrees 30 minutes East for 2,760 feet; thence North 18 degrees East for 500 feet; thence North 24 degrees East for 685.62 feet; thence North 30 degrees East 1,457 feet; thence North 41 degrees East for 296 feet to a point in Nicholson Highway, the place of ending. The total distance being 6,098.6 feet. From station 34 plus 10 to station 60 plus 98.6, the end of the proposed road, the line follows Pipe line Avenue as laid out by W. H. Hicks in his plat of lots, as shown by draft hereto attached and made a part hereof. As noted on said draft: Pipe Line Avenue is 73 feet in width over all. The Summit Water Company owns 33 feet through the center, leaving 20 feet on each side for travel way; the center line of the proposed road is the northern boundary of the original 73 feet width or layout. A 16 inch cast iron water line is laid in the center of the 73 ft. Avenue. Width of the proposed township road is 40 feet.

It will be noted that Washington Avenue is on the line of the highway running from Beaverdale to Wilmore or Fortage.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, and also H. Frank Dorr, Chief Clerk of the County Commissioners of Cambria County, were assured by members of the Board of Supervisors of Summerhill Township that release of damages have been acquired by the said Board of Supervisors from abutting property owners.

In compliance with our duties as viewers we have estimated and determined the benefits, agreeing there is occasion for a public road, with the understanding, however, that Summerhill Township be released from all claims for damages that may arise from opening of said road.

We have notified the parties interested that this report will be filed with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, the week of March 4th, 1945.
