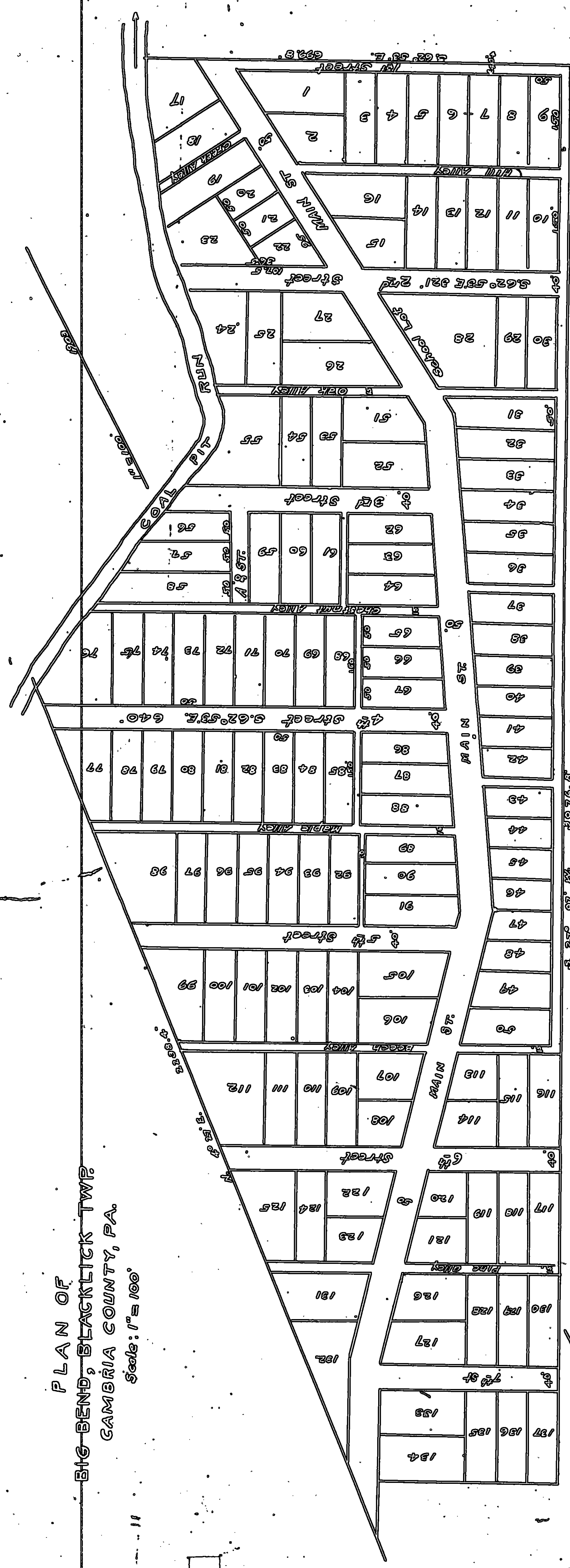

Order of Court to View and Lay Out a new public Road in Big Bend, Cambria County, Pennsylvania. In the Court of Quarter Sessions for Cambria County, State of Pennsylvania.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, For Cambria County, Pennsylvania, held at Ebensburg, held said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway to begin at a point at the intersection of Main Street and 4th. Street, said Main Street being otherwise known as Highway 45 a public highway and extending over and across 4th Street South 62" 53' East for a distance of 640 feet, all of which is shown in red on a map being the plan of Big Bend, in Blacklick Township in Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

The exact distance fro the point of beginning of the proposed new road from the intersection of Main Street is 640 feet, measured on the Centre line of said 4th. Street in a Southeasterly direction from said Main Street as shown.

The beginning of the said public road is a public highway and the ending of the proposed public Road is near Coal Pit Run.

After due consideration the Court appointed L. E. Kaylor, S. H. Jencks and Edward Dannegan as viewers to view the ground for the proposed road and after viewing the same they agree that there is occasion for such a road they shall lay out the same having as to the best location etc., and doing the least injury to adjacent property interests.

The viewers after carefully considering the apparent facts presented were of the opinion that there was need for the new road and they approved the application and granted the prayer of the petitioners.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 18th day of March A. D. 1946, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Blacklick, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public road or highway, to begin

at a point at the intersection of Main Street and 4th Street, said Main Street being otherwise known as State Highway Route 45, a public highway, and extending over and across 4th Street South 62°53' East for a distance of 640 feet, all of which is shown in red on a map being the Plan of Big Bend, Blacklick Township.

The exact distance from the point of beginning of proposed public road from the intersection of Main Street is 640 feet, measured along the center line of said 4th Street in a South-easterly direction from said Main Street, as shown.

The beginning of the proposed road is a public highway and the ending of the proposed road is near Coal Pit Run.

The Viewers acted on these three Court Orders while on the one trip, thus saving additional expense to the taxpayers. L. E. Kaylor.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

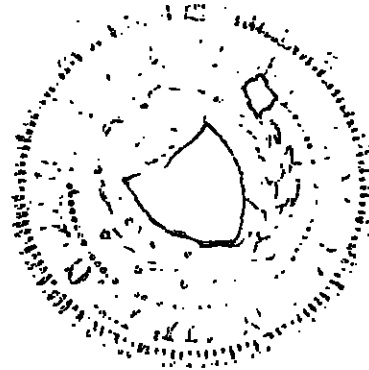

4th Street South 62° 53' East for a distance of 640 feet, all of which is shown  
in red on a map being the Plan of Big Bend, Blacklick Township, which map is  
hereto attached, made part of and marked "EXHIBIT A."

The exact distance from the point of beginning of proposed public road from  
the intersection of Main Street is 640 feet, measured along the center line of
