At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for Cambria County held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 13th. day of March, A. D. 1946, before the Honorable Judges of said Court:-

Upon petition of divers citizens of Blacklick Township, in Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Cambria County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public Road leading from the intersection of Cardiff Road and Park Avenue, said Cardiff Road being otherwise known and designated as Route 459, said Park Avenue being likewise a public highway, and extending over and across the centre line of said Park Avenue South 27° 30' West 390 feet. Also beginning at the aforesaid intersection of Cardiff Road and Park Avenue and extending over and across said Park Avenue 27° 30' East 275 feet.

The exact distance of the one portion of said park Avenue going Southwesterly is 390 feet and the exact distance of the other portion of the said road, known as Park Avenue, going Northeasterly for 275 feet..

The viewers were impressed that there is a need for the road and cooperating with the Supervisors and the petitioners granted the prayer of their petition and approved the new road as asked for.

Petition of the citizens for their new road granted April 15th., 1946, the day of the View.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE: It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure for the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

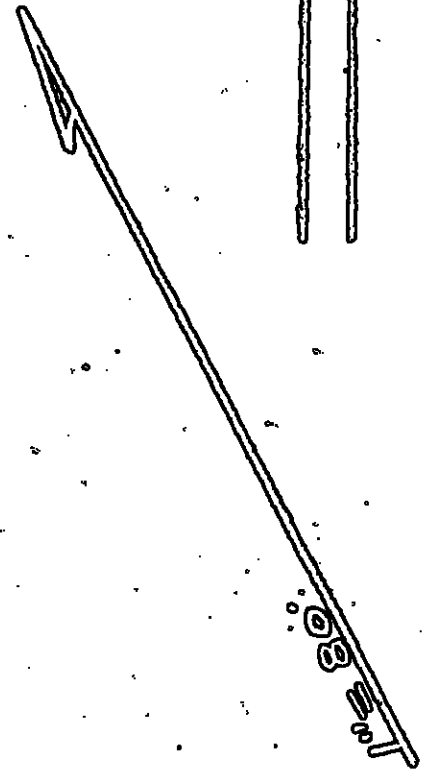
