TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The petition of Alphonse Kirsch,

A. R. Canis and Francis Arotin,

Supervisors of Barr Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania,
respectfully represents:

That on June 16, 1947, the Barnes & Tucker Company made a deed of dedication of certain streets and alleys for highway purposes to the Township of Barr, said deed being recorded in the office for the recording of deeds etc. in and for the County of Cambria in Deed Book Volume at page . That by virtue of said deed there were conveyed and dedicated to the said Township certain streets and alleys for highway purposes situate in the Village of Watkins, in said Township of Barr, said streets and alleys being hereinafter more fully described. That the Supervisors of the Township of Barr accept said deed of dedication in the name of the Township of Barr for highway purposes. That the said Village of Watkins is well populated and contains homes which were formerly owned by the coal company in said locality but are now privately owned. That the Supervisors of Barr Township are desirous of accepting said streets and alleys as public highways in accordance with Section 1 of the Amendatory Act of 1943, May 21, P. L. 590.

That attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" is a certified copy of the resolution of the Board of Supervisors of said Township of Barr, adopted by majority thereof by a vote duly recorded and entered upon the minutes of said Board, showing acceptance by the said Board of Supervisors as public highways the streets and alleys hereinafter described. resolution was adopted the 23rd day of July, 1947.
