REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,
we, the undersigned Viewers appointed by the attached order of the
Court to view a proposed new public road in Upper Yoder Township,
Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully report as follows:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the
Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as
shown by the records of the Court; that due public notice of the
time and place of meeting was given by posting notices as re-
quired by law, along the route and at the termini of the pro-
posed road as shown by copies of said notices hereto attached
and made a part of this report and by notices given to the
Cambria County Commissioners, service being accepted by the
Chief Clerk and also notices being served on the Supervisors of
Upper Yoder Township, Service being accepted by their Solicitor
Frank P. Barnhart. Copies of all of these notices being hereto
attached and made a part of this report. All of said notices
setting the time, the place and the purpose of said View. That
we met in accordance with the notices given and at the time
and place designated and proceeded with the duties of our
appointment. There were present the three Viewers and a few
interested citizens. The Supervisors were ^{not} present but ex-
pressed their approval of the proposed road at a previous date.
We viewed the proposed road, part of which is already in use
as a private road. A number of houses are already built along
the route of the proposed road. After careful consideration we
have decided that the road as proposed, is necessary and will
serve a number of residents and also the public at large. The
proposed road is bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at the intersection of said proposed road, known as Edith Street, with the center line of Penn Street, a public highway; thence S.81° 30'E., 1729.76' to the intersection of Alan Street a public highway, said beginning being N.18° 0'E., 516.12' along Penn Street from Harshberger Road, the nearest public highway. Said place of ending being N.4° 30'W., 108' along Alan Street from Louise Street ~~at~~ the nearest public highway.

There is also hereto attached and made a part of this report, a plan or map of the proposed road, on which courses and distances more fully appear.

The three Viewers, the Supervisors and all citizens whom we contacted were agreed as to the necessity for the proposed road. We are also agreed that there are no damages or benefits accruing to any person or persons by reason of the building of the road. This applies to all owners of adjoining land and land adjacent thereto. We are advised that all adjoining owners have signed an agreement waiving all claims for damages.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
