The petition of Joseph B. Valko, Charles Bender and

1. That they are the duly elected, qualified and active supervisors of Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
2. That by a plan approved by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on the 25th day of July, 1946, a portion of State Highway Route 11002 located in the Township of Adams, County of Cambria, State of Pennsylvania, was abandoned as part of the State Highway system, said portion abandoned being eight-hundred eighteen feet in length.
3. That said State Highway Route 11002 was relocated by the construction of a new portion of highway sevenhundred-fifty feet in length. A map showing the portion of State Highway abandoned and the part of new highway constructed is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A.", and made a part of this petition.
4. That attached hereto and made a part of this petition is the written consent of all owners of real estate affected by the proposed vacation of the portion abandoned State Highway Route 11002.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court to approve the vacation of the portion of State Highway Route 11002 abandoned, as shown on the map attached hereto and to approve the new location of State Highway Route 11002 as shown on said map.

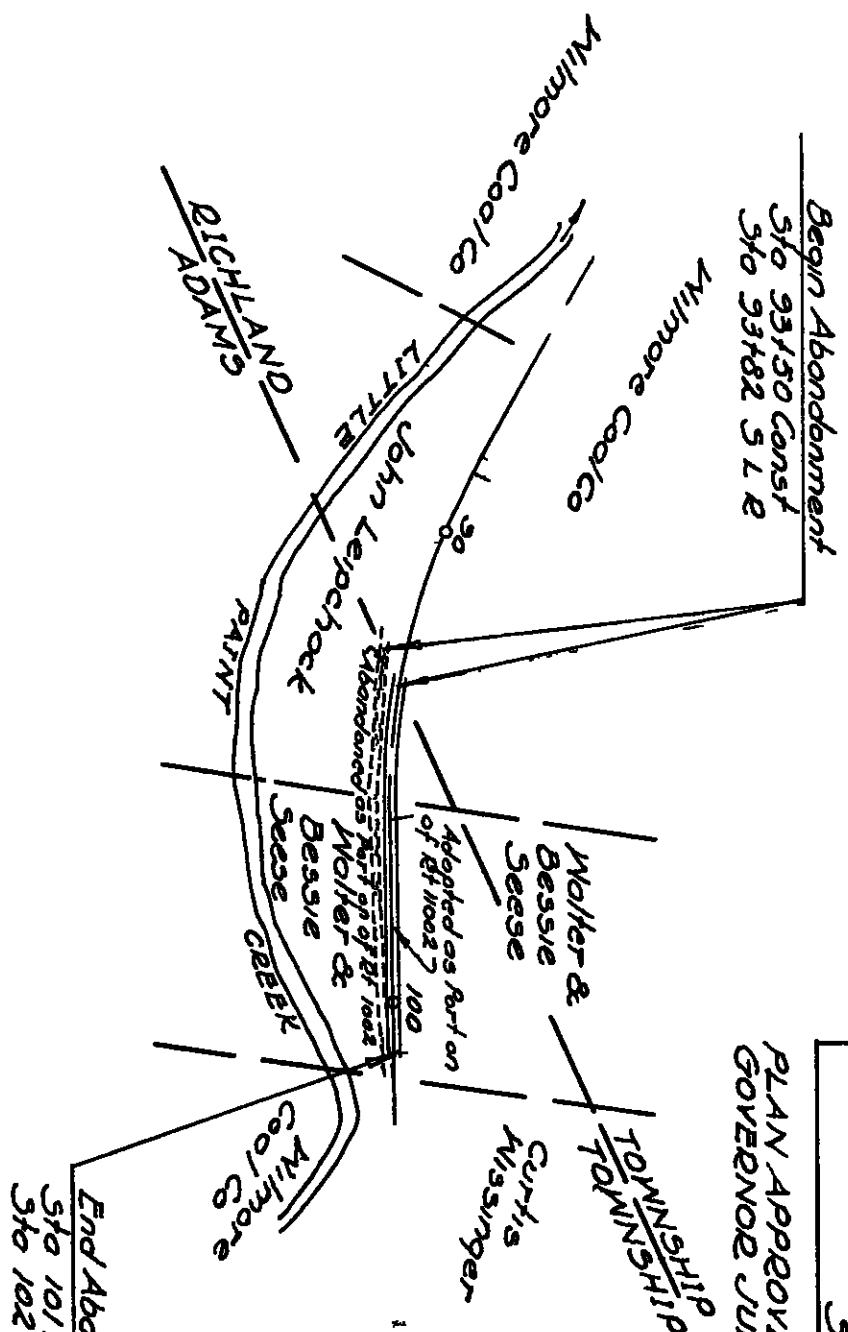
