REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the above named Court to view the premises of Louis H. Crosser in the Village of Salix, Township of Adams, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to estimate and determine the damages that have resulted, or may seem likely to result, by reason of the relocation of State Highway Route through land of your Petitioner, respectfully report as follows:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown by the records of the Court. That due public notice has been given of the time and place of meeting by posting notices on the premises affected and at points adjacent thereto and by serving notices personally on Louis H. Crosser, owner of land, and by service on the Commissioners of Cambria County, evidence of which service is shown by copies of notices hereto attached, all of which notices set forth the time, place and purpose of said meeting.

That in accordance with the notices given we met on the premises and proceeded with the duties of our appointment. There were present at the View, the three Viewers, Louis H. Crosser and a number of other interested parties. The Viewers, accompanied by several of the others, carefully viewed the premises and ascertained the amount of land taken. They then adjourned to meet again at the Court House at Ebensburg, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of taking testimony from any witnesses who might appear. In accordance with this we met again at the Court House on Monday, October 20th, 1941, at 9:30 A. M. and proceeded with the taking of testimony. The witnesses were Josiah Jones, Louis H. Crosser and Attorney Clarence E. Davis, represented the Petitioner. Josiah Jones testified that the value of the property, immediately before the exercise of the right of Eminent Domain and unaffected by it, at \$1100.00; after the exercise of the right of Eminent Domain and as affected by it at no value. Louis H. Crosser testified that the value of the property before the exercise of the right of Eminent Domain, and as unaffected by it, at \$2900.00, and after the exercise of the right of Eminent Domain and as affected by it, at no value.

The meeting then adjourned and the Viewers continued in session to consider the testimony and arrive at a decision.

A meeting for the purpose of exhibiting a schedule of damages, hearing of further testimony and noting any exceptions taken to the award was called for October 28th, 1941, in the Court House at Ebensburg, at 9:30 o'clock A. M.

In accordance with this arrangement we met on the day and date above given. There were present the three Viewers and the two witnesses who were present at the previous meeting. The schedule of damages was then read by Chairman McCann, of the Board of View, and those present were asked if they had any further testimony to offer or exceptions to take to the award. Considerable discussion of the award took place but no further testimony was offered and the meeting was adjourned. Cambria County was not represented.

The Board of View gave careful consideration to all the evidence presented before finally reaching their decision which was:

VIEWERS

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter-Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass: and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."



That your petitioner and the Commissioners of Cambria County have endeavored to agree on the amount of damages sustained, but they are unable to arrive at an amicable settlement thereof.






Now, September 27, 1941, the within petition presented, read and considered, the Court does thereupon appoint  and , members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as viewers to view and examine the premises in the within petition described, and for the purpose of ascertaining the damages, if any, sustained by the petitioner, and make return of their proceedings according to law.
