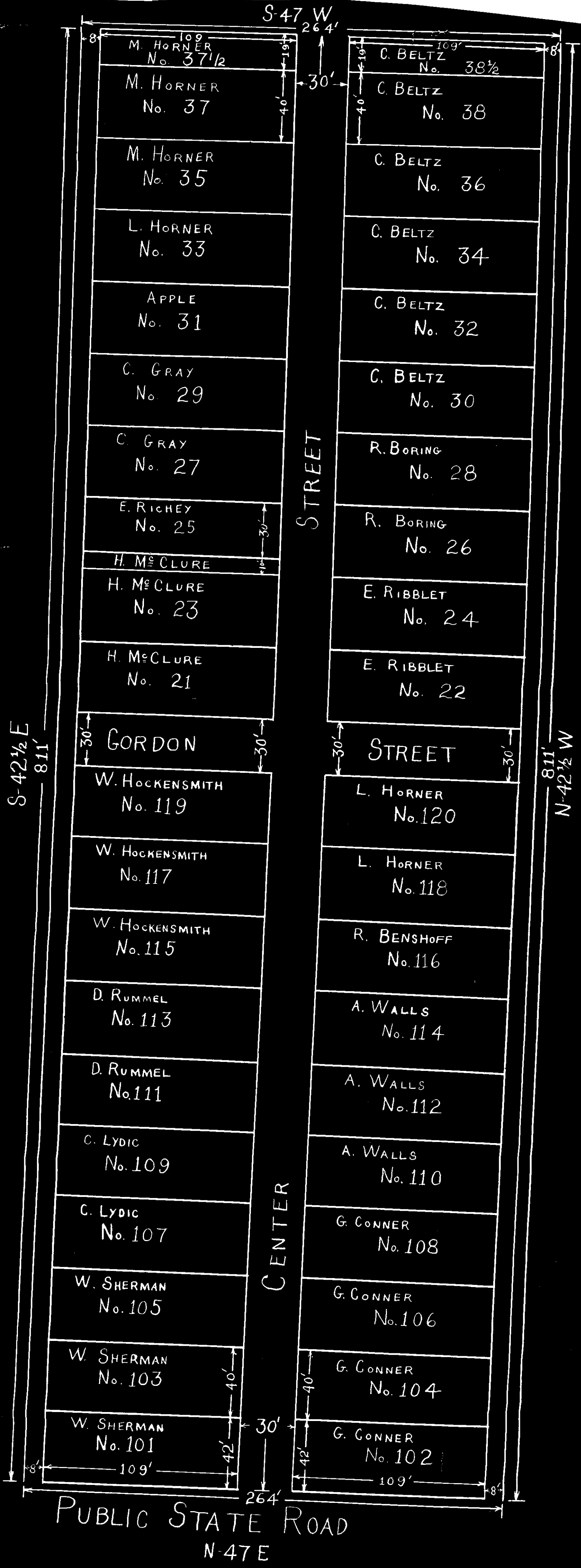

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of the Supervisors  
of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, respectfully represent:

FIRST

That residents and citizens of  
West Taylor Township living along Center Street have petitioned  
the Supervisors of West Taylor Township to adopt, take over and  
maintain the said Center Street, and,

SECOND

That the said Center Street has  
been laid out and dedicated to public use for many years by the  
original Grantor and adjoining property owners, but the West  
Taylor Township Supervisors have never formerly adopted the same  
as a Township Road.

THIRD

That the said Center Street intersects with the State Highway leading from Johnstown to the William Penn Highway, between the Lot No. 101 of W. Sherman and Lot No. 102 G. Conner. Said Center Street runs in a direction North  $42\frac{1}{2}$  degrees West 811 feet from the said State Highway, known as Route No. 11020, to the northern most property line of land owned by M. Horner and C. Beltz. That said Center Street is 30 feet wide between property lines.

FOURTH

That the Supervisors of West Taylor Township are desirous of adopting the said Center Street as a Township Highway, so as to serve and meet the needs of the citizens of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

FIFTH

The said Supervisors of West Taylor Township have passed a Resolution, adopting said Center Street as a Township Road and authorizing this Petition asking your Honorable Court's approval, a certified copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof, as well as a blue print of the said Center Street and release of the adjoining property owners.

Therefore, your Petitioners pray,  
your Honorable Court, to approve the said adoption of the said  
Center Street as a Township Highway, leading from the State  
Highway Route No. 11020 from Johnstown to the William Penn  
Highway and running North  $42\frac{1}{2}$  degrees West 811 feet. The said  
Center Street to be 30 feet in width between property lines,  
and they will forever pray.

D E C R E E

NOW, this 6<sup>th</sup> day of October  
1941, the foregoing Petition having been read and duly  
considered, and it appearing to the Court that the Supervisors  
of West Taylor Township are desirous of adopting said Center  
Street as a Township Road, and it being for the best interests  
of the residents of West Taylor Township to have the said  
Center Street adopted as a Township Road.

It is therefore ordered and  
decreed that the adoption as a Township Road of the said Center  
Street intersecting with State Highway Route No. 11020 between  
the property of W. Sherman, Lot No. 101 and property of G.  
Conner, Lot No. 102 and extending therefrom, North  $42\frac{1}{2}$  degrees  
30 feet wide, a distance of 811 feet, all as shown on the blue  
print hereto annexed, is approved and the said road is hereby  
a Township Road and a part of the roads of West Taylor Township  
and under the care and responsibility of the Supervisors of  
said West Taylor Township.

WHEREAS, the residents of West Taylor Township residing along Center Street which intersects State Highway Route No. 11020, between the property lines of W. Sherman, Lot No. 101 and G. Conner Lot No. 102 and continues North  $42\frac{1}{2}$  degrees for a distance of 811 feet, have petitioned the Supervisors of West Taylor Township to adopt said Center Street as a Township Road, and,

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of West Taylor Township are desirous of complying with the petition of said residents by adopting said Center Street as a Township Road so that the residents of West Taylor Township will not suffer any inconvenience or hardships.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the said Center Street beginning at State Highway Route No. 11020 in West Taylor Township between the property line of W. Sherman, Lot No. 101 and G. Conner, Lot No. 102, and continuing North  $42\frac{1}{2}$  degrees for a distance of 811 feet, be and is hereby adopted as a Township Road by the West Taylor Township Supervisors and the President and the Secretary of the said Board of

Supervisors of West Taylor Township are hereby authorized and empowered to sign or execute any papers or documents and to initiate or complete any action necessary to effect said adoption.
