REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the above named Court, to view and determine whether a portion of public road in Lower Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, known as the Mountain Road, should be vacated and abandoned because of disuse and if properly maintained being burdensome to the tax payers, respectfully report as follows:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown by the records of the Court. That due public notice has been given of the time, place and purpose of such meeting by posting notices at the Termini of the portion of road to be vacated, along the route and at points adjacent thereto, copies of said notices being hereto attached and made a part of this report, and by service on the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Lower Yoder Township, copies of said notices being hereto attached and also made a part of this report, all of which notices set forth the time, place and purpose of the meeting.

Said portion of Road proposed to be vacated is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in said Mountain Road at the intersection of the Lane leading to the Joseph Long House, said point being in a Southerly direction 1563.6' measured along the center line of a portion of the old Mountain Road heretofore vacated from the corner of the Joseph Long Tract in line of the John St. Clair Tract in the center of the old Mountain Road; thence by the center of said portion of Road to be vacated,

Blue Prints are hereto attached and made a part of this report setting forth in more detail the description of the portion of road to be vacated. That in accordance with the notices given we met at the place of beginning and proceeded with the duties of our appointment. There were present at the View, the three Viewers, the Township Engineer and one of the Supervisors of the Township. We viewed the portion of the road to be vacated and found that the Road in question is exceedingly steep in places and lots of bad curves. The bed of the road is of such a rough nature that it is practically impassable. However, there is one family living near the Southern Terminal and while they have another way out, over a neighbor's land, this could be closed to them at any time.

The cost of maintaining the portion of the road to be vacated would be very great, out of all proportion to benefits received, and we, therefore, recommend that the road be vacated as a public highway but be retained as a private road for the reason that it has to all practical purposes been abandoned for years, would be too expensive to maintain and would be burdensome to the tax payers of the Township.

"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

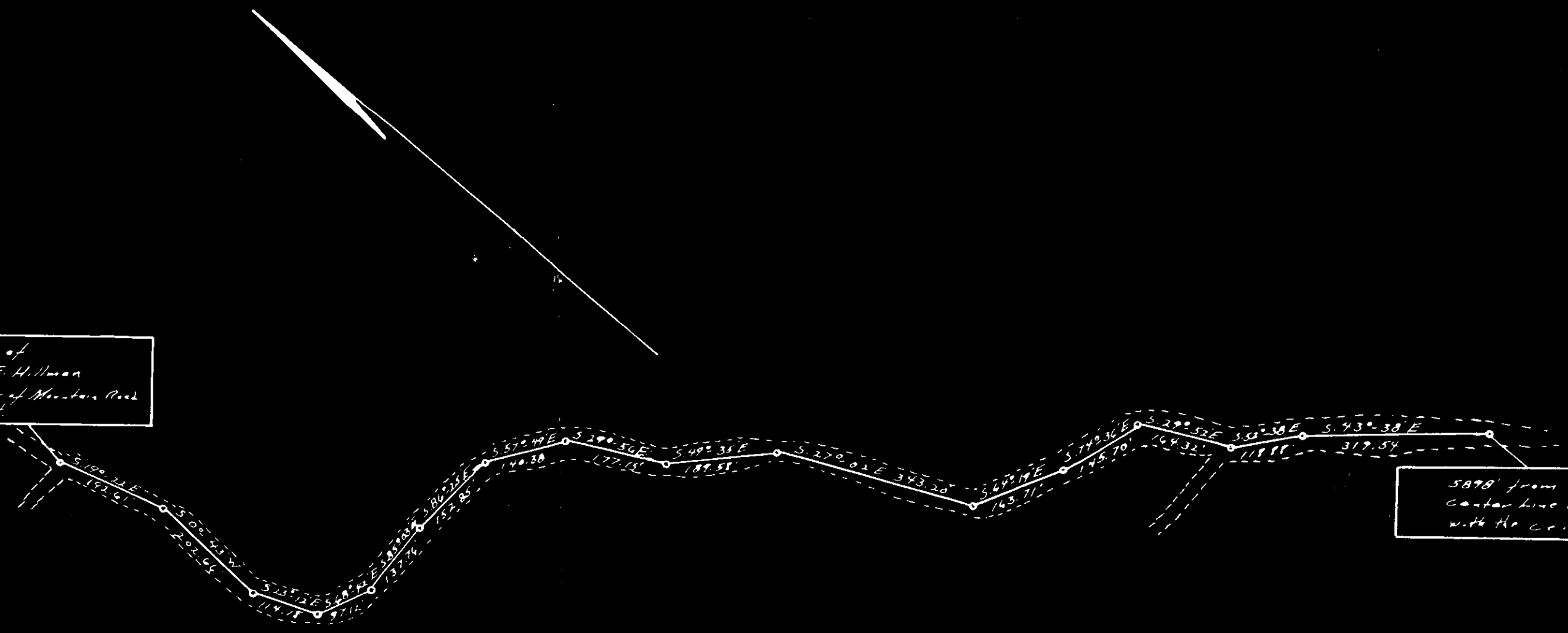
