IN AND FOR CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the said
Township of Upper Yoder, in the county aforesaid, respectfully
represents:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for
want of a public road or highway in the said Township of Upper
Yoder, being a portion of Robinson Avenue and beginning at its
intersection with Harshberger Street and extending in a south-
westerly direction from its said intersection to its intersection
with Daisy Street Extension, and Daisy Street Extension extending
in a northwesterly direction from its intersection to its inter-
section with Harshberger Street, making a continuous highway.

The exact location of the place of beginning from the
nearest intersecting public highway, namely, Daisy Street in the
Borough of Southmont is at a distance of five hundred three (503)
feet, measured along the center line of Hershberger Street in an
easterly direction from said Daisy Street. The exact location of
the place of ending from the nearest intersecting highway, namely,
Daisy Street in the Borough of Southmont, is at a distance of

thirty-five and fifty-five-hundredths (35.55) feet, measured along the center line of Hershberger Street in a westerly direction from said Daisy Street.

A print showing the location of said proposed road, as above described, is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT A".

A copy of the written notice to the Supervisors of said Upper Yoder Township of the intended presentation of this application, with the acceptance of service thereon, is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT B".

A release of damages whereby the owners of property abutting the aforesaid proposed road, releasing the said Township of Upper Yoder from any damages they have sustained or may seem likely to sustain by reason of the said accepting, opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining of said proposed highway, is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT C".

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County to view the ground proposed for such road and if they see the necessity therefor, lay out the same and make report of this proceeding to the next session of Court.

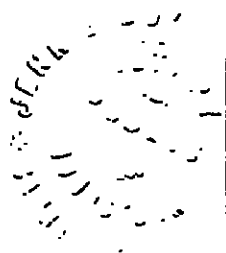

Petition and release of damages for the accepting, opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining certain dedicated Highways in Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as Public Highways.

We the undersigned, your petitioners, respectively represent:

That we are the owners of all of the property abutting on Robinson Avenue and Daisy Street extension in the Southmont Garden Plan of Lots.

That said Robinson Avenue is 30' in width and Daisy Street extension is 40' in width as dedicated and shown on the Southmont Garden Plan of Lots.

That we all and each of us having property abutting on Robinson Avenue do hereby dedicate additional ground to a depth of 1.5' on either side of said Robinson Avenue, to make same 33' in width.

NOW THEREFORE, we respectfully petition your honorable body to proceed with the necessary legislation required for the accepting, opening, improving and maintaining a portion of Robinson Avenue extending in a Southwesterly direction from its intersection with Harshberger Street (or Road) to its intersection with Daisy Street extension and Daisy Street Extension extending in a Northwardly direction from its intersection to its intersection with Harshberger Road, making a continuous Highway. The exact location of the place of beginning from the nearest intersecting Public Highway, namely, Daisy Street in the Borough of Southmont, is at a distance of 503' measured along the center line of Harshberger Street (or Road) in an Easterly direction from said Daisy Street. The exact location of the place of ending from the nearest intersecting Public Highway, namely, Daisy Street in the Borough of Southmont, is at a distance of 35:55' measured along the center line of Harshberger Street (or Road) in a Westerly direction from said Daisy Street.

IN CONSIDERATION of the accepting, opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining said portion of Robinson Avenue and Daisy Street extension and the widening of the right of way of Robinson Avenue to 33', we the undersigned do hereby release the Township of Upper Yoder its officials, agents and employees of any and all damages we have sustained or may seem likely to sustain, by reason of accepting, opening, draining, improving and maintaining said portion of Robinson Avenue and Daisy Street extension and the widening of a portion of Robinson Avenue to 33'.

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the above named Court, to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road in the Township of Upper Yoder, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, the termini being in the Township of Upper Yoder and being a portion of Robinson Avenue, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in Harshberger Street, a public highway, at the intersection of the center line of Harshberger Street with the center line of said proposed road, known as Robinson Avenue; thence by the center line of said proposed road, South 27 degrees 13 minutes West, One Hundred Twenty-five and Nineteen-hundredths (125.19) Feet; thence South 30 degrees 11 minutes West, One Hundred Eleven and One-hundredths (111.01) Feet to the point of a curve to the right, having a radius of One Hundred Seventy and Forty-one Hundredths (170.41) Feet; thence by said curve in a Southwesterly direction an arc distance of Two Hundred Eight and Two-tenths (208.2) Feet to a point of a tangent; thence by said tangent, North 79 degrees 49 minutes West, Two Hundred Seventy-three and Twenty-nine Hundredths (273.29) Feet to the intersection of Daisy Street; thence by same, North 4 degrees 29 minutes East, Two Hundred Ninety-eight and Six-Hundredths (298.06) Feet to the intersection of same with the center line of aforesaid Harshberger Street, the place of ending. The exact location of the place of beginning, from the nearest intersecting public highway, namely, Daisy Street in the Borough of Southmont is at a distance of Five Hundred Four and Thirty-nine Hundredths (504.39) Feet measured along the center line of Harshberger Street in an Easterly direction from the intersection of said Daisy Street. The exact location of the place of ending from the nearest intersecting public highway, namely, Daisy Street, in the Borough of Southmont is at a distance of Thirty-five and Fifty-five Hundredths (35.55) Feet measured along the center line of Harshberger Street in a Westerly direction from the intersection of said Daisy Street.

And if they decide there is such a necessity proceed to lay it out, having respect to the shortest distance - where it will do the least damage and as far as practicable agreeable to the wishes of the Petitioners, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown by the records of the Court. That due public notice has been given of the time, place and purpose of meeting by posting notices at the termini, at points along the route and at points adjacent thereto, copies of which notices being served on the Solicitor for the Township and the Clerk to the Supervisors and the Commissioners of Cambria County, all of which notices are hereto attached, properly signed and made a part of this report.

That in accordance with the notices given we met at the point of beginning on the date designated and proceeded with the duties of our appointment. There were present only the three Viewers, the Township was not represented. The Viewers went over the route of the proposed new road carefully and for its entire length and then gave careful consideration as to whether a necessity existed for such road and have unanimously agreed that there is a necessity for the road, and therefore recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted and the new road approved.

There has been filed with the petition a sketch showing that a portion of the road is a dedicated road 40 feet wide and the balance of the road being a 30 foot dedicated road, the owners on each side of the road, the 30 foot part, have given 1-1/2 feet of land to make it 33 feet wide, excepting the owner of the lot bounded by Harshberger Street and the proposed new road on its Westerly side. The owner is Ludwig Bauer.

A small brick wall has been erected on his property line and this will be within the right of way of the proposed road but as it is the intention to only use 16 feet of the 33 foot width of the road, due to its short length, this wall may never be removed or used by the Township.

After a lengthy discussion it was finally decided that there were no benefits or damages to any of the adjoining property owners along the route of the road.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

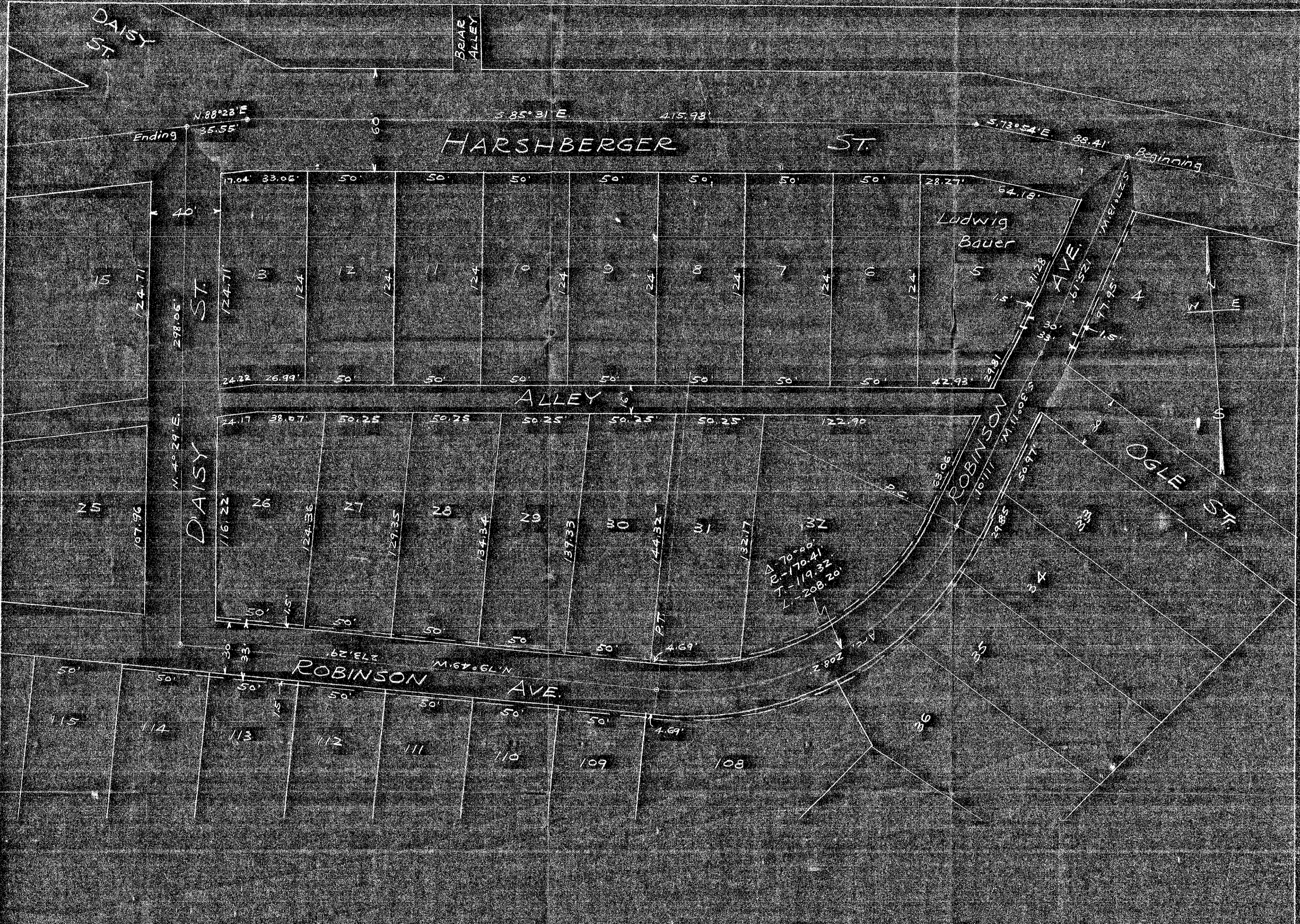
