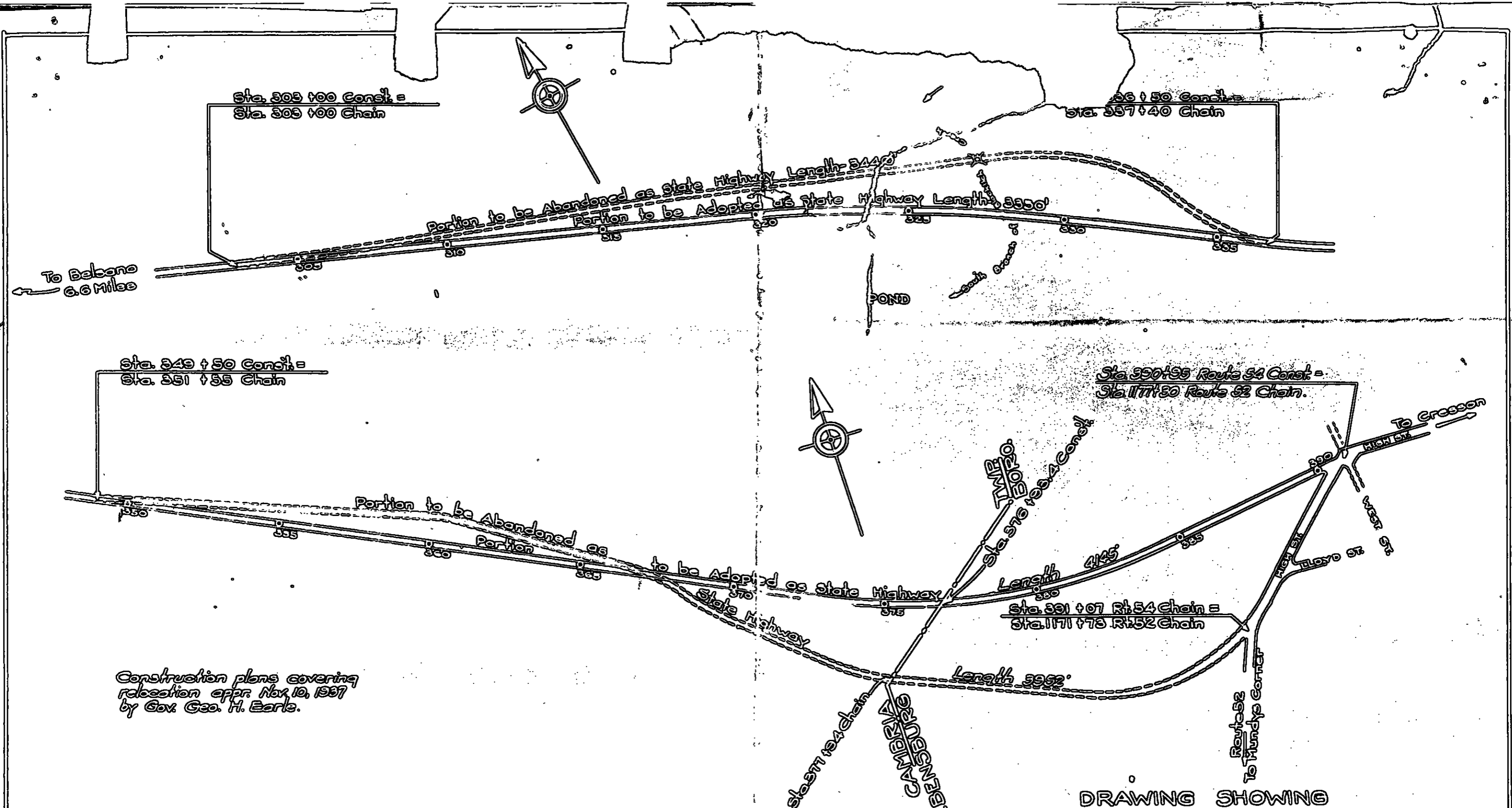

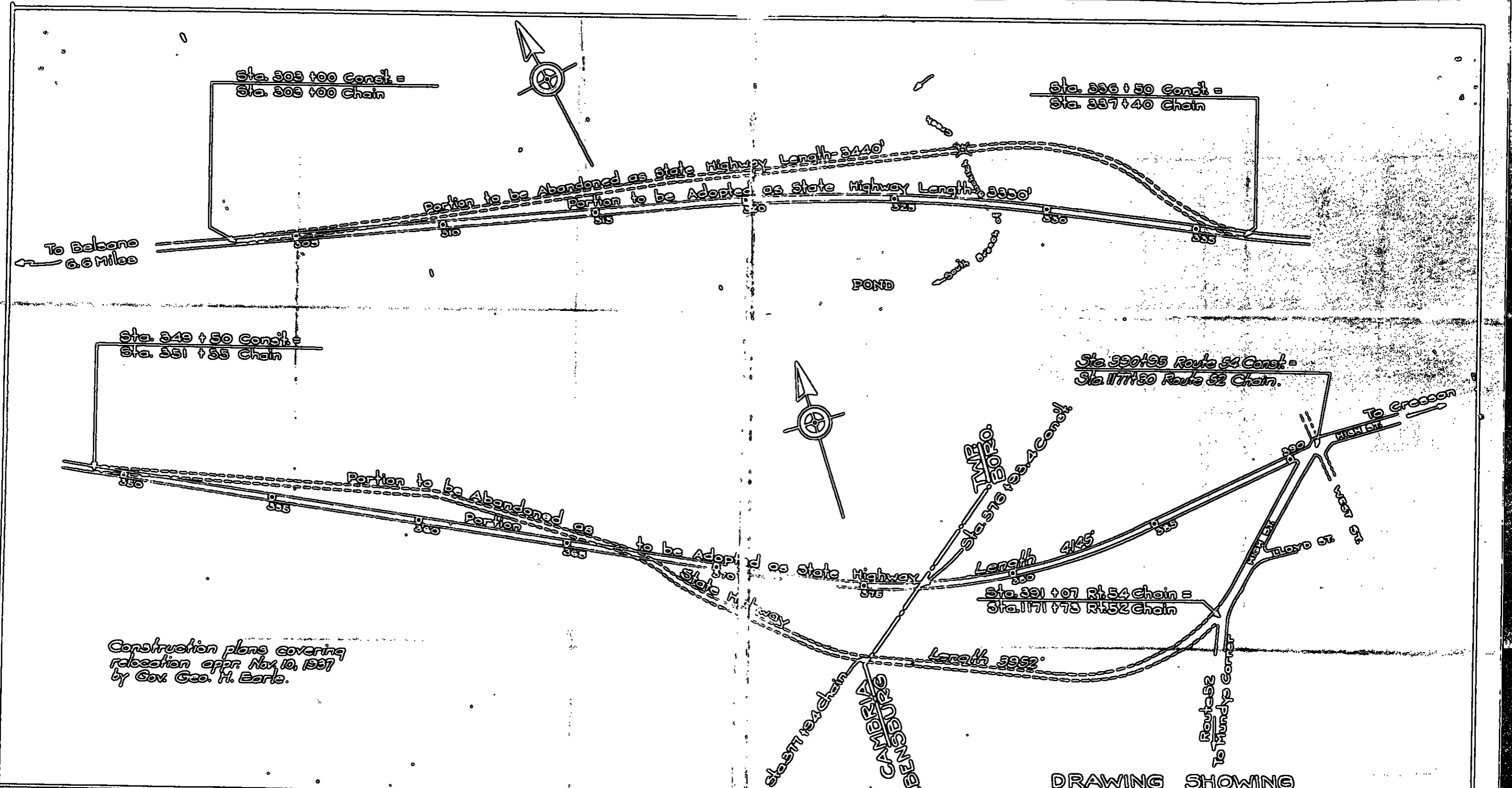

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the attached order of the above named Court, to view and determine whether two portions of Road in Cambria Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, should be vacated and abandoned because by the relocating of State Highway Route 54 Spur-Sec. 2 they have become useless and burdensome to the taxpayers, respectfully report as follows:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown by the records of the Court; that due public notice has been given of the time, place and purpose of the meeting by posting notices at the termini of both portions of road to be vacated, along the route, and at points adjacent thereto, copies of said notices being hereto attached and made a part of this report, and by service on the Supervisors of Cambria Township and the Commissioners of Cambria County, copies of said notices being hereto attached and also made a part of this report, all of which notices set forth the time, place and purpose of the meeting.

Said portions of Road to be abandoned are bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the New State Highway Route 54 Spur-Sec. 2 in Cambria Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, at a point known as Station 305 as shown on State Highway Plan, District #9, Sheet 4, at Station 303 plus 00; thence in an Easterly direction to a point as shown on said State Highway Plan on Sheet 6 of 11 at Station 336 plus 50; thence on said Plan from Station 350 to Station 367.

That in accordance with the notices given we met at the place of Beginning and proceeded with the duties of our appointment. There were present the three Viewers. Cambria Township was not represented. We viewed the portions of road to be vacated their entire length and after the view we met at the office of Mr. S. H. Jencks in Ebensburg for further discussion. Mr. Frank Dorr, Chief Clerk, and Attorney P. J. Little were interviewed in regard to property ownership along the route of the portions of land in question.

After giving the matter careful consideration we decided that that portion of the road described as follows; Beginning at a point on the New State Highway, Route 54 Spur-Sec. 2 in Cambria Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, known as Station 305 as shown on State

Highway Plan District No. 9, Sheet 4, at Station 303 plus 00; thence in an Easterly direction to a point as shown on said State Highway Plan on Sheet 6 of 11, at Station 336 plus 50, should be vacated as being useless and burdensome to the tax payers. We therefore recommend that the above described portion be vacated.

That portion of road continuing in an Easterly direction and beginning at Station 350, as shown on above described State Highway Plan and ending at Station 367, should be vacated as a public road but should be retained its entire length as a private road because of the fact that one house is along its route and this is the owners only means of egress. Other land along the route have no other means of egress; therefore we recommend that the Section shown on the State Highway Plan beginning at Station 350 and ending at Station 367 should be retained as a private road. The portion of the road to be retained is shown in color on plan filed with report and made a part hereof, which shows in more detail courses and distances.

There are no benefits or damages awarded to any one along the route of the vacated portions of land heretofore described.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
