TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:-

The petition of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PORTAGE TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA respectfully represents:

1. That upon petition of the residents and owners of lots abutting on portions of Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street, streets not heretofore adopted by your petitioners, being dedicated streets in the said Township of Portage and part of the recorded Plan of Hammers Addition No. 2 to Portage, laid out under the direction and in the presence of William H. Moudy May, 1907, which said plan was recorded July 5, 1912 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 130, and said plan as revised by map recorded in the said office April 21, 1916 in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 173; your petitioners accepted the said portions of the said Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street as public streets and/or highways, subject to the consent of this Honorable Court as more fully appears by Resolution of your petitioners hereto attached and made part hereof, marked "Exhibit A".

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray that your Honorable Court give its consent to the acceptance of said portions of Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street, described in said Resolution hereto attached, as public highways or streets in the said Township of Portage.

O R D E R


NOW, the 9th day of Feb., 1942, the within petition having been read and considered, the Court hereby gives its consent that the following portions of HAMMER STREET, MAPLE STREET, SONMAN AVENUE AND LAKEVIEW STREET, described in Resolution hereto attached, as "Exhibit A", being dedicated streets on the recorded Plan of Hammers Addition No. 2 to Portage, laid out under the direction and in the presence of William H. Moudy May, 1907, which said plan was recorded July 5, 1912 in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 130, and said plan as revised by map recorded in the said office April 21, 1916 in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 173, in Portage Township, Cambria County, be accepted as public highways and/or streets, said streets being described as follows:

1. HAMMER STREET:- Beginning at the center of the intersection of Hammer Street and Johnston Avenue through the intersection of Conemaugh Avenue and Hammer Street to the boundary line of Portage Township and Portage Borough, a distance of seven hundred (700) feet, more or less.
2. MAPLE STREET:- Beginning at the center of the intersection of said Maple Street and Conemaugh Avenue to the boundary line of Portage Township and Portage Borough, being at a point a short distance beyond the intersection of said Maple Street and Jefferson Avenue, a distance of three hundred fifty-five (355) feet, more or less.
3. SONMAN AVENUE: Beginning at the center of the intersection of Sonman Avenue and Maple Street; thence along the line of Sonman Avenue to the center of the intersection of Lakeview Street and Conemaugh Avenue, a distance of approximately one thousand eighty-five (1085) feet, more or less.

And it is further ordered and directed that the said portions of Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street forthwith be and become a

part of the highway system of the Township of Portage, Cambria County, and
be it still further ordered and directed that this proceeding be recorded in
the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners and citizens of the Township of Portage have petitioned us, the Portage Township Supervisors, to accept, with the approval of the Court, certain portions of streets and/or public highways in said township as public roads and/or streets, which streets and/or highways were laid out as streets and/or highways on the Plan of Hammers Addition No. 2 to Portage, laid out under the direction and in the presence of William H. Moudy May, 1907, which said plan was recorded July 5, 1912 in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 130, and said plan as revised by map recorded in the said office April 21, 1916 in Plat Book, Vol. 1, Page 173; and

WHEREAS, the said petitioners and citizens of the Township of Portage, residing on said portions of streets and/or highways which have heretofore never been accepted by the Township Supervisors suffer great inconvenience by reason that the same have never been accepted as public streets and/or highways by the Supervisors of Portage Township; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intention and desire of the Supervisors of the said Portage Township to accept the hereinafter described portions of the said streets, known as Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and a portion of Lakeview Street, in pursuance to the Act of Assembly of 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1147, as amended by the Act of 1935, P. L. 1299 Section 2, and as further amended by the Act of 1941, P. L. 39, Section 1, in such case made and provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following portions of the said Hammer Street, Maple Street, Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street, heretofore adopted, approved and recorded be and the same are hereby accepted by the Supervisors of Portage Township as township streets and/or highways, being described as follows:

1. HAMMER STREET:- Beginning at the center of the intersection of Hammer Street and Johnston Avenue through the intersection of Conemaugh Avenue and Hammer Street to the boundary line of Portage Township and Portage Borough, a distance of seven hundred (700) feet, more or less.

2. MAPLE STREET:- Beginning at the center of the intersection of said Maple Street and Conemaugh Avenue to the boundary line of Portage Township and Portage Borough, being at a point a short distance beyond the intersection of said Maple Street and Jefferson Avenue, a distance of three hundred fifty-five (355) feet, more or less.

3. SONMAN AVENUE:- Beginning at the center of the intersection of Sonman Avenue and Maple Street; thence along the line of Sonman Avenue to the center of the intersection of Lakeview Street and Conemaugh Avenue, a distance of approximately one thousand eighty-five (1085) feet, more or less.

Motion for the adoption of the said portions of streets and/or highways made by John Timura and seconded by Charles Wills Jr. Resolution adopted this 30 day of January A. D., 1942.
