REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court,
we the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of
the Court to view the proposed road within mentioned, respect-
fully report:

That we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of
the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by
the records of the Court; that having given due public notice
of the time and place of meeting, by posting notices as re-
quired by law along the route and at the termini of the said
proposed new road, as evidenced by copy of said notice hereto
attached, and by service of said notice upon the County Com-
missioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder
Township and the Solicitor of Upper Yoder Township, evidence
of which is shown by copies of said notice hereto attached
and made a part of this report; that we met in accordance with
the notice given on the 14th day of October A. D. 1942 at
11:00 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our
appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new
road; that during the view several residents of Upper Yoder
Township and all three Viewers were present. After viewing
the premises, we met at the office of S. E. Dickey & Co.,
809 Johnstown Trust Bldg., Johnstown, Pa., where two of the
Supervisors, Curt Barnhart and D. H. Weimer, were interviewed;
that said proposed new road is now temporarily opened over
two dedicated Highways in the Henry Shenkle Estate Plan of Lots
known as Mellott Avenue and America Street, the location of which
is shown in green on the blue print attached hereto and made

a part hereof; that one of the terminus of said proposed road is at a point other than in a public highway or place of public resort; that after hearing all interested persons present at the view and Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, we find that there is no objections to said proposed new road and having determined that said road is necessary, we proceeded to layout same as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of the Menoher Highway, State Highway Route No. 271, a Public Highway, leading from Johnstown to Legioner, at the intersection of Mellott Avenue; thence by the center line of Mellott Avenue, a dedicated Highway 40' in width, N.55° 45'W., 460'; thence N.1° 41'W., 320.87'; thence N.21° 16'W., 254.76'; thence N.28° 46'W., 400.31' to the center line of America Street; thence by the center line of America Street, a dedicated Highway 50' in width, N.61° 14'E., 680.04' to the place of ending at its intersection with a 20' width dedicated Highway at the property of Ord Hunt, Lot Number 76. The total length of said proposed new road being 2115.98'. The exact location of the place of beginning from the nearest intersecting Public Highway, namely, the old Millcreek Road leading from the Menoher Highway to Martin Keifer property at Swank's Cottage, is at a distance 1180' measured along the center line of the Menoher Highway in a Northeasterly direction from the intersection of the old Millcreek Road with the Menoher Highway near Dunies Inn. The exact location of the place of ending is at a distance of 2115.98' measured along the center line of the proposed new road from the place of beginning in the Menoher Highway; that there are now six or more houses on lots abutting the proposed new Highway and that all of the abutting property or lots belong to individual owners; that after taking into consideration all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that said road as prayed for by the Petitioners and laid out

by us is necessary and convenient for the several property owners and houses erected thereon and that same will not be burdensome to the taxpayers of Upper Yoder Township. Therefore, we recommend that the prayer of the Petitioners be granted.

We have been informed that a Release of Damages was signed by all of the abutting property owners excepting one, a non-resident, who could not be contacted, and filed with and made a part of the Petition for said proposed new road, however, regardless of said release of damages, we assess no benefits and no damages to any of the abutting property owners.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 25th day of September A. D. 1942, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Upper Yoder, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under incon-

venience for want of a ~~public~~ road or highway, to lead from to begin at a point on the Mencher Highway, a public highway in the said Township, and extending over and along Mellott Avenue, a dedicated Avenue, to America Street, a dedicated Street; thence over and across America Street to a Court twenty feet in width at the property of Ord Hunt, in the said Township of Upper Yoder, the place of ending.

The exact location of said place of beginning from the nearest intersecting public highway, namely, the old Millcreek Road leading from the Mencher Highway to Martin Keifer property at Swank's Cottage is a distance of 1188 feet, measured along the center line of the Mencher Highway in a northeasterly direction from the intersection of the old Millcreek Road with the Mencher Highway Dunies Inn.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

We the undersigned, your petitioners, respectively represent:

That we are the owners of all of the property abutting on a 40' width Street and a 50' width Street dedicated Highway's in the Henry Shenkel Estate Plan of Sub-Divisions known as Mellott Avenue and America Street. That we are badly in need of a Township Road for the benefit of the traveling public and the buildings and properties abutting on said Highway's.

Therefore, we respectfully petition your honorable body to proceed with the necessary legislation required for the accepting, opening, improving and maintaining of said Mellott Avenue from its intersection with the Menoher Highway to its intersection with America Street and America Street from its intersection with Mellott Avenue eastwardly to a 20' wide court at the property of Ord Hunt and Westwardly to its intersection with the boundary line of the Adam Keifer property, now or late. The exact place of ending of proposed Highway's are not in another public Highway but the opening of same, as prayed for by your petitioners is necessary for the convenience of the traveling public and property owners.

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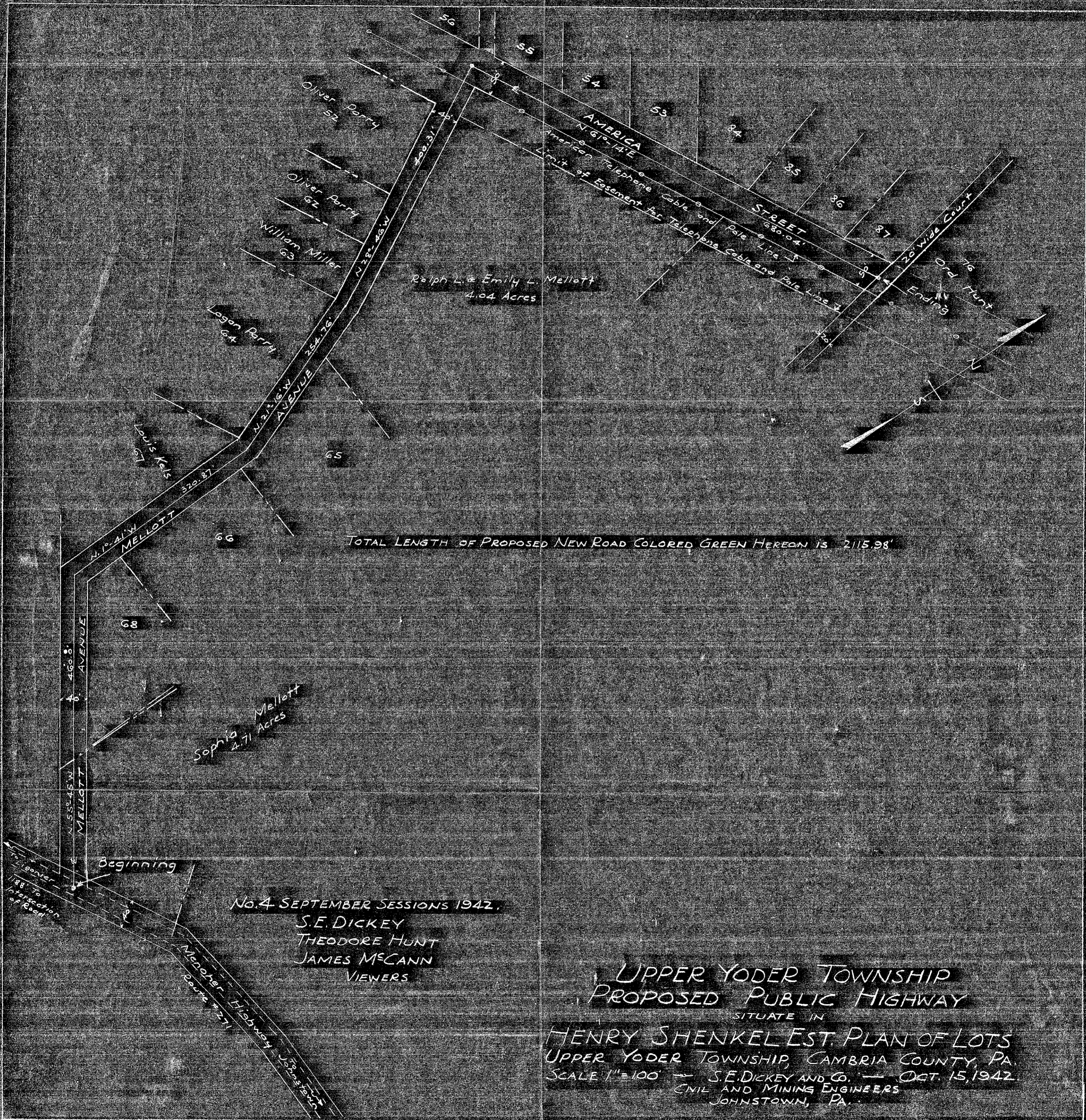
