PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:--

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:

1. That, at a regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, held on the ~~28th~~ day of ~~August~~, A. D. 1942, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road or street, located in the River View Section of East Taylor Township.

2. That the section or piece of road, or street, which is to be taken over by the Township of East Taylor, is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit #1". A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit #2".

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street, as a said township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18th, A. D. 1935, P. L. 1299, in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of East Taylor.

On motion of Clyde Herald, seconded by W. G. Wilson,
and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road supervisors of East Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, accept as a public highway that section of road, or street, located in the said East Taylor Township:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Chapel Avenue and WJefferson Street, as shown on the revised plan of lots, as laid out for G. M. Reed, by Fetterman Engineering Company, April 9th, 1938; thence, North $56^{\circ} 36'$ East along the said WJefferson Street, a distance of 822.8 feet to the center line of Lincoln Avenue; on the said plan of G. M. Reed; thence, continuing along the line of said WJefferson Street, North $58^{\circ} 55'$ East, as shown on the Wagner Plan of Lots, laid out by the Fetterman Engineering Company, a distance of 2850 feet, more or less, to the boundary line of the Township of East Taylor and the Township of Jackson. The said road or street, which is hereby accepted by the said Township of East Taylor, as a public highway, having a width of Forty (40) feet.

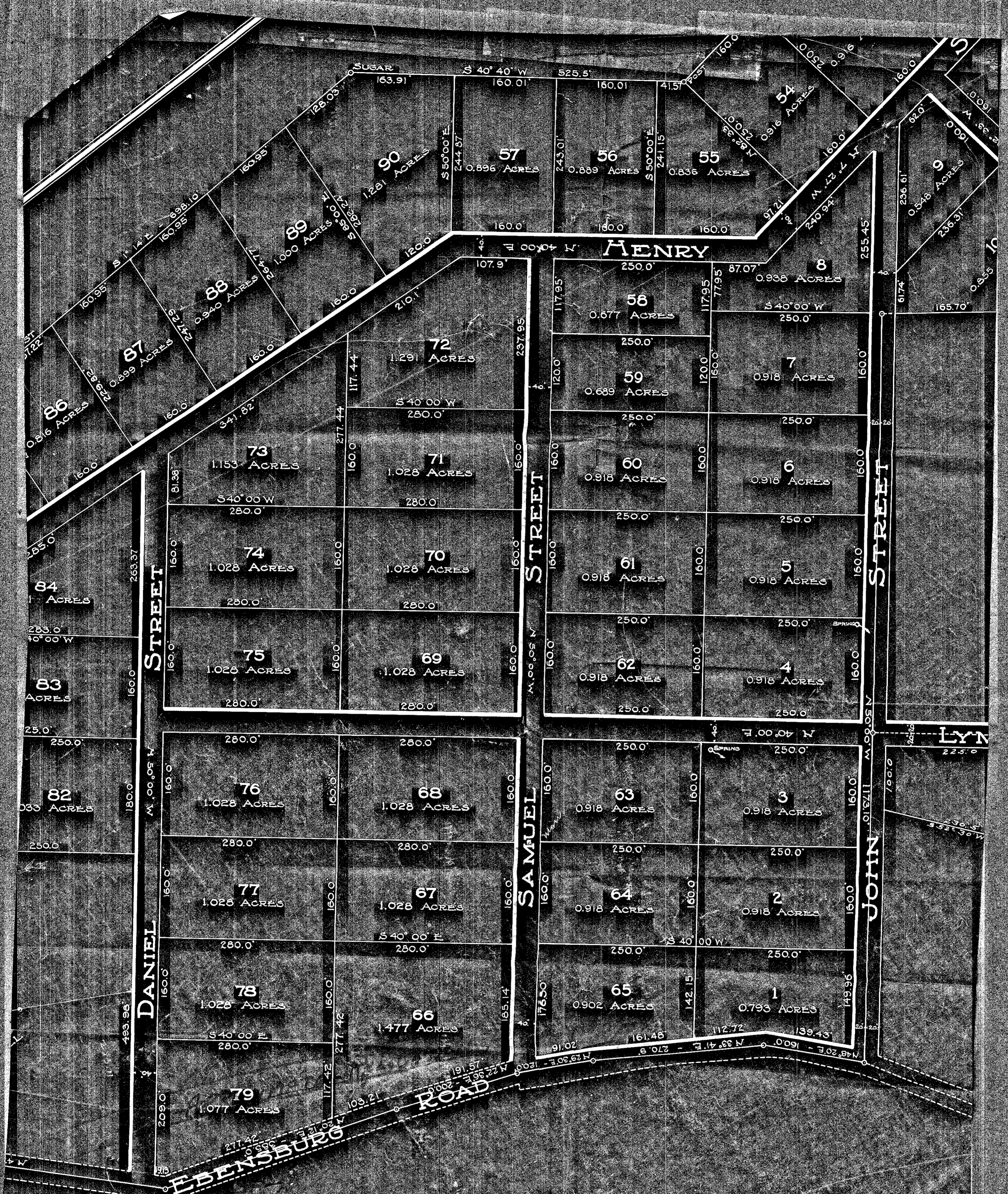
