REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court

We, the undersigned Viewers appointed by the attached order of said Court to view the proposed new road within described and to determine if a necessity exists for it and if so, to proceed to lay it out according to law, respectfully report:

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court. That due public notice of the time and place of meeting was given by posting notices at the termini of said road, along the route and at places adjacent thereto. Also, the serving of notices on the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, through their Attorney, Frank P. Barnhart, as attested by copies of all such notices properly signed and hereto attached and made a part of this report.

That we met in accordance with such notices at the time and place indicated and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed new road. There were present all three Viewers and a number of the adjoining property owners. That said new proposed road is now a private road, kept in good condition and maintained by the owners of the adjoining properties. That one of the Terminus of the road is at other than a Public Highway, commonly known as a dead end. That there are now eight families living along the route of the proposed road, and also, it furnishes the only means of egress for other properties. All those present spoke in favor of the new road and all three Viewers favored it. It was therefore agreed by the Viewers that the prayers of the petitioners should be granted and the opening of the new road approved accordingly. The Viewers proceeded to lay out the new road which is bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Menoher Highway, a public Highway in said Township, and extending over and across a private road to a turning circle on the property of W. D. Slagle. The exact location of the said place of beginning of said proposed road from the nearest intersecting public Highway, namely, St. Clair Road, leading from the said Menoher Highway, Route No. 271 to Morrellville is 3535 feet, measured along the center line of the said Menoher Highway in a Westerly direction from the said St. Clair Road. The exact place of ending of the said road is at a distance of 1855 feet from the Menoher Highway measured along the center line of the said proposed road in a Northerly direction from the said Menoher Highway. That the other terminus of the proposed road, namely the point of ending, as above stated, is at the point other than in a public highway or place of public resort; but the said proposed road is one necessary for public travel.

A map or plan of the proposed road is filed with this report showing in more detail, the courses and distances.

All of the abutting property owners have agreed to waive all claims for damages and all but one owner have signed waivers which have been filed with the petition, and with the verbal acceptance by the one owner who failed to sign a release, it is unanimously agreed that there will be no question of damages. Therefore, the Viewers agree that they assess no damages and no benefits to any of the adjoining property owners. They also agree that in view of the fact, that the road in question is not a part of a continuous highway, that they recommend to the Honorable Court that the width of the road be made the minimum width of (33) thirty-three feet.

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
