
TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The Petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of Conemaugh, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:

1. That at a Regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of Conemaugh held on the 19th day of August A.D., 1949, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road or street located in the Township of Conemaugh.

2. That the section or piece of road or street which is to be taken over by the Township of Conemaugh is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors which is entered in the Minute Book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit 1". Map of proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit 2".

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18, A.D., 1935, P.L. 1299, as amended (Section 17, Act of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481) in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of Conemaugh.

R E S O L U T I O N

On motion of L. L. Reynolds, seconded by W. J. Killian and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED, that the Board of Road Supervisors of Conemaugh Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accept as a Public Highway that section of road or street located in the Plan of Franklin Extended in the said Township of Conemaugh:

FIRST. A section of East Third Street; thence, North fifty-six degrees twenty-two minutes ($56^{\circ} 22'$) West, a distance of three hundred fifty (350) feet, more or less, to the intersection of East Third Street and Griffith Avenue.

SECOND. A section of Third Avenue East, beginning at the intersection of East Fourth Street and Third Avenue East; thence, North thirty-three degrees thirty-eight minutes ($33^{\circ} 38'$) East along the line of Third Avenue East, a distance of eight hundred seventy-five (875) feet, more or less to the intersection of Third Avenue East and East Sixth Street.

THIRD. A section of East Sixth Street, beginning at the intersection of Fourth Avenue East and East Sixth Street; thence, North fifty-six degrees twenty-two minutes ($56^{\circ} 22'$) West, along the line of East Sixth Street, a distance of two hundred fifty-six (256) feet, more or less, to the intersection of Third Avenue East and East Sixth Street.

The section of Road or Street hereinabove described being forty (40) feet in width and being shown on the Plan of Franklin Extended, a duly accepted, approved and dedicated Plan of Lots prepared for Franklin Land & Improvement Co., Ltd., by S. G. Fetterman, C.E. on January 16, 1902, and being recorded in the Recorder's Office at Ebensburg, Pennsylvania, in Misc. Record Book 10, at page 48.

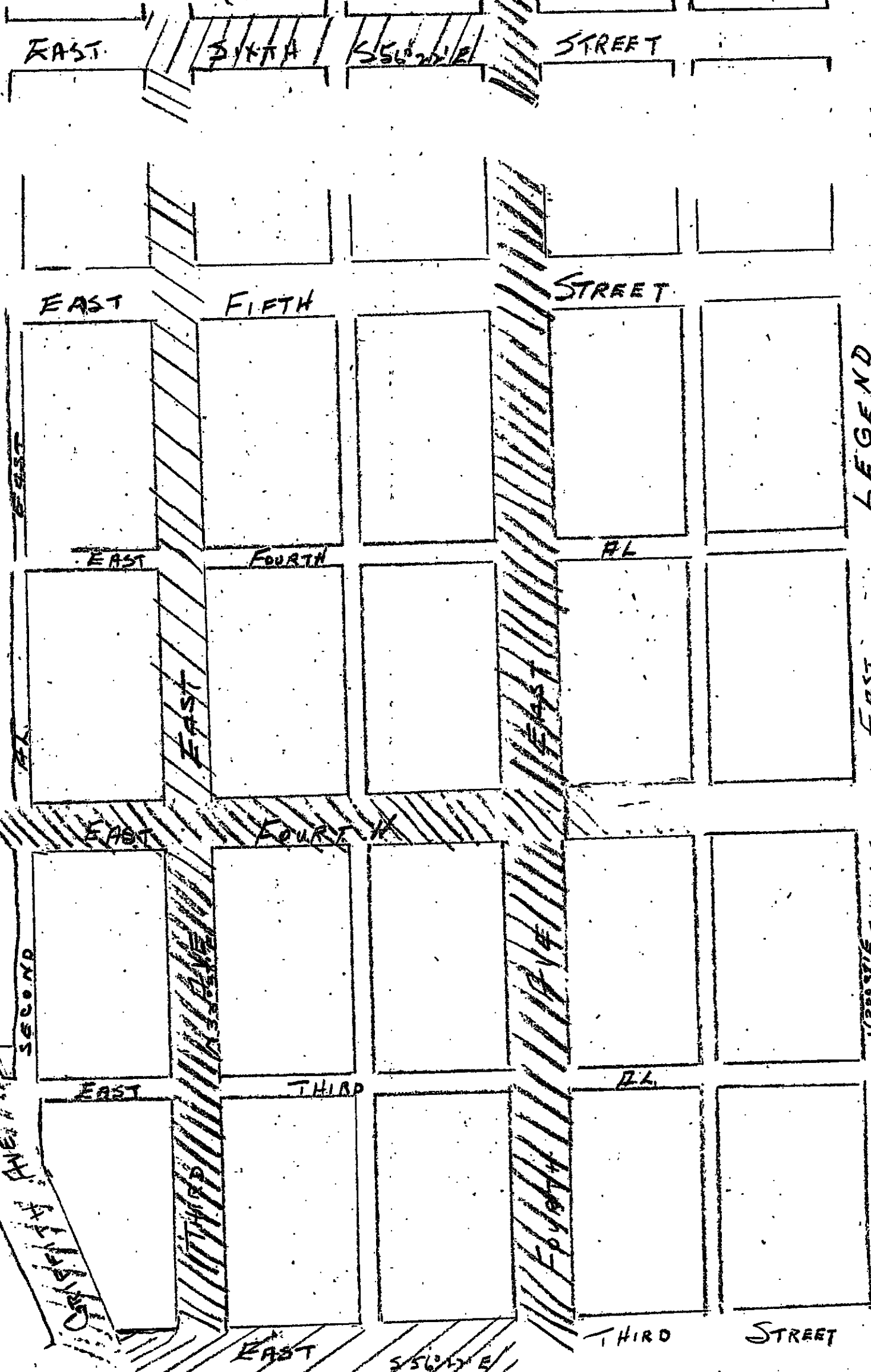

 of Supervisors, 1909


