In accordance with the provisions of the Article XI of the
Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, as amended, 53 P.S. 19093-1101 et seq.,
Richard Nesbit, Joseph Brawley and Gladstone Bradford, Supervisors of
the Township of West Carroll, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby make
the following report:

That they are the duly elected, qualified and active
supervisors of the said Township of West Carroll.

That by a plan approved by the Governor of the Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania on the 25th day of April, 1947, a portion of State Highway
Route 62 located in the Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and
State of Pennsylvania, was abandoned as part of the State Highway System,
said portion abandoned being one thousand five hundred fifty-seven (1557)
feet in length.

That the said State Highway Route 62 was relocated by the con-
struction of a new portion of highway one thousand three hundred fifty (1350)
feet in length. A map showing the portion of State Highway abandoned and
the part of new highway constructed is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit D"
and made a part of this report.

That the owners of real estate affected by the abandonment and vacation of the said portion of State Highway Route 62 are listed hereon as follows:

That the above named persons were each served by registered mail on November 7, 1949, with written notices to the effect that the Supervisors of the said Township of West Carroll would hold a meeting on Tuesday, November 22, 1949, at four (4:00) o'clock P.M. to consider the matter of vacating the said abandoned portion of State Highway Route No. 62. A copy of said notice together with the registry return receipts is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A", and made a part of this report.

That pursuant to the said notice, the Supervisors of the said Township of West Carroll held the said meeting at the time and place aforesaid at which meeting the said Supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, passed an ordinance vacating the said abandoned portion of State Highway Route 62. A certified copy of the said ordinance, marked "Exhibit B", is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO VACATE TOWNSHIP ROAD.

NOTICE is hereby given that Richard Nesbit, Gladstone Bradford and Joseph Brawley, Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, will hold a meeting on Tuesday, November 22, 1949, at Four (4:00) o'clock P.M. in the Bakerton Public School Building at Bakerton, Pa., when and where all parties interested may be heard, to consider the matter of vacating the portion of State Highway Route No. 62, wholly within the said Township of West Carroll, which was abandoned by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as part of the State Highway system because of the relocation and construction of a new portion of said State Highway Route No. 62 by the Department of Highways pursuant to a plan approved by the Governor on April 25, 1947.

The said abandoned portion of State Highway Route No. 62 to be considered at the aforesaid meeting is described as follows:

Beginning at State Highway Station 656+06 on State Highway Route No. 62, being the intersection of the newly constructed portion and the abandoned portion of said Route No. 62, thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route No. 62 a distance of 1557 feet or 0.2949 miles to where said abandoned road again intersects the said State Highway Route No. 62 at station 671+63.

ORDINANCE NO. 1

An Ordinance to Vacate a Road Wholly Within The Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, Which Was Abandoned as Part of the State Highway System.

WHEREAS, by a plan approved by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on the 25th day of April, 1947, a portion of State Highway Route 62 located within the Township of West Carroll, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, was abandoned as part of the State Highway System due to the relocation and construction of a new portion of said State Highway, and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Supervisors of the said Township of West Carroll the abandoned portion of the said State Highway Route 62 is not necessary or needed as a township road, and, in the interest of public convenience, the said Supervisors have decided to vacate, by ordinance, the said abandoned portion of State Highway Route 62, herein described.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same,

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, for and in the interest of public convenience, the following described road be and the same is hereby vacated:

Beginning at State Highway Station 656+06 on State Highway Route No. 62, being the intersection of the newly constructed portion and the abandoned portion of said Route No. 62, thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route No. 62 a distance of 1557 feet or 0.2949 miles to where said abandoned road again intersects the said State Highway Route No. 62 at Station 671+63. The width thereof being fixed at 30 feet.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor be and hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pa., together with the names of the owners of property effected, a draft and survey of the road vacated and a report of the proceedings relating to the vacation of the road hereinabove described.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Notice is hereby given that Richard Nesbit, Gladstone Bradford and Joseph Brawley, Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, at a meeting of the said Supervisors held on Tuesday, November 22, 1949, at Four (4:00) o'clock P.M. in the Bakerton Public School Building at Bakerton, Pa., passed an ordinance in the interest of public convenience, vacating that portion of State Highway Route 62 which was heretofore abandoned as part of the State Highway System.

The abandoned portion of State Highway Route 62 which was vacated by the aforesaid ordinance is described as follows:

Beginning at State Highway Station 656+06 on State Highway Route No. 62, being the intersection of the newly constructed portion and the abandoned portion of said Route No. 62, thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route No. 62 a distance of 1557 feet or 0.2949 miles to where said abandoned road again intersects the said State Highway Route No. 62 at Station 671+63. The width thereof being fixed at 30 feet.

A report of all the proceedings in connection with the vacation of the above described road together with a certified copy of the aforesaid ordinance, a draft or survey of said road and copies of all notices will be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, on December 5, 1949.

Any citizen or freeholder of the Township of West Carroll may, within thirty (30) days after the filing of the aforesaid report of the Supervisors, file exceptions to the report together with a petition for review.
