TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of Middle Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, sets forth the following facts:

1. That at a regular meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of Middle Taylor, held on the 2nd day of March, A. D. 1955, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road or street located in the Valley View Section of Middle Taylor Township.

2. That the section or piece of road or street which is to be taken over by the Township of Middle Taylor is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors, which is entered in the minute book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit No. 1." A map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit No. 2."

WHEREFORE, the petitioner prays your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over of the said road or street as a said township road under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18, 1935, P. L. 1299, as amended, in order that such road or street shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of Middle Taylor.

RESOLUTION

On motion of Frank Johnson, seconded by

Orville Rose and duly passed, it was

RESOLVED that the Board of Road Supervisors of Middle Taylor Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, accept as a public highway that section of road or street located in the Valley View Section of the said Township of Middle Taylor:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Pleasant Hill Highway (Penna. State Highway Legislative Route No. 11015) and Earl Street on the Plan of Valley View; thence along the line of the said Earl Street in a southerly direction a distance of 1137 feet to the intersection of Earl Street and Taft Street; thence along the line of Taft Street, in an easterly direction a distance of 1070 feet to Prince Street; said Earl Street and Taft Street being properly dedicated Streets on the Plan of Valley View, laid out by W. M. Updegrave and M. W. Miller on the 11th day of June, 1910, C. P. Collins, C.E., and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Flat Book Vol. 1 at page 92. The said street or road which is hereby accepted by the said Township of Middle Taylor as a public highway having a width of thirty (30) feet.

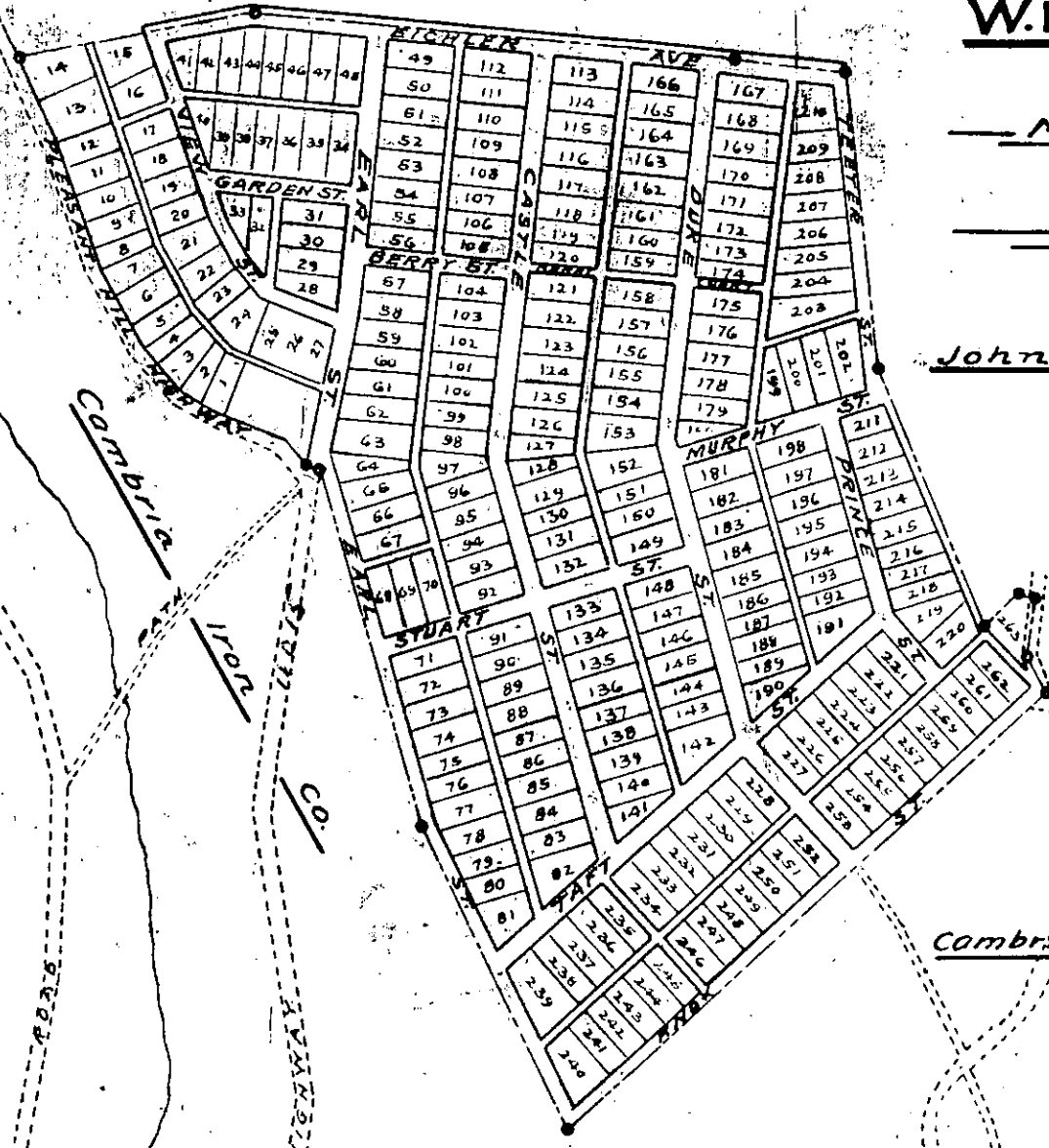
