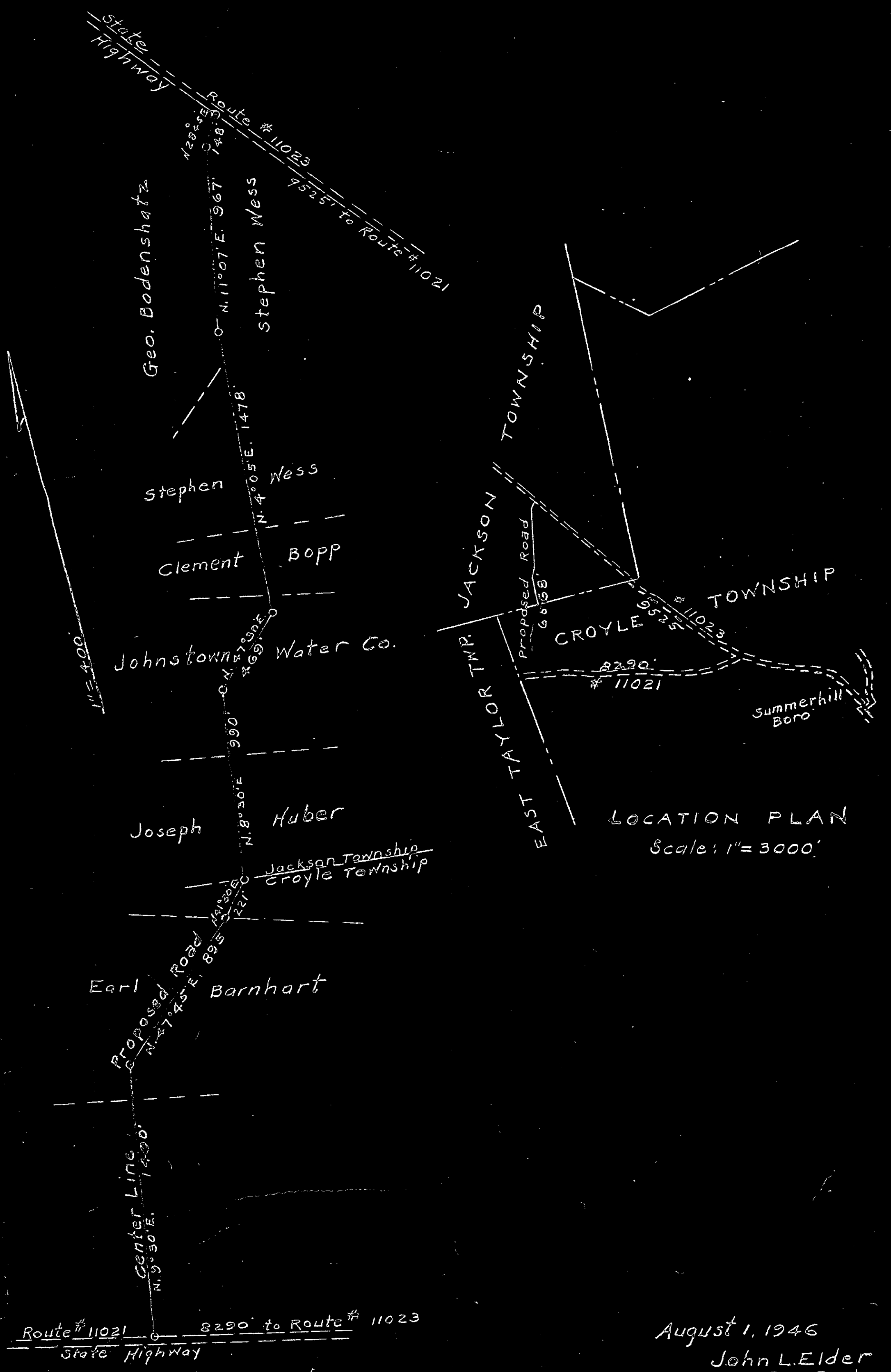

REPORT OF THE SUPERVISORS OF CROYLE TOWNSHIP

The Petition of MICHAEL KISHLOCK, JOSEPH HUBER, and OLIVER W. PLUMMER, respectfully represents:

(1) That they are the Road Supervisors of the Township of Croyle, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

(2) That they propose to open and lay out a public road in Croyle Township as shown on the blue print hereto attached, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "A". Said road shall have a uniform width of 33 feet and a length of 2,516 feet, beginning at the intersection of State Highway Route No. 11021; thence North 9 degrees 30 minutes East, 1400 feet; thence North 47 degrees 45 minutes East 895 feet; thence North 41 degrees 30 minutes East 221 feet to the boundary line of Jackson and Croyle Townships.

(3) That your petitioners have given ten (10) days notice to the property owners effected by the laying out of the said road as required by the Act of Assembly of a hearing and after said hearing your Supervisors deem that said road is necessary for the public convenience. A copy of said notice is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "B".

(4) Attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "C" is the Resolution of the Board of Supervisors for opening and laying out the above described road.

(5) Attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "D", are the releases executed by the owners of property abutting on said proposed road.

WHEREFORE YOUR petitioners pray that this report and the exhibits attached hereto may be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Courts of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

A RESOLUTION

That First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, A Street and B Street, as laid out in the Map of the Village of Ehrenfeld, Croyle Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, by the Engineering Department of the Pennsylvania Coal and Coke Corporation on October 22, 1947, which plan is recorded in the recorder of deeds in and for Cambria County in Plat Book Vol. 4, Page 40, be opened, accepted and adopted as highways of the Township of Croyle, with the uniform width contained in the aforesaid plan, and in accordance with the lines, courses, distances and grades as therein appear, and the Solicitor of the Township is directed to petition the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County for the Court's approval to the opening, adoption and acceptance of the aforesaid streets.
