REPORT OF THE SUPERVISORS OF CROYLE TOWNSHIP

The petition of MICHAEL KISHLOCK, JOSEPH HUBER, and  
OLIVER W. PLUMMER, respectfully represents:

(1) That they are the Road Supervisors of the  
Township of Croyle, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania.

(2) That they propose to lay out, open and accept  
certain Streets and public roads in the Township of Croyle, on  
the plan of the Pennsylvania Coal and Coke Company, for the  
Village of Ehrenfeld, dated October 22, 1947, which plan is re-  
corded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria  
County, in Plat Book Vol. 4, Page 40, and which Streets are there n  
laid out by the following names: First Street, Second Street,  
Third Street, Fourth Street, A Street and B Street. The said  
streets and roads above described appear on the plan of lots  
heretofore referred to, a copy of which is hereto attached, made  
part hereof and marked Exhibit "A", and colored in red.

(3) That your petitioners have given ten (10) days  
notice to the property owners affected by the laying out of said  
streets as required by the Act of Assembly of a hearing, and after  
said hearing the Supervisors deem that the said streets are  
necessary and convenient, and by resolution duly made and adopted

the said streets were laid out, opened and accepted by the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle as part of the highway system of said Township, which Resolution is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "B".

(4) That attached hereto and made a part hereof is Deed of Release and Quitclaim executed by the owners of property abutting on the said proposed roads and/or streets, marked and designated as Exhibit "C".

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that this report and the Exhibits attached hereto be filed in the office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Coal and Coke Corporation on October 22, 1947, laid out the plan of the Village of Ehrenfeld, Croyle Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, which plan is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for Cambria County, in Plat Book Vol. 4, Page 40, and dedicated First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, A Street, and B Street, on the said plan as public Streets, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Supervisors of Croyle Township to lay-out, open, and accept the said Streets as part of the public highway system for the Township of Croyle, and;

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have given a ten (10) day's notice to the property owners affected thereby as to the time and place where and when all parties interested may meet and be heard and after hearing and a consideration of the matter at such meeting, a majority of the Supervisors decided in favor of exercising the power so conferred in laying out, opening and accepting the said Streets.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following described Streets as appears on the plan of the Village of Ehrenfeld, Croyle Township, Cambria County, recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, in and for Cambria County, in Plat Book Vol. 4, Page 40, be laid out, opened and accepted by the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle as part of the Highway System of the said Township, after making written report thereof together with a draft or survey of said streets to be presented and filed in the office of the Clerk of Courts of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, such Streets being

described and laid-out in the aforesaid plan and including, namely, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Fifth Street, A Street, and B. Street.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided any citizen or freeholder of the Township may, within thirty (30) days after the filing of the report of the Supervisors, file exceptions to the report, together with a petition for a review.
