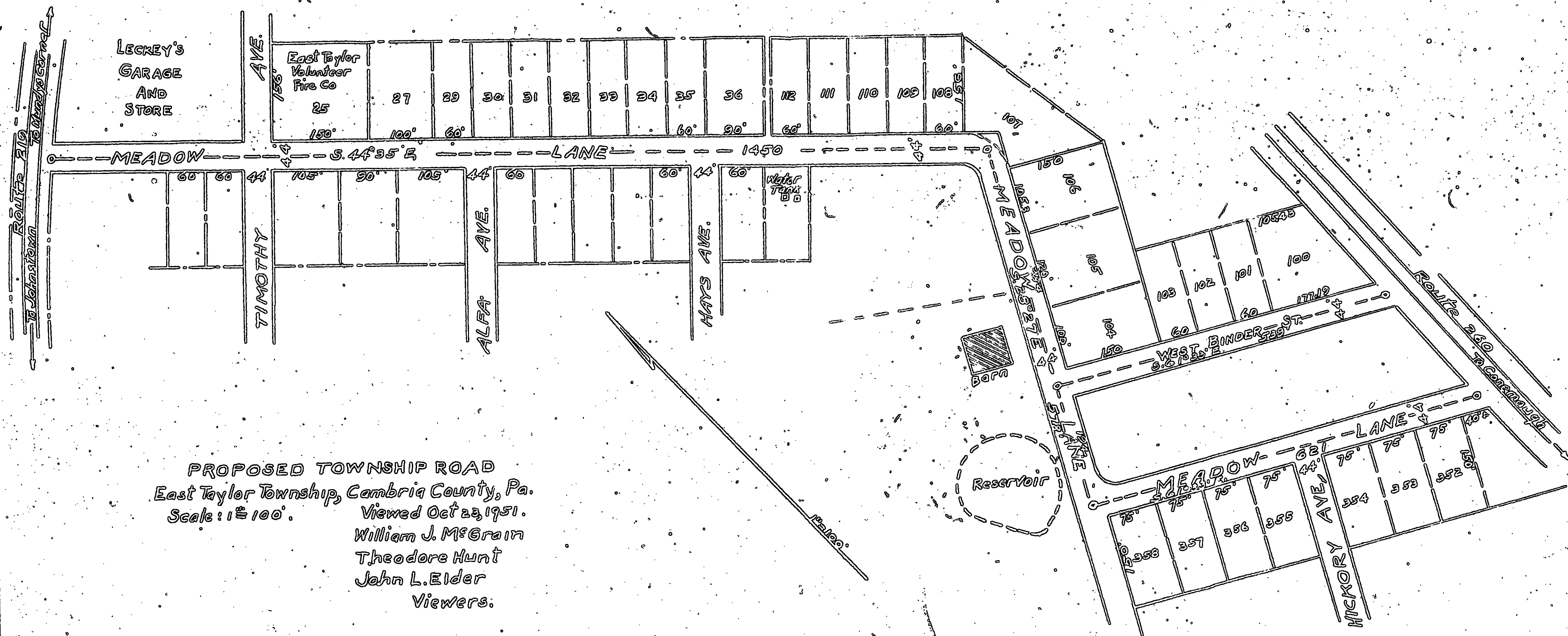


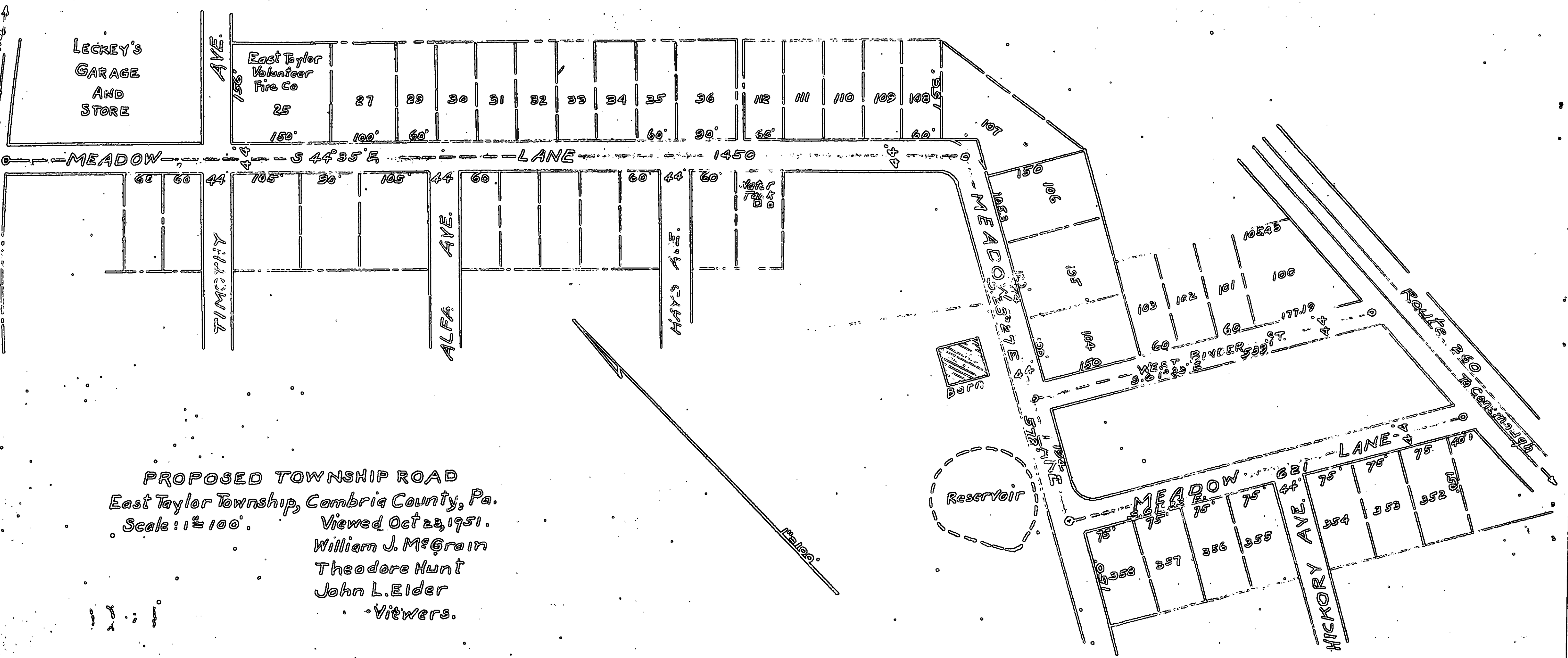

PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS IN
AND FOR CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

The Petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the said Township of East Taylor, in the County of Cambria, respectfully represents:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of public roads and highways in the said Township of East Taylor to begin at a point at the junction of State Highway Route No. 219 and Meadow Lane as marked on the Plan attached hereto and extending in a southeasterly direction a distance of approximately one thousand four hundred and fifty feet; thence continuing in a southwesterly direction approximately five hundred feet; thence continuing in a southeasterly direction a distance of approximately six hundred and fifty feet to State Highway Route No. 260.

Also the public highway beginning at a point on State Highway Route 260 and extending in a southeasterly direction a distance of approximately five hundred twenty-eight and twenty-four hundredths feet to a point intersecting with Meadow Lane and known as West Binder Street; all of which is shown on a blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof as "EXHIBIT A."

The approximate distance from the beginning of the said township road to an intersecting State Highway is approximately two thousand five hundred and ninety-nine feet measured from the center line of the State Highway

Route No. 219 along the proposed township highway known as Meadow Lane to a State Highway Route No. 260. The last named terminus of said public road is on a public highway.

Your petitioners further represent that the first of the termini of the proposed public road or said township highway as hereinabove set forth; and that the proposed township highway is one necessary for public travel. The above is more fully set forth and shown on "EXHIBIT A."

A copy of the written notice to the Supervisors of said East Taylor Township and to the Commissioners of said Cambria County of the intended presentation of this application, with the acceptance of service thereon, is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT B."

A Release of Damages whereby the owners of property abutting the aforesaid proposed road, releasing the said Township of East Taylor from any damages they have sustained or may seem liable to sustain by reason of the accepting, opening, gradings, draining, improving and maintaining of said proposed township highway is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT C."

Your Petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Court of Cambria County to appoint three members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they see the necessity therefore, lay out the same and make report as required by law.

Also the public highway beginning at a point on State Highway Route 260 and extending in a southeasterly direction a distance of app. 528.24 hundredths feet to a point intersecting with Meadow Lane and known as West Binder St.; all of which is shown on a blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof as EXHIBIT A. The approximate distance from the beginning of the said township road to an intersecting State Highway is approximately 2599 feet measured from the center line of the State Highway Route No. 219 along the proposed township highway known as Meadow Lane to a State Highway Route No. 260. The last named terminus of said public road is on a public highway. and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Wm. J. McGrain surveyor, and John L. Elder and Theodore Hunt viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
