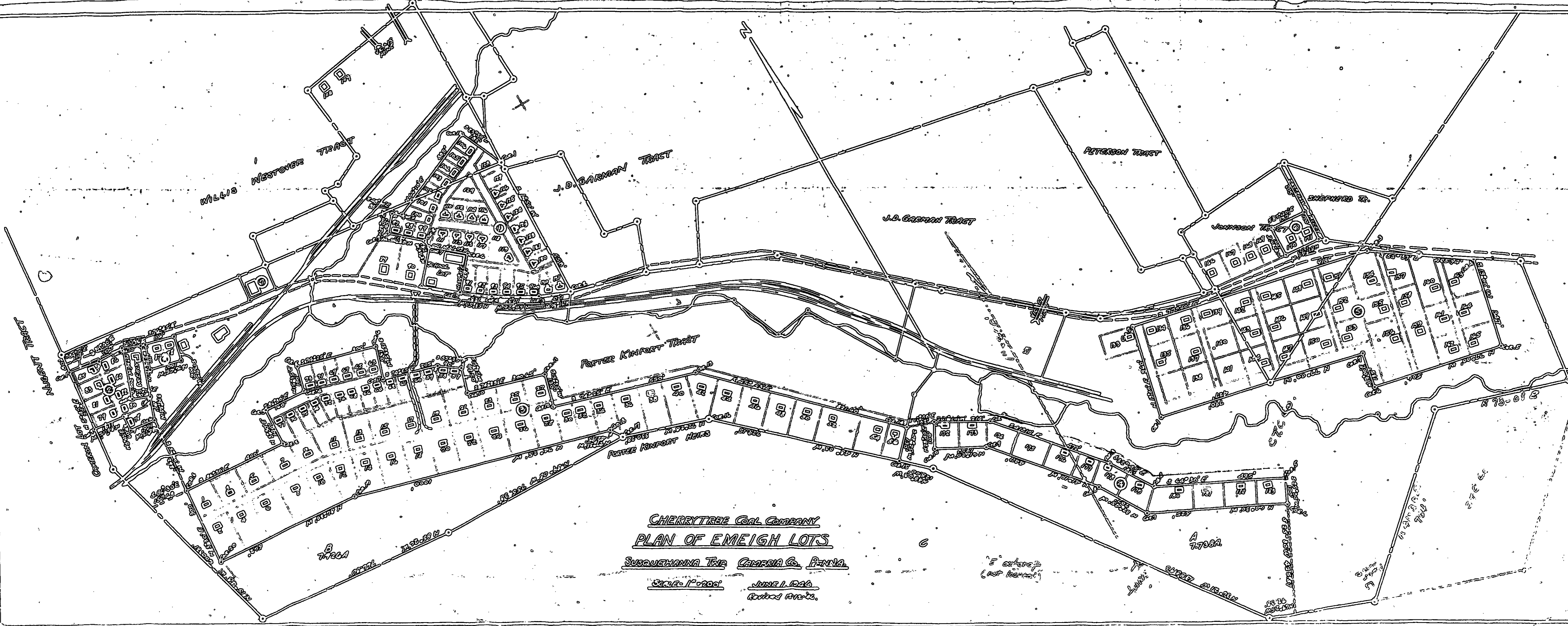

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO ACCEPT STREETS
AS PUBLIC HIGHWAYS

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Stanley Zemrose, Michael Byrnes and Alvin Byrnes, Supervisors of the Township of Susquehanna, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

1. That on the 27th day of June, 1946, the Cherrytree Coal Company, dedicated to public use, all streets, alleys, roads or driveways as the same are now laid out or used in connection with the houses, buildings and land of the Cherrytree Coal Company in the Village of Emeigh in the Township of Susquehanna, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said deed with plan attached being recorded in the office for the recording of deeds in and for the County of Cambria in Deed Book Vol. 535 page 697.
2. That the Supervisors of the Township of Susquehanna accept the streets on said plan as they appear on the blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof, tinted in green, as public highways of the Township of Susquehanna, in accordance with the authority vested in them under Section 1147 of the Amendatory Act of 1943 P. L. 590, subject to the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
3. That attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, is a certified copy of the resolution of the Board of Supervisors of said Township of Susquehanna, adopted September 28 1952, by unanimous vote of said Supervisors, duly recorded and entered upon the minutes of said Board of Supervisors.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that the Court may approve the acceptance of said streets as public highways by

the Supervisors of the Township of Susquehanna.



RESOLUTION.

Whereas, on June 27, 1946, the Cherrytree Coal Company by deed dedicated to public use all streets, alleys, roads and driveways as the same are now laid out or used in connection with the houses, buildings and land of the Cherrytree Coal Company in the Village of Emeigh, in the Township of Susquehanna, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said deed with the plan attached being recorded in the office for the recording of deeds in and for the County of Cambria in Deed Book Vol. 535 page 697.

And Whereas, the Board of Supervisors of Susquehanna Township desire to adopt, approve, record and accept, with the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, as public highways of the Township of Susquehanna the streets on said plan, on the blue print attached to this resolution, and made a part hereof, tinted in green in accordance with the authority vested in them under Section 1147 of the Amendatory Act of 1943 P. L. 590.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, by the unanimous vote of said Board, that the streets appearing on the plan attached to this resolution, and made a part hereof, tinted in green, be adopted, approved and recorded as dedicated streets under the plan recorded as above, and that the same be accepted by the Supervisors of the Township of Susquehanna, as public highways of the Township of Susquehanna.

And Be it Further Resolved, that a petition be executed by the Supervisors of the Township of Susquehanna and filed in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County for the purpose of obtaining the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County to the acceptance of such streets as public

highways of the Township of Susquehanna.
