TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF
CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

The Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township having given ten (10) days' notice to the property owners effected, of which notice a copy is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT A", met at the Judges' Chambers in the United States National Bank Building, in the City of Johnstown, on December 21, 1951, at 1:30 o'clock P.M.

At this hearing, the matter was considered and the Supervisors decided in favor of exercising their power to lay out and open Lindbergh Avenue, and thereupon, on December 21, 1951, passed a Resolution, a copy of which is hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT B".

Within ten (10) days after the passage and approval of this Resolution, notice was given thereof by posting ten (10) handbills in conspicuous places along the line of the property and improvements, a copy of said notice being hereto attached, made part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT C".

Within sixty (60) days after the hearing, the Supervisors notified the person designated in the petition, namely Mary E. Bissett, of their action thereon by handing to her the following notice:

"You are hereby notified that the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, on the 21st day of December, 1951, acted favorably on your petition to lay out and open Lindbergh Avenue and passed the following Resolution:
