At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 15th day of December A. D. 19120, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Blacklick, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from a point in the elbow of the public road leading from Carrolltown to Bethel which point is 4700 feet from the point where the road leading to Colver intersects with said road in land of the Commercial Coal Mining Company, and to end at a point on the public road leading from Bethel to Nanty Glo, which point is at the point where said road intersects with a public road leading to the Clay Pike near the Bethel School in the Township of Blacklick, aforesaid

~~The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three persons from the Board of Viewers, qualified according to law, to view the ground proposed for said road, and, if they see occasion, to lay out the same; and to inquire of and vacate that portion of the public road above referred to, known as the road leading from Carrolltown to Bethel beginning at the aforementioned elbow 4700 feet from the junction of the road leading to Colver and said road, thence extending in a southeasterly direction a distance of approximately 4000 feet to where said Carrolltown and Bethel road intersects with the road known as the Clay Pike at or near the Baptist Church in the Village of Bethel and also to inquire of and vacate the public road leading from the public road running from Bethel to Nant Y Glo where said road intersects with said Bethel and Nant Y Glo road near the Bethel School House in length approximately 3000 feet; which roads sought to be vacated will by reason of the laying out of the proposed road become useless; and to make report of their proceedings to the next term of Court.~~

~~and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint~~

~~viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.~~

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of  
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the permanent board of viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court, upon the attached order, to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying certain portions of township road in Blacklick Township, Cambria Co., Pa., respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Blacklick Township by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini and along the route of the portions of road proposed to be vacated and supplied; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability:

All of us met, in accord with the notices so given, at the cross roads in the Village of Bethel, said township, county and state, and having gone over the portions of road in question and carefully considered the necessity for the piece of new road proposed to be supplied, and the propriety of vacating the portions of road suggested to be vacated and are of the opinion that there is not a legal necessity for the proposed piece of new road and that the portions of old road in question should not be vacated.

A plot or draft showing the location of the pieces of road referred to on the attached order is hereto attached and made a part of this report: The first piece of road proposed to be vacated, beginning at the cross-roads in Bethel, (Point marked "A" on attached draft), takes the following courses and distances, viz: North 32° East 518 ft., North 2° West 685 ft., North 4° West 137 ft., North 43° West 382 ft., North 12° 15' West 301 ft., North 8° 30' West 383 ft., North 70° West 723 ft., and North 22° West 28 ft.; to point marked "B" on said draft; at the

elbow in the Bethel-Carrolltown road designated as the point of beginning of the piece of road proposed to be supplied: and the second piece of road proposed to be vacated begins at point marked "D" on draft and is designated as the point of ending of the piece of road proposed to be supplied, near the Bethel School on the road leading from Bethel to Cardiff and Nanty-Glo and extends thence North 27° 30' East 558 ft., North 56° East 337 ft. and North 5° 10' East 1908 ft. to a point on the Clay Pike designated on said draft as point "F", and the piece of road proposed to be supplied begins at point "B" on draft, at the elbow in the Bethel-Carrolltown road and takes the following courses and distances; South 24° 30' West 132 ft., South 39° West 133 ft., South 61° West 347 ft., South 87° West 128 ft., South 61° 15' West 338 ft., North 64° West 155 ft., North 77° 30' West 156 ft., South 42° West 261 ft., South 28° 30' West 411 ft., South 25° 30' West 412 ft., South 23° 45' West 682 ft. to a point on the North side of the Clay Pike and thence continuing across said Pike, South 16° 30' West 397 ft., South 11° 15' West 525 ft., South 1° ~~XXX~~ West 670 ft., South 1° 50' West 394 ft., South 12° 45' East 198 ft., South 14° 45' East 312 ft., South 12° East 280 ft., South 17° 30' East 170 ft. to the point of ending, marked "D", near the Bethel School.


