That the iron bridge located on the road leading from Salix to Dunlo where said road crosses the branch of the Little Conemaugh River known as the Yellow Run Creek near the Village of Dunlo and more particularly located at a point four hundred fifty (450) feet Northwest of a point where the road leading to Llanfair and Sautertown intersects with the Salix-Dunlo road is in a very bad state of repairs, so much so that it is a menace and dangerous to the travelling public:

That the said bridge is insufficient to accomodate the public travel and is dangerous on account of its roadway not being of sufficient width that it will neither sustain nor permit two vehicles to pass on the present structure., which is twelve feet wide

That the said bridge should be re-constructed and made sufficient width to correspond with the Highway which is now under process of permanent construction.

That the said bridge is a county bridge and was built by the Commissioners of Cambria County, Pennsylvania many years ago under proper proceedings governing such action and according the the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided.

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as shown by the records of the Court, that due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers was given by publication in the Johnstown Daily Tribune and the Cambria County Legal Journal, and by hand bills posted on the premises, and by notices served upon the Chief Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and on the Contractor Thiel Construction Company and upon L. R. Owen, County Engineer, all of whom accepted service as shown by copies of said notices hereto attached and made a part of this report, at least ten days prior to the making of said view and inspection; that we met upon the premises according to the notices given on Tuesday, December 16th. A. D. 1924 at 11 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.







We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria county appointed by your honorable Court, upon the attached order, to view and determine as to the expediency of erecting a new, wider and more substantial bridge over the Yellow Run Creek on the road leading from Salix to Dunlo, in the Village of Dunlo, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria county and the Supervisors of the Township of Adams and having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the proposed new bridge; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability:

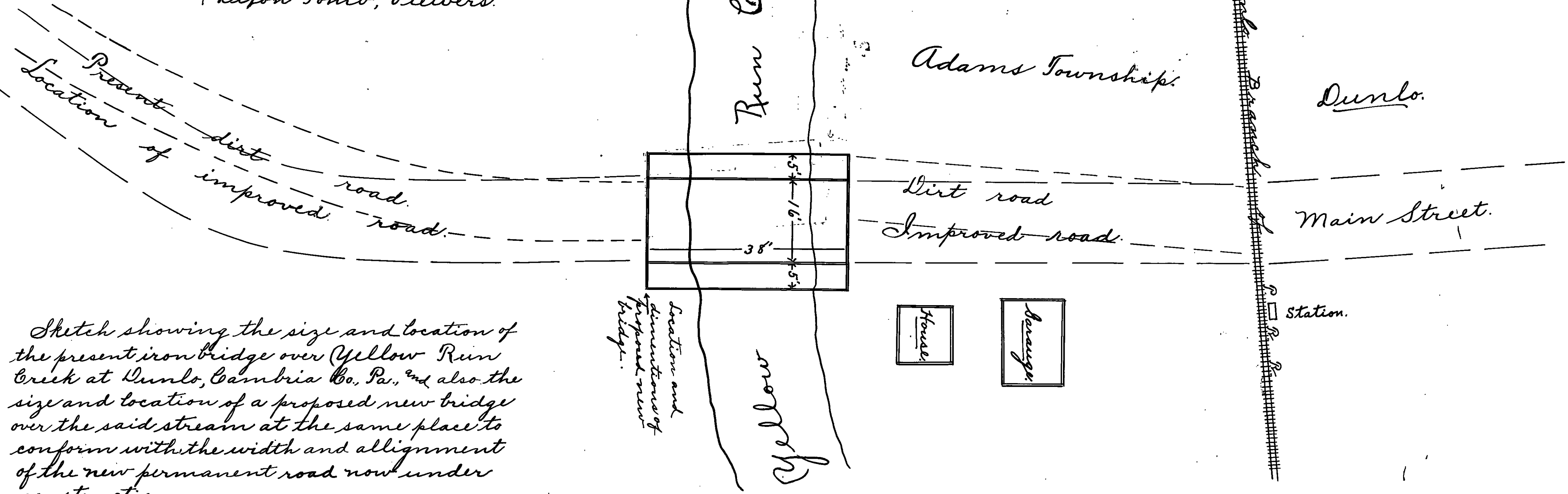
