

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court, upon the attached order, and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying certain portions of a township road in Allegheny Township, said county and state, between the terminal points therein specified, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of said township, as evidenced by their acceptance of service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the piece of road to be viewed, all of us met at the time and place appointed and having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: we viewed the premises and are of the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and accordingly we proceeded to vacate the piece of said road beginning at a point North 27° 30' East 441 ft. along the old road from where it is intersected by the Ebensburg Branch of the P.R.R. and extending as follows, North 21° 30' West 932 ft., North 17° 50' West 373 ft., North 53° 40' East 57.75 ft., South 83° East 352 ft., North 64° 55' East 177 ft., North 51° East 288 ft., North 30° East 98.5 ft., to the end of piece of road to be vacated and to supply a piece of road taking the following courses and distances from the point of ending of the portion proposed to be vacated, viz: South 15° 45' West 520 ft., South 20° West 506 ft., and South 4° 30' West 600 ft. to the point of beginning of the piece of road proposed to be vacated.

A plot or draft showing the courses and distances of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and the piece of road proposed to be supplied is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

Having failed to obtain a release of damages from the parties thru

and over whose land the piece of road proposed to be supplied passes we have assessed them damages as follows, to Willim Hogue one hundred dollars and to Litzinger Brothers sixty dollars.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 9th day of May, A.D. 1921, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court; Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Allegheny, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience by reason of steep grades, sharp curves and swampy places in a part of the public road leading from Munster to Loretto Road Station, a part of which road they desire to vacate and to have another road laid out in its stead.

They therefore pray that that part of the said public road which leads from Ebensburg Junction on the Ebensburg Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad to the road leading from Loretto to Ebensburg, all of which is in Allegheny Township, shall be vacated between these points, and a new road located and laid out in its stead; the points of beginning and ending of the said road required to be set out under the provisions of the Act of Assembly are as follows: "Beginning at the point where said road intersects with the Ebensburg Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad at Ebensburg Junction and ending at a point near Loretto Road Station where said road intersects the road leading from Loretto to Ebensburg, five thousand two hundred and eighty (5280) feet North from the point where the road leading from Chest Springs to Loretto intersects the road leading from Loretto to Ebensburg at the main entrance to the estate of Charles M. Schwab".

And, further pray that a new road be laid out between said points above mentioned, at a proper grade and curvature to eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of the said road.

They therefore pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers for vacating the road for the purpose above specified

And, they will ever pray, etc.

The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint A. M. Shoemaker, surveyer, and Adam Shuman J. D. Ritter viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.
