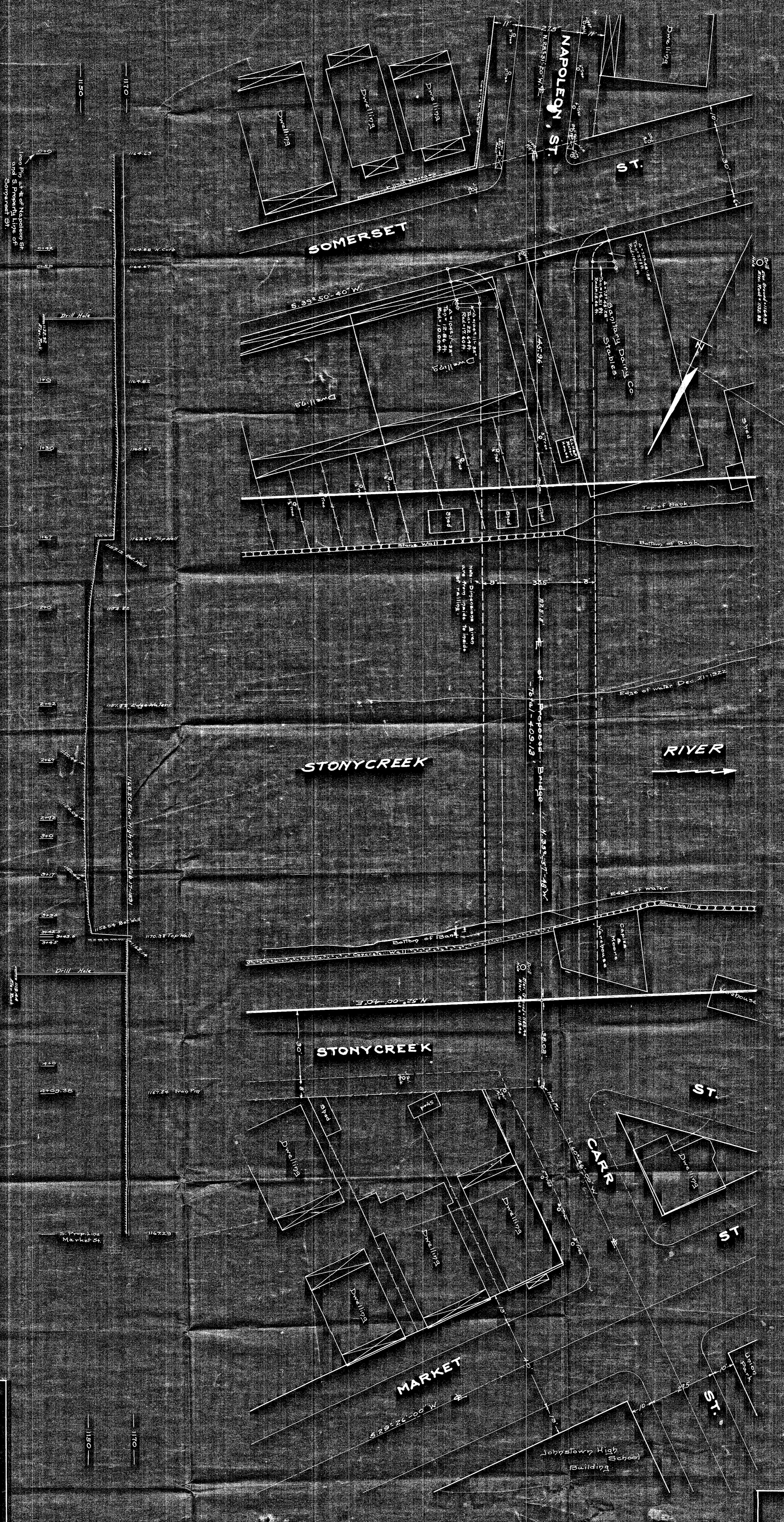

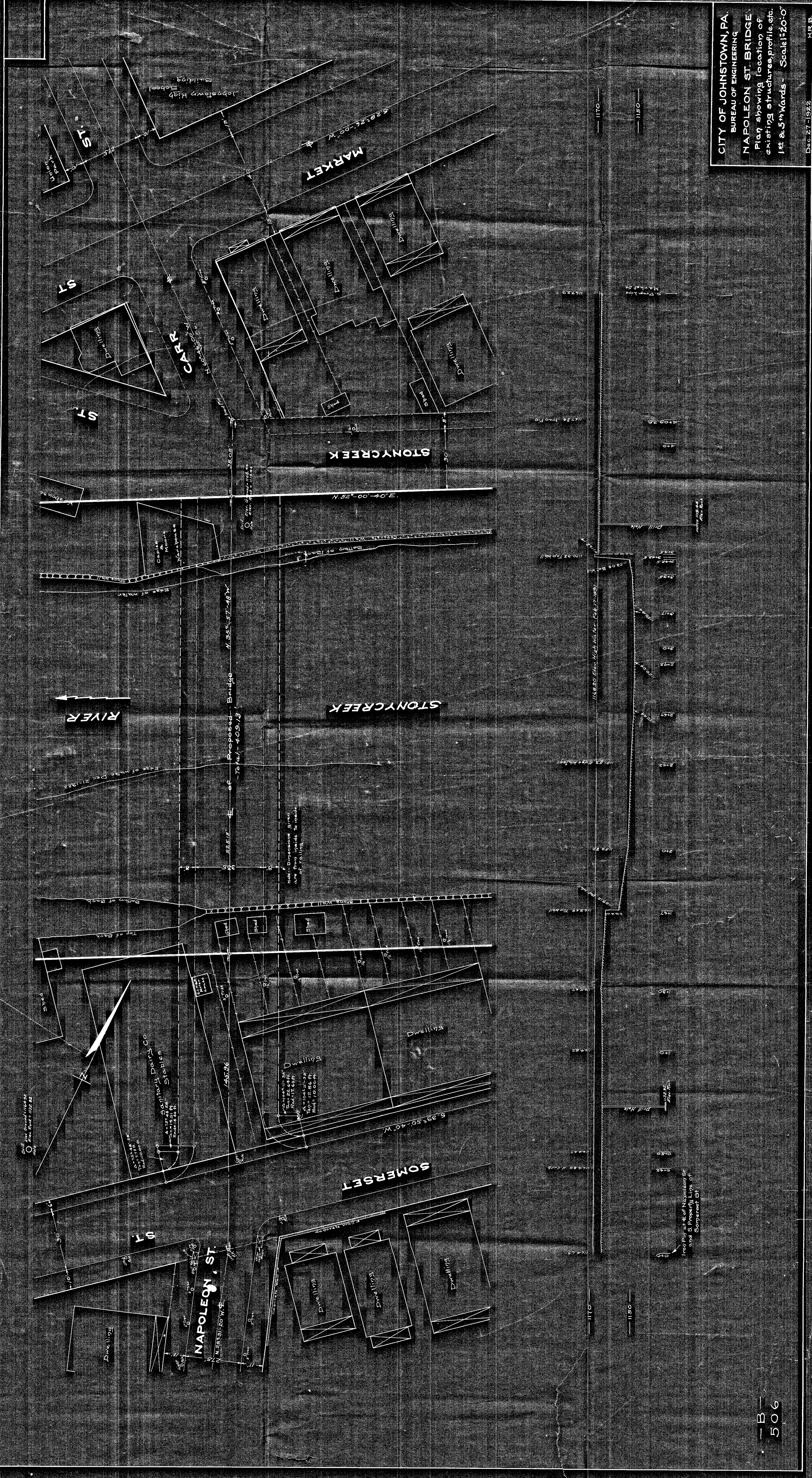

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION BY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, in the matter of the petition of the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown for the appointment of Viewers to view the site for a bridge over the Stonycreek River, connecting Napoleon Street in the Fifth Ward with Carr Street in the First Ward of said City, the report of Viewers was filed on the 4th day of June, 1923, and was on the 7th day of September, 1923, submitted by the Court to the Grand Jury, and the Grand Jury having found that the erection of such bridge will require more expense than it is reasonable for the City of Johnstown, a city of the third class, to bear, and the County Commissioners not deeming it advisable to enter such bridge on record as a County bridge, and the Grand Jury having recommended that the County Commissioners furnish the City of Johnstown, out of the County funds, the sum of ✓

That they were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the said Court, gave due public notice of the time and place of the meeting of said Viewers by publication in the Johnstown Daily Tribune and by handbills posted upon the premises and by notice served upon the Commissioners of Cambria County and upon Tillman K. Saylor, Esq. Solicitor for the City of Johnstown, at least ten days prior to the time of the making of said view, evidence of which is shown by copy of said notices hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met upon the premises according to the notices given on Tuesday, May 8th, 1923 at 9:30 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

We viewed the site and locality of the Bridge proposed to be built, making a personal inspection of the grounds at the points designated in the petition and order.

We find that the proposed new bridge is necessary because of present traffic, congestion and conditions, therefore, we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for a bridge at this site and that the expense of erecting said bridge of sufficient size to take care of the present and future traffic would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and more than the said City should bear, therefore, we proceeded to lay out said bridge having due respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for same and in such manner as would as near as practicable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time do the least injury to private property, a plot or draft showing the location of said proposed bridge is hereto attached and made a part of this report. The termini of said proposed bridge being shown in said draft.




