

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:-

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township of Blacklick, in said County, respectfully represents:-

That the public road leading from the Nicktown Road to the Ivison Road, in the Township of Blacklick, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, is a main thoroughfare, and a much traveled highway.

That a portion of said road has been relocated, and crosses a creek known as the Blacklick Creek or Dutch Run, at a point on said road 81 yards West of the point where the Cambria & Indiana Railroad crosses the said road, and about 85 yards in a Southwesterly direction from Adams Station on said Cambria & Indiana Railroad, in said Township of Blacklick.

That no bridge has ever been erected over said Creek at this point, and that it is necessary that one be erected.

That the cost of constructing such a bridge requires a larger expenditure of money than it is reasonable for the Township of Blacklick to bear.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers to make an investigation and report to your Honorable Court the advisability of erecting a bridge, and whether or not the erection of such a bridge requires more expense than it is reasonable that the said Township should bear.

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court to view and determine as to the necessity for a new bridge over Blacklick Creek, on the new road as recently laid out near Adams Station, on the Cambria & Indiana Railroad, in Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully report:-

That having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; and having given due notice of the time and place of meeting to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of the Township of Blacklick, and having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places in the vicinity of the location proposed for said proposed new bridge:

All of us met at the time and place appointed and having gone over and carefully viewed the situation and found as follows:-

That a new public road has recently been laid out across said Blacklick Creek, at the point suggested for the proposed new bridge;

That there is no bridge whatever by means of which said Creek may be crossed at the suggested location on the new road as laid out and approved:

That the old bridge on the piece of road which crosses said creek at a point about one hundred and eighty eight feet to the North East of the present suggested location; which said piece of road has recently been vacated; is in a bad state of repair and so far as can be ascertained, is unsafe for public travel;

That the cost of constructing a suitable and permanent bridge across said creek at the place suggested will be more than the taxpayers of the township of Blacklick should be required to bear; and,

Having found the above facts we are of the opinion that a new and more substantial bridge over Blacklick Creek, at the location above mentioned, is necessary for the accomodation of the traveling public and that the costs of constructing a suitable bridge should be borne by the County of Cambria.
