

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court.

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the above Court, to view the premises for the purpose of supplying a public highway in the Township of Portage, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, beginning at a point on line between the Borough of Portage and the Township of Portage at the intersection of Johnson Avenue and Blair Street, in the Township of Portage, and extending in a Northwesterly direction a distance of approximately three thousand six hundred seventy-five (3675) feet to the intersection of Lakeview Street with the township road leading from Portage to Johnstown, in the Township of Portage, respectfully report:-

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as shown by the records of said Court, gave due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers by publication in the Portage Dispatch and the Cambria County Legal Journal, by handbills posted on the premises and by notices served upon the Commissioners of Cambria County, upon the Secretary of the Board of Supervisors of Portage Township and upon David Weaver for the petitioners, at least ten days prior to the time of the making of said view, evidence of which is shown by copies of said Notice hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met upon the premises according to the Notice given on Tuesday, July 1st.,

A. D. 1924, at 10 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

We viewed the site and locality of the road proposed to be laid out, making a personal inspection of the ground between the points designated in the petition and order.

We are of the opinion and agree that a public road between the points mentioned is necessary, and that we authorize the laying out of a road according to the accompanying draft.

We therefore lay out and return for public use a road taking the following courses and distances:-

BEGINNING at a point on the line between the Borough of Portage and the Township of Portage at the intersection of Blair Street and Johnson Avenue, thence from said point and place of beginning as indicated on draft hereto attached and made a part of this report and through center line of Johnson Avenue North Eighty-six (86°) degrees Thirty ($30'$) minutes West a distance of One Thousand Four hundred twenty (1420) feet to a point, thence from the said point in center of Johnson Avenue aforesaid North Fifty-one (51°) degrees West a distance of Two Hundred two and four tenths (202.4) feet to a point in center line of Maple Street; thence along said center North Three (3°) degrees East a distance of Two hundred Twelve and five tenths (212.5) feet to a point intersection of Maple Street and Sonman Avenue; thence along center of Sonman Avenue North Eighty-six (86°) degrees Thirty ($30'$) minutes West a distance of Seven Hundred fourteen (714) feet to a point intersection of Sonman Avenue and Lakeview Street; thence along the center line of Lakeview Street North Thirty-seven (37°) degrees Thirty ($30'$) minutes West a distance of Three Hundred thirty-four (334) feet to a point in center of street; thence from said point North Eleven (11°) degrees Twenty ($20'$) minutes West a distance

of Five Hundred Thirty-nine (539) feet to a point and the center of the road leading from Portage to Johnstown, said point being the terminus.

We allow no damages to the abutting property owners as affected by the laying out of the above road because we consider the advantages which will accrue to their respective properties by reason of the laying out of said road are equivalent to all damages which will be sustained by them. Streets and alleys as indicated on the draft hereto attached, except the portion of Blair Street in Portage Borough have been laid out and dedicated but have not been opened as public thoroughfares.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
