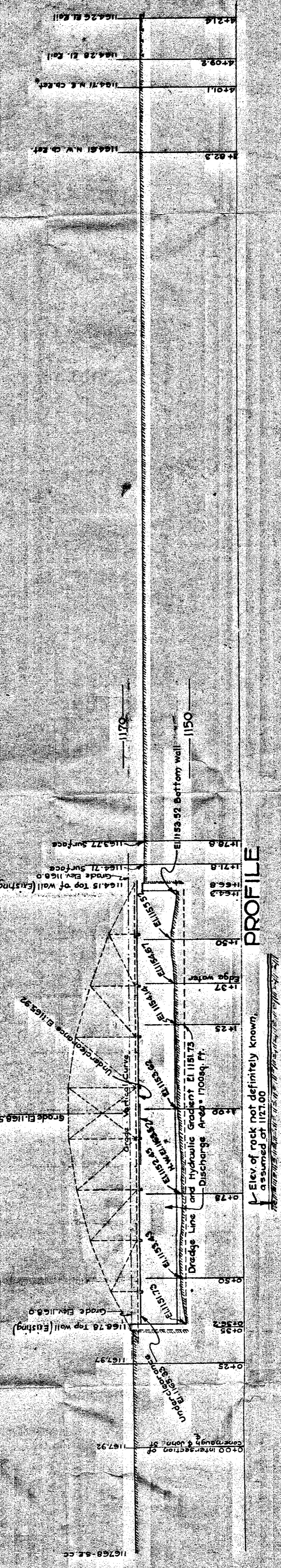

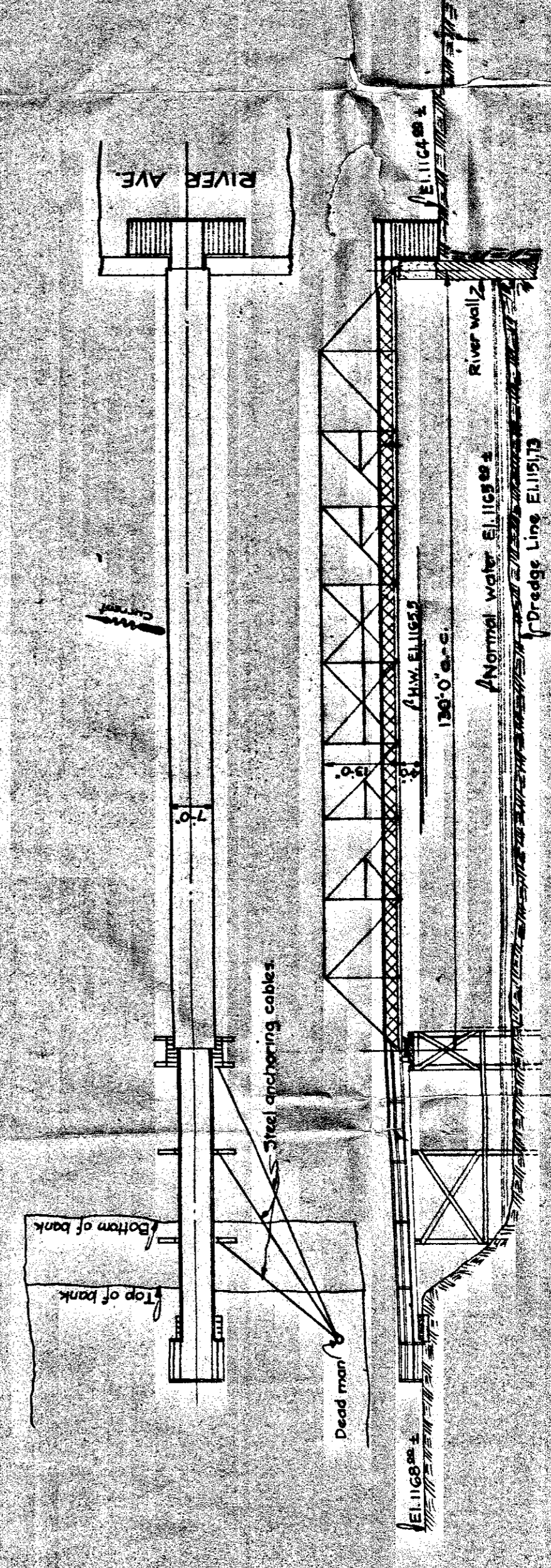

REPORT OF VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed Order of the above Court to view the place proposed for the bridge over the Little Conemaugh River on John Street in the Second Ward of the City of Johnstown and the Thirteenth Ward of the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully report:-

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as Members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County as is shown by the records of said Court; that we gave due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers by publication in the Johnstown Daily Tribune and in the Cambria County Legal Journal, and by hand bills posted on the premises and by notices served upon the Commissioners of Cambria County and upon Tillman K. Saylor, Esq., Solicitor of the City of Johnstown at least ten days prior to the time of the making of said view, evidence of which is shown by a copy of said notices hereto attached and by acceptance of service by the Commissioners of Cambria County and by Tillman K. Saylor, Esq., Solicitor for the City of Johnstown, and made a part of this report; that we met upon the premises according to the notice given on Friday, February 25, A. D. 1927, at ten thirty o'clock A. M., and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

We viewed the site and locality of the bridge proposed to be built, making a personal inspection of the grounds and points designated in the petition and order.

We find that the proposed new bridge is over the Little Conemaugh River, connecting John Street in the Second Ward with the Thirteenth Ward of the City of Johnstown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and we are of the opinion that a necessity exists for a bridge at this point, and that the expenses of erecting said bridge of sufficient size to take care of the traffic would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown, and that said expense is greater than the City of Johnstown is able to bear, therefore, we proceeded to lay out said bridge having due respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for the same in such manner as would be as near as practicable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time to the least injury to private property, a plot or draft showing the location of said proposed bridge is hereto attached and made a part of this report. The termini of said proposed bridge being shown in said draft.

We gave due consideration to the matter before us, and we are of the opinion that there is a necessity for the said bridge as laid out, and further that the expenses of erecting same would be burdensome upon the inhabitants of the City of Johnstown and more than it is reasonable that they should bear, and that the bridge is necessary for the traveling public, therefore, we recommend the proper assistance by the County of Cambria.



"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

above stated case having been by order of the Court laid before the Grand
Jury, after hearing witnesses produced and counsel for the petitioners, the
Grand Jury are of the opinion and do find that the aforesaid bridge is neces-
sary, and that the erection of the same will require more expense than it is
reasonable for the City of Johnstown, a city of the third class in said coun-
ty, to bear, and the County Commissioners not deeming it advisable to enter
said bridge on record as a county bridge, we consider and find that it is
proper to assist the said City in the building and erection of said bridge,
and we therefore recommend that the Commissioners of Cambria County furnish
the City of Johnstown out of County funds the sum of
