
IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

THE PETITION OF THE UNDERSIGNED RESPECTFULLY REPRESENTS:

1. That they are the duly elected and qualified Commissioners of Cambria County.
2. That some years ago a County Bridge was erected over a branch of the Susquehanna River in Susquehanna Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and has been maintained and repaired since that time by the County of Cambria.
3. That said Bridge is located on the road leading from Barnesboro to Cherrytree, Burnside, etc., said road being known as Route No. 62 on the General Plan of Roads in the State of Pennsylvania.
4. That said Bridge is approached at either end by improved sections of said Route No. 62.
5. That owing to the increased amount of traffic over this Bridge, due to the number of improved roads which furnish means of vehicular travel and which roads feed Route No. 62, the said Bridge has become insufficient and inadequate to accommodate the public traffic, as it is only a one-way bridge.
6. That in addition to being insufficient and inadequate it has become exceedingly dangerous on account of the damage which has been done to the North abutment of said Bridge by the heavy rains of the Spring and Summer, which said floods partially destroyed the said Bridge.
7. That said North abutment is now held in place by wooden props which have been placed there by the Road Department of Cambria County.
8. That said Bridge is supported in a large measure now by timbers that have been placed under said Bridge as a matter of protection and for safety.

WHEREFORE, Your petitioners pray your Honorable Court to approve the building of a new bridge, without the delay caused by the report of a Grand Jury or Grand Juries, to take the place of the insufficient, inadequate and partially destroyed bridge, and they will ever pray.
