

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, appointed by your honorable Court and in the attached order directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road in Reade Township, said county and state, between the termini therein specified; respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Reade Township, and having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places along the highway and at the termini of the piece of road petitioned to be vacated; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met in accord with the notices so given and posted as aforesaid and having gone over the piece of road proposed to be vacated and viewed the premises we are all of the opinion that the piece of road in question should be vacated.

The piece of road lying between the termini specified in the attached order, a plot or draft of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report, takes the following courses and distances, viz: Beginning on the public road leading between Glasgow and Coalport, known as the Gill Hollow road, at the termini set forth in said attached order and extending thence North thirty nine degrees East four hundred forty eight feet, thence North twenty seven degrees East six hundred six feet, thence North forty degrees East six hundred ten feet and North forty two degrees East four hundred seventy three and five tenth feet to the line dividing the counties of Clearfield and Cambria, this being the other termini mentioned on said attached order.

The portion of this road leading from the line between the two counties to a public road in Clearfield County having been some time since been vacated the Southerly portion of the road, or that part lying in Cambria County, is no longer in use by the general public and hence not necessary as a public road and, in the minds of the viewers, should be vacated.

The Northerly termini of this piece of road abutts the property line of one Clyde F. Kruis, whose farm lies in Clearfield County but who has had his only outlet over this piece of road and he will, upon the vacation of this piece of public road stand in need of a private road or outlet over same; though as he is the only person who has real need for the road it should not, in our opinion, be kept up at the expense of the taxpayers of the Township of Reade.

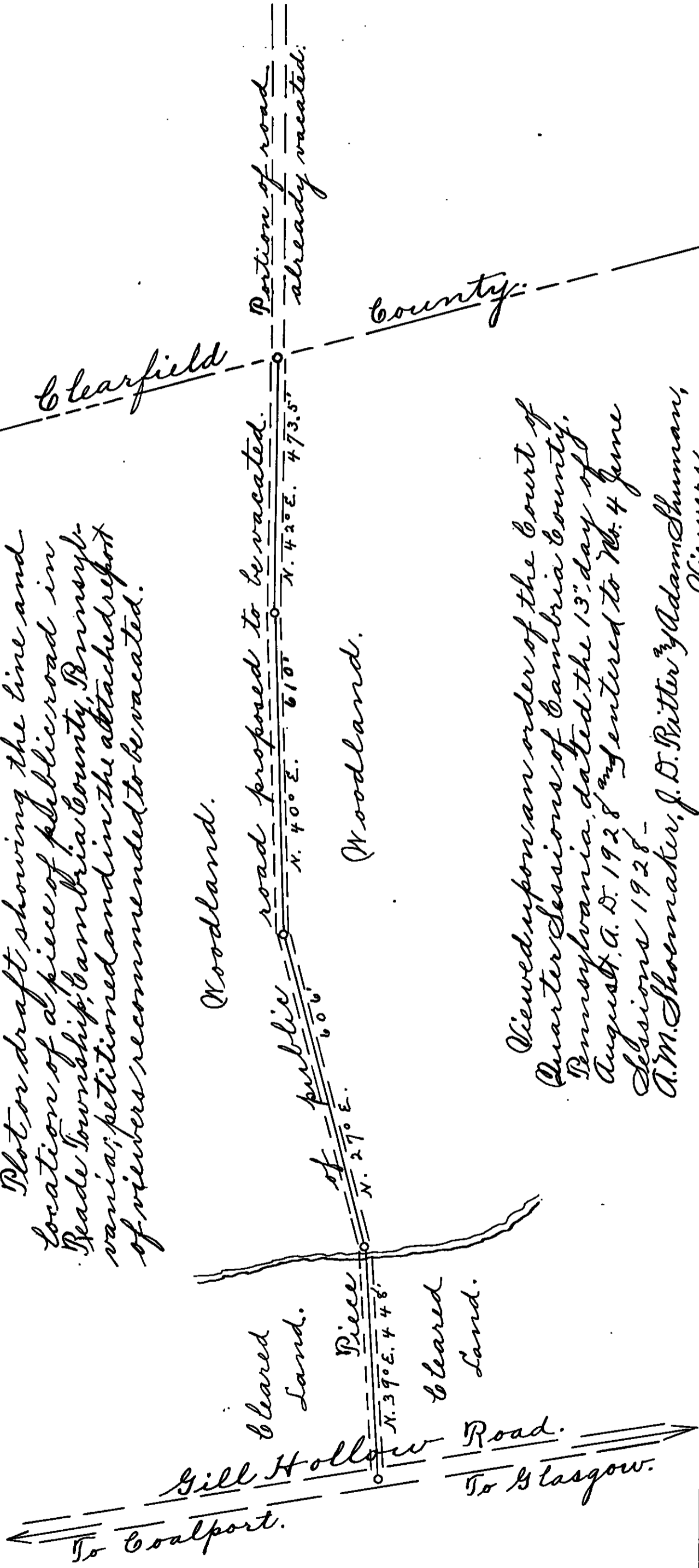

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."



