IN RE CHANGE OF LOCATION ) Of June Sessions, 1927.  
OF ROAD IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP )

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of David H. Stevens, James Mackall  
and A. B. Kerr respectfully represents:

That they are duly elected, qualified and  
acting supervisors of the Township of Jackson in the County of Cambria:

That along a highway in said Township, a  
portion known as the "Upper Johnstown Road" at a point six hundred (600)  
feet, more or less, in a Southerly direction from the intersection of  
said road and the Fresh Road, and extending in said Southerly direction  
a distance of one thousand two hundred fifty (1,250) feet, more or less,  
is in a bad state of repair; is now located at such an elevation that  
it drifts with snow during the winter time and is impassable; and is a  
dangerous curve, the grades of which are steep and uneven.

That the petitioners, as supervisors afore-  
said, deem it advisable to change and alter that portion of the road afore-  
mentioned so as to straighten the same and eliminate the curve aforesaid,  
placing the same at an elevation where it will be passable throughout the  
winter, by re-locating the same on said straight line at a point approxi-  
mately one hundred fifty (150) feet in an Easterly direction from its  
present location.

That the property owners affected by such change have agreed to claim no damage which may be occasioned because of the same.

That by resolution of the Board of Supervisors aforesaid passed on the twenty-third day of June, 1927, the said change and alteration has been deemed to be advisable, subject to the approval of your Honorable Court.

That the said change and alteration will be made at a cost and expense of not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300), a map or draft of the proposed change being hereto attached.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays your Honorable Court to approve such change and alteration so that the new location shall be taken to be the public road, and the old location vacated.

And they will ever pray.

AND NOW, ~~June~~ *July 26*, 1927, it appearing that the supervisors of the Township of Jackson have passed a resolution deeming it advisable to change and alter a part of the "Upper Johnstown Road", a public highway in said Township under their supervision, by eliminating the section of said road shown on the attached map or draft, and have agreed that the property owners affected by such change shall claim no damage caused thereby; and it further appearing that costs and expenses for such change and alteration will not exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300), NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered, adjudged and decreed that the new location, as shown on said attached draft or map, be, and the same is, hereby approved and shall be taken to be the public road, and the old location thereof is hereby vacated.
