

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the permanent board of viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying a certain piece of public road in Gallitzin Township, said county and state, respectfully report:

That having given due and legal notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of the Township of Gallitzin; copies of which notices are hereto attached; and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places near the termini and along the route of the piece of road proposed to be vacated, and each having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met, in accord with the notices so given and posted as aforesaid and having gone over and carefully viewed the situation and agreeing that the present road inconvenient and burdensome and that the situation would be much improved relative to the school property and the alignment of the road, if the prayer of the petitioners were granted, accordingly we proceeded to vacate the present road and lay out a shorter and straighter road between the points of beginning and ending for the new road, as suggested by the petitioners.

Hence we recommend that the old road, which takes the following courses and distances between the termini specified in the attached order of the Court, viz: South 19° East 116.5 feet, South 10° 15' West 122 feet, South 33° 35' West 114 feet and South 31° 48' West 157 feet should be vacated; and a new road between the points of beginning and ending proposed and taking the direction North 37° 40' East 354 feet should be supplied

instead of that vacated.

A plot or draft which is hereto attached and made a part of this report shows the courses, distances and location of the old road recommended to be vacated and also the new road which the viewers believe should be supplied instead of that which they recommend should be vacated.

The viewers being of the opinion that no damages have or will be sustained by reason of the opening and using of the new road as laid out have assessed no damages.

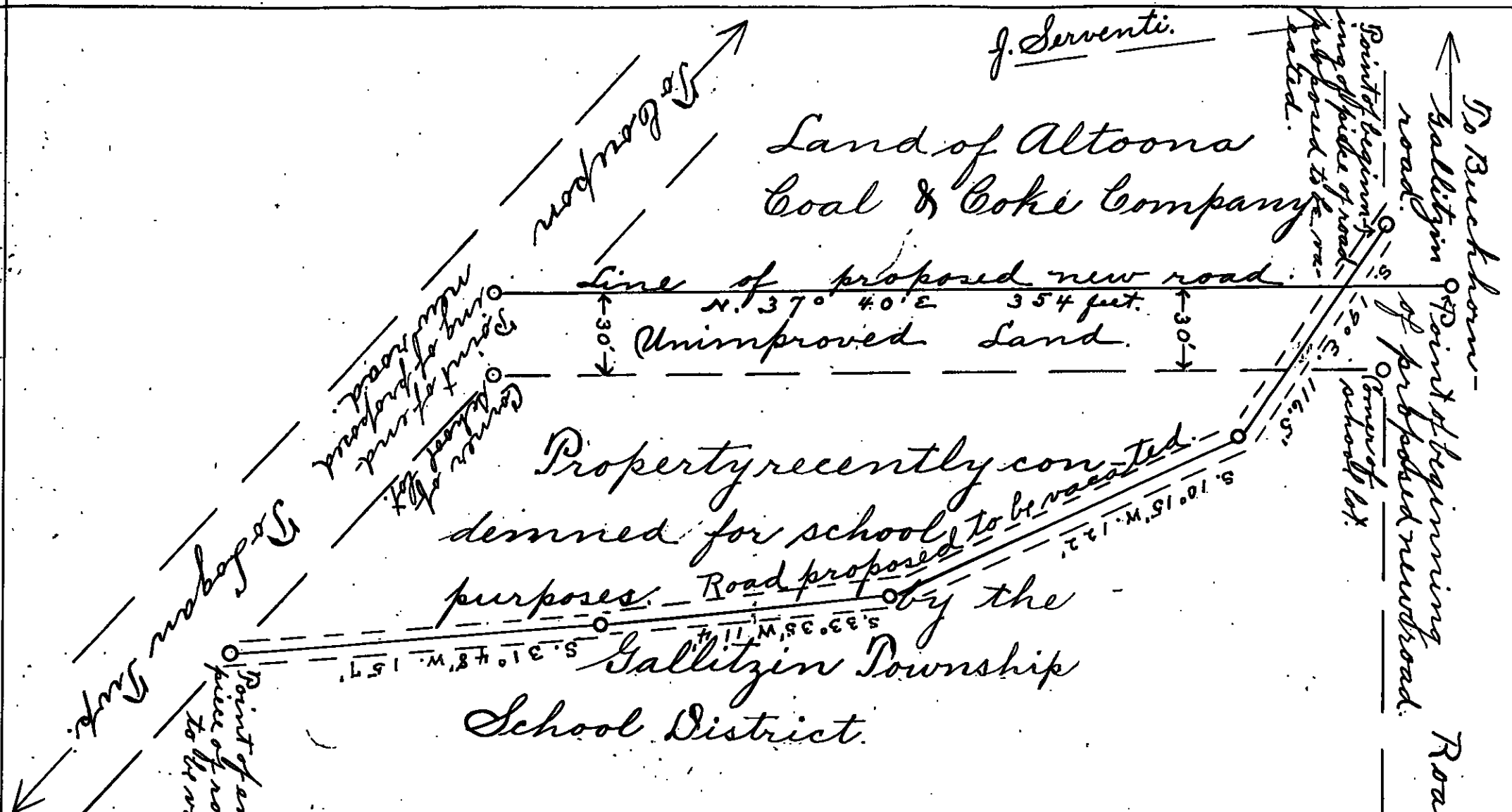

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 24th day of February A. D. 1930, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Gallitzin, in the said County, setting forth that ~~they have under their~~
~~own name for account of xxxxxxxxxxxx Public~~ ~~road or street~~

a road in Gallitzin Township which may or may not be a public road crosses a piece of ground in Gallitzin Township which the School-District of said Township has condemned as a site for a new school building. This road in question has been in public use for a long time and may by that fact have become a public road. The petitioners ask that Viewers be appointed to vacate the road which is described as follows, viz: Beginning on the public road, which leads from the Buckhorn-Gallitzin Road in the village of Coupon to Logan Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, where said Coupon-Logan Township road is adjoined by another public road from the northward at a point approximately 1327 feet South 9° 30' East from said Buckhorn-Gallitzin Road and ending at the juncture of another road or street in said Village at a point 1187 feet south 52° 50' East from said Buckhorn-Gallitzin Road and instead of the piece of road proposed to be vacated to supply a road with the southerly termini on the Coupon-Logan Township road at a point 9° 30' West 162 feet from the point of beginning of the piece of road proposed to be vacated and ending on the public road or street, above referred to, at a point approximately 1062 feet eastward from said Buckhorn-Gallitzin Road. The petitioners further say that if the proposed road is supplied, the former road will become useless and therefore should be vacated by order of the Court.

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
