

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Paennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Perment Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road in Gallitzin Township, said county and state, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County, and having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the Supervisors of the Township of Gallitzin and to the traveling public by posting ten notice of the view in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini and along the route of the piece of road proposed to be vacated; and each having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met at the time and place appointed and having gone over the piece of road proposed to be vacated, noting the condition of same and the land through and over which it passes as well as the location of the new improved highway which now accomodates the traffic which formerly would have used the piece of road in question, and are all of the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and the piece of road mentioned in said petition vacated.

The piece of road viewed and herein recommended to be vacated takes the following courses and distances, viz: Beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 276, leading from Gallitzin Borough to the Borough of Cresson at approximately thirty three hundred ten feet from the juncture of said highway route with the Main Street in the borough of Gallitzin, and extending thence as follows; south 31° 30' east 119 feet, south 27° east 120 feet, north 79° 30' east 123 feet, south 30° 15' east 53 feet, south

71° east 597.5 feet, south 62° 15' east 131 feet, north 52° 05' east 63.5 feet and north 25° 30' east 121 feet to the line of the Borough of Gallitzin.

A plot or draft is hereto attached and made a part of this report showing the location of the road sought to be vacated between the termini indicated on the attached order and the nature of the ground over which the same passes.

Said piece of road has fallen almost entirely into disuse and disrepair, it is rough, hilly and the alignment thereof is such as to present day traffic would be unfavorable and dangerous.

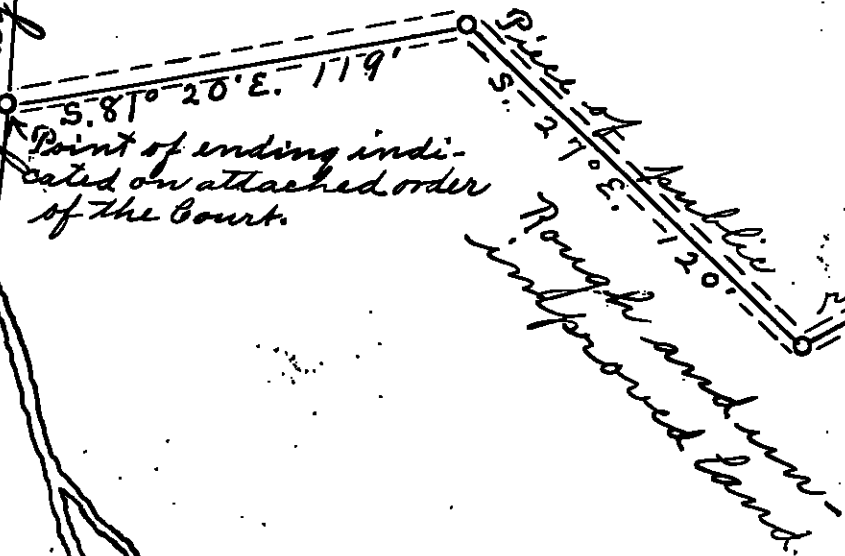

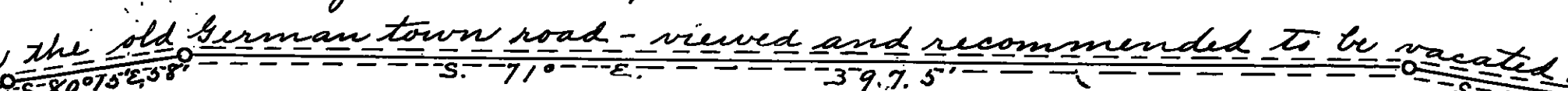

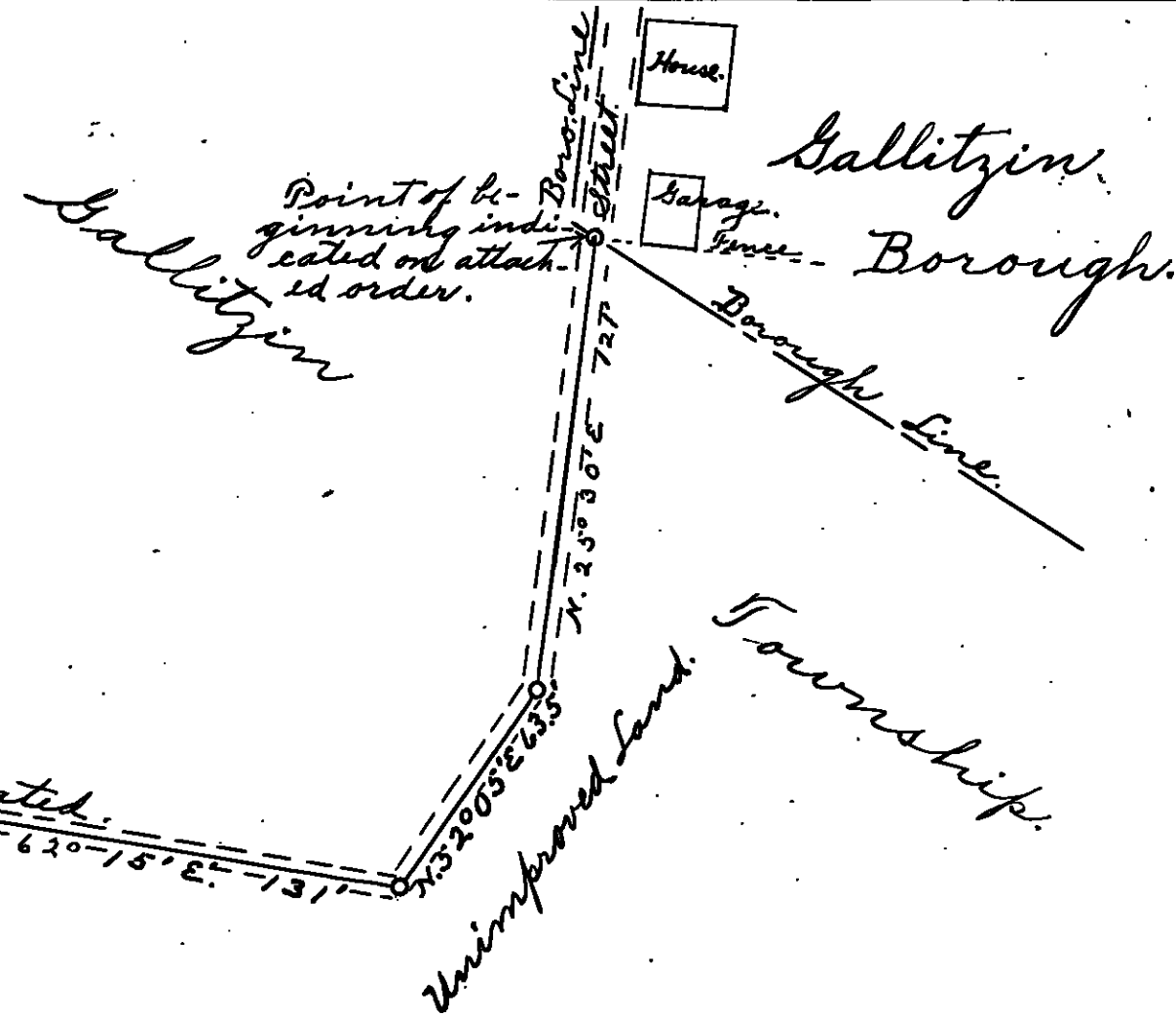

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 2nd day of April A. D. 1950, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Gallitzin, in the said County, setting forth that ~~they labor under in- convenience for want of a~~ road ~~of the County to lead from~~

and old public road, known as the Germantown road has long since been laid out between the Borough of Gallitzin and the Borough of Cresson. That within recent years a new improved highway, known as State Route No. 276, has been opened and in general use. That since the laying out and improving of the new State Highway Route referred to, between the boroughs of Gallitzin and Cresson, through Gallitzin and Cresson townships, that portion of the old road in Gallitzin Township known as the Germantown road, between the line dividing the Borough of Gallitzin from Gallitzin Township and ending at the new improved highway, on said Gallitzin-Cresson road, a distance of approximately three thousand three hundred ten feet from the juncture of said Gallitzin - Cresson road with Main street in the Borough of Gallitzin; there being no intersecting roads in either townships from which the exact distance can be given, has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ~~lay out~~ ^{vacate} the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ ^{vacation} and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ ^{vacation}, they shall proceed to ~~lay out~~ ^{vacate} the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

"It shall be the duty of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private bridge, if they shall decide it is of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and nothing briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and preferring, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
