PETITION TO TRANSFER ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT.

The Petition of the undersigned, Commissioners of Cambria County,
respectfully represents:

1. That a section of one of the Cambria County road, known as the
Brésson Pike Highway, is located in Cambria Township as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Ebensburg Borough and Cambria Township
line at the eastern side of said Ebensburg Borough; thence through said Cambria
Township to the boundary line of Cambria Township and Munster Township, a distance
of approximately two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) miles, more or less.

2. That the section of said road is part of a main highway, known
as the Cresson Pike Highway, and is an improved brick and concrete road.

3. That it is the desire of the County that an effort be made to
have the State of Pennsylvania take over this section of highway, but the petitioners
are informed that the State will take over only sections of roads which are township
roads.

4. That there are other parts of this County road running through
the Townships of Munster and Cresson and petitions will be filed for the purpose
of transferring said sections of said road from the County to the other two
townships.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the portion or section of said
Cresson Pike Highway which lies within Cambria Township may be taken over by and
transferred to the Township of Cambria for the purpose of having the State of
Pennsylvania take over the entire Cresson Pike Highway situate in Cambria County
running through the three Townships of Cambria, Munster and Cresson, and they will
ever pray
