(PETITION TO TRANSFER ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of the undersigned, Commissioners of Cambria County,
respectfully represents:

I. That a section of one of the Cambria County roads, known as the
Benscreek Pike, is located in Upper Yoder Township, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the City line of Johnstown and Franklin Street
of City of Johnstown produced; thence in a southwesterly direction and curving to
the right to a point on the eastern boundary of the Borough of Ferndale for a distance
of one-tenth of a mile, more or less; thence continuing through the Borough of
Ferndale to a point on the western boundary of Ferndale Borough and the Township of
Upper Yoder; thence from this point in a southerly direction to a point on State
Highway Route No. 317 for a distance of three-tenths of a mile, more or less.

2. That the section of said road is part of a main highway, known as
the Benscreek Pike, and is an improved brick and concrete road, including 1/10 mile of
earth road leading to Route No. 52.

3. That it is the desire of the County that an effort be made to have
the State of Pennsylvania take over this section of highway, but the petitioners
are informed that the State will take over only sections of roads which are Township
roads.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the portion or section of said
Benscreek Pike which lies within Upper Yoder Township may be taken over by and
transferred to the Township of Upper Yoder for the purpose of having the State of
Pennsylvania take over the entire Benscreek Pike situate in Cambria County running
through the Township of Upper Yoder, and they will ever pray.
