R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court to view and ascertain the damages, if any, sustained by Howard M. Custer, Sannie Crouse, Phoebe Wonders, Ira E. Custer and Nora S. Wilson by reason of the construction and maintenance of a drain of 12" concrete pipe approximately one hundred seventy five feet long, through and over their premises situate in Croyle Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully report:

That having given due public notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the public and to the parties interested and having had the petitioners and the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle accept service of notices hereto attached, and having posted ten printed hand bills along the public highway near and adjacent to the premises to be viewed, and having each been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and true report to make concerning all matters and things submitted to us in relation to which we were authorized to enquire: We met upon the premises, in accord with the notices so given, and having gone over and carefully viewed the same, we adjourned to meet at the Court House in Ebensburg at a time fixed, of which all parties in interest had due notice; when and where the petitioners or most of them with their attorney appeared and were heard. Later, in accord with the notices served we met again to exhibit our schedule and hear any further testimony which the parties might have to offer.

From viewing the premises and hearing the testimony we learned that a concrete drain of approximately the length set forth in the petition for the appointment of viewers and at the location therein designated. That the said drain lead to and emptied into a natural ravine at a point approximately one hundred fifty

feet

north westward from the spring from which the petitioners obtain their water supply for the residence erected upon the premises and which feeds the trough where they supply water for their stock, said trough being located approximately eighty two feet farther down along said ravine.

That said drain, carrying surface water from the township road would in all probability supply more water directly into the ravine and consequently carry more sediment down said ravine, at least as far or perhaps some distance beyond the watering trough than would ordinarily wash and be carried down from this particular point, that is from the point where said drain pipe empties into said ravine, and thus would in all probability slightly interfere with the locating of a hydraulic ram at a point at or handy to said trough.

That there is no doubt sufficient fall between the spring and the trough to operate such a device at this point and thereby supply water at the barn on the premises which would require a lift of slightly over eight and three tenth feet above the level of the spring; which from the testimony supplies sufficient water for the purpose indicated, and as they testify they desire to install.

That there are however several methods which at slight expense would serve to eliminate the interference with the installation of a hydraulic ram at ^{or in close proximity to} the point they indicate they desire to install same.

That otherwise the damage done or interference with the proper and ordinary use of any part of the farm land or any other damage or inconvenience sustained would be vary slight.

That there no doubt is some little benefit to the farm by reason of the drain having been placed where it is since from the natural topography of the land just at this point it is evident that during rains or wet spells the surface water from the higher land on the opposite side of the road from the residence would necessarily, without the drain, wash over the yard in front of the residence or across the garden or field.

Accordingly, taking into consideration the advantages and dis-

advantages and offsetting one against the other, we are of the opinion that the damages sustained by the property owners in excess of benefits is the sum of one hundred thirty five dollars, which amount we recommend should be paid by the Township of Croyle to the above named petitioners and owners, or joint owners, of the land designated in the order of Court attached hereto.

There was no denial on the part of the Supervisors of said Township of Croyle that they had been responsible for the putting in of said drain pipe.

A plot or draft is hereto attached and made a part of this report, indicating the location of the drain pipe in question and the relative location of the spring, farm house, barn and other out buildings as well as the relative elevation of points which would be of importance in installing such a device as the owners of the premises indicate they desire to install.

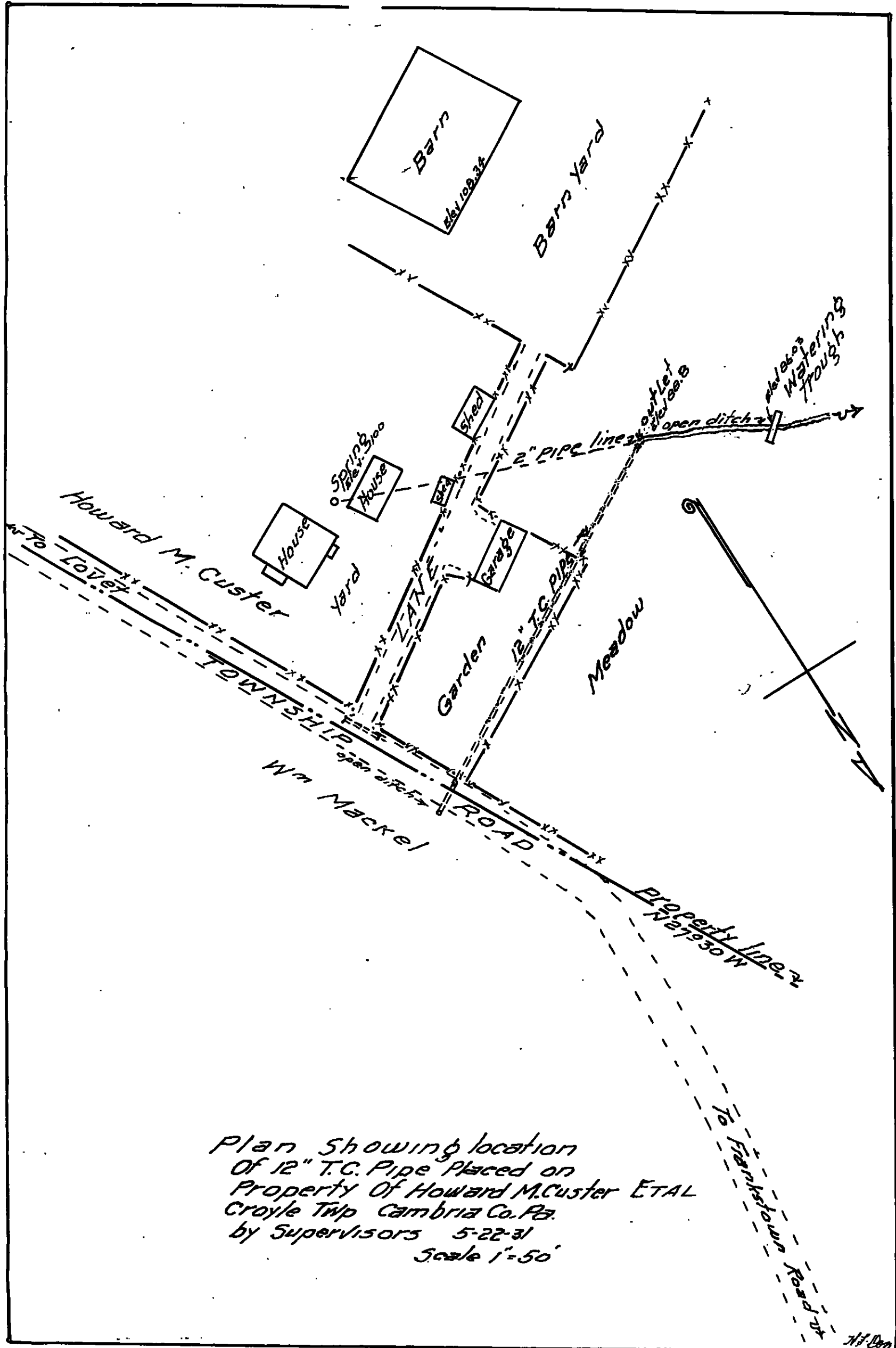


