John Thomas, Jr., offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the State of Pennsylvania has adopted a law whereby the State Highway Department take over certain abandoned turn pikes and toll roads, and

WHEREAS, Cambria County has two such roads, the one leading from Ebensburg to Cresson, approximately seven and one-half ($7\frac{1}{2}$) miles, and the other leading from Johnstown City line south, beginning at a point at the intersection of the City line of Johnstown on Franklin Street and continuing in a southerly direction to the Borough line of Ferndale; thence from a point on the southerly boundary line and the intersection of the above-named road and Upper Yoder Township; thence in a southerly direction to the intersection of State Highway Route No. 317, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commissioners of Cambria County that the State Highway Department take over these roads and adopt them as part of their system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Commissioners of Cambria County, in regular session assembled, do hereby formally turn over the above-mentioned roads to the State Highway Department, and that a copy of this resolution be filed in the office of the Clerk of Courts of Cambria County and with the State Highway Department at Harrisburg.

Motion seconded by Frank P. Hollern and unanimously carried.
