

TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF UPPER YODER TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PA.

WHEREAS, the undersigned are the owners in fee of all the lots abutting on Penn Street in the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said Penn Street having been designated to public use by plot known as the Plan of Elim; said Plan being duly recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, Pa., in Plat Book Vol. 1, page 80; and

WHEREAS, said Penn Street connects with two streets as accepted to public use, to-wit, Hershberger Road as shown on the Plan of Elim as recorded as aforesaid and Christine Court as shown on the Plot of Penn Real Estate Co., recorded in Plat Book Vol. 3, page 14.

WHEREAS, the undersigned hereby petition and desire that the Township shall accept said Penn Street between Hershberger Road and Christine Court as a public thoroughfare of the Township to be incorporated into the system of public highways:

NOW, THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we

owners in fee of all the abutting lots abutting on Penn Street, in consideration of the benefits accruing of the land owned by us, do hereby and by these presents remise, release, quit-claim and forever discharge the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, of and from all manner of damages, actions or accounts for or on account of the accepting as public thoroughfare of the township the hereinafter described thoroughfare, hereby dedicating the same to said township for public use as a highway, subject to township regulations, the following described thoroughfare, a plan thereof being recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. 1, page 80; the said Penn Street beginning at a point on Hershberger Road and extending in a Northerly direction to Christine Court, -- the Plan thereof showing the profile, drainage facilities, etc. being attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Body to adopt a resolution accepting the above described highway as a public thoroughfare of said township to be incorporated into the system of township highways.

CERTIFIED COPY OF RESOLUTION AS ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY
-- FULL MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD OF SUPERVISORS BEING
PRESENT AT MEETING OF SUPERVISORS OF UPPER YODER
TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DULY HELD
ON THE 31st day of December, A. D. 1931.

WHEREAS, a petition was presented by all the owners in fee of all the lots abutting on Penn Street in the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said Penn Street having been designated to public use by Plot known as the Plan of Elim; said Plan being duly recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, in Plat Book Vol. 1, page 80; and

WHEREAS, said Penn Street connects with two (2) streets as accepted to public use, to-wit, Hershberger Road as shown on the Plan of Elim, as recorded as aforesaid, and Christine Court as shown on the Plot of Penn Real Estate Co., recorded in Plat Book Vol. 3, page 14; and

WHEREAS, said petitioners desire that the Township shall accept said Penn Street between Hershberger Road and Christine Court as a public thoroughfare, to be incorporated into the system of township highways; and

WHEREAS, all of the abutting owners have executed a release of and from all manner of damages, etc., as attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said supervisors to accept the above described highway as a public thoroughfare;

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED,

That Penn Street in the said township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, between Hershberger Road and Christine Court be opened and accepted as a public highway of the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as heretofore dedicated to public use on the Plan of Elim; said Plan being duly recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. 1, page 80; and a portion of said Plan as attached hereto being hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the necessary grading and drainage shall be as determined by the Township Engineer;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this action, with the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, be recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, and then filed with the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Penn Street as hereinabove described shall then become a part of the public highway system of the said Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and that the costs of these proceedings be paid by the said Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

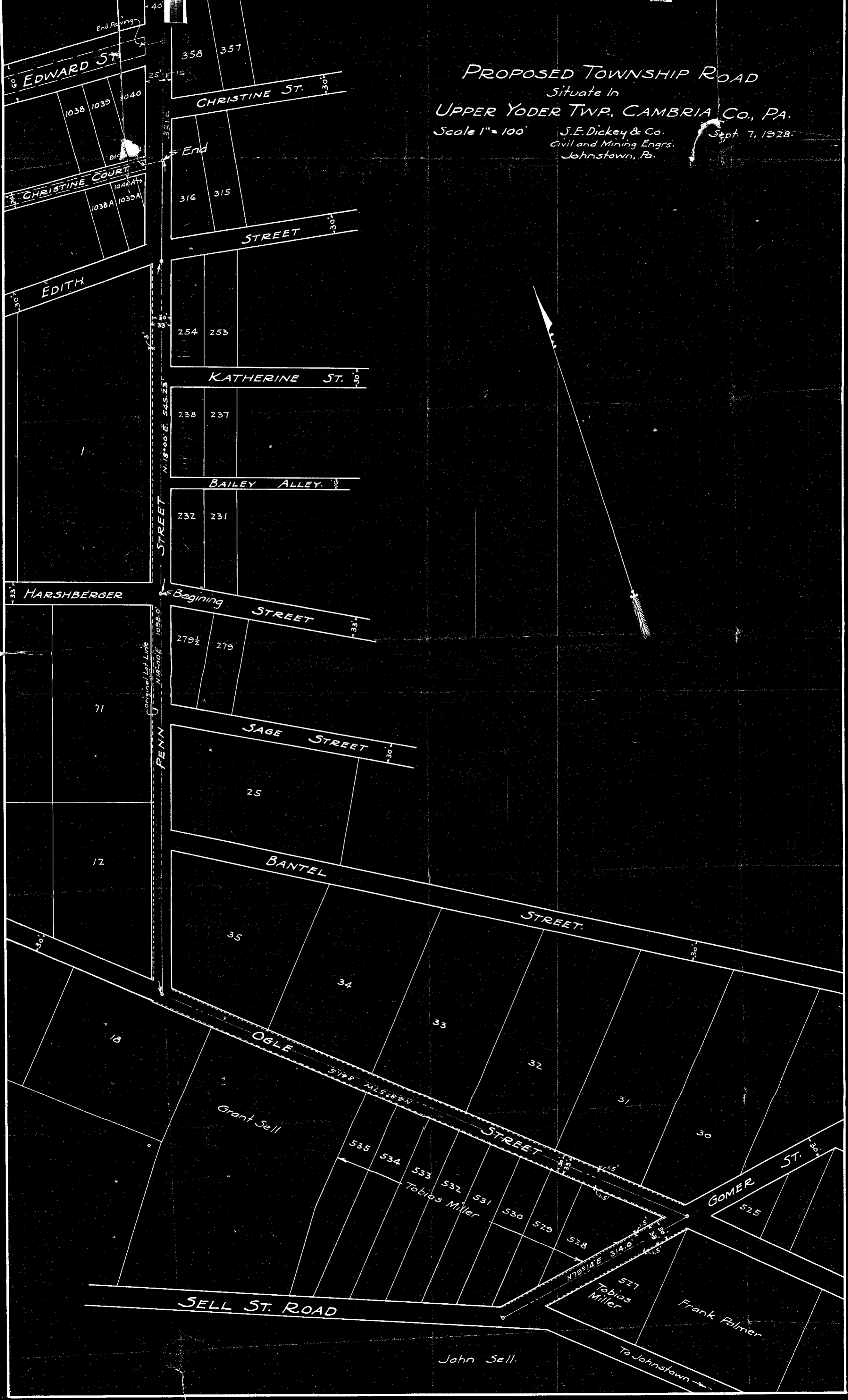
