

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned viewers appointed by the said Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine the damages, if any, which have resulted or which seem likely to result to Margaret A. Conrad by reason of the laying out, opening, widening, re-locating, changing and widening of the right-of-way of a certain piece of public road - known as State Highway Route No. 11038 - through and over her premises or farm situate in Allegheny Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, - adjoining lands formerly of Simon Vaught, D. A. McGough, A. E. Farbaugh, Valentine Bishop, George F. Biller, John Boes, F. H. Itell and Mary Fury, containing 166 acres and 17 perches, respectfully report:

That having given due and legal notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Attorney for the petitioner; who has accepted service of a notice hereto attached; and having served a like notice upon the Commissioners of Cambria County, and having posted notices upon the premises as required by the Act of the General Assembly and the rules of Court of this county, and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and according to the best of our judgment and ability; two of us, viz: A. M. Shoemaker and James McCann - P. M. Kinney not appearing - met upon the premises in accord with the notices as served and posted as aforesaid, together with the Clerk for the said Commissioners of Cambria County and having gone over and carefully viewed the said premises, noting the advantages and disadvantages and offsetting the one against the other and carefully considering whatever matters, bearing upon the subject of our inquiry, which were brought to our attention or which we could observe relative thereto, and having estimated and determined that the said Margaret A. Conrad has sustained damages, in excess of benefits, by reason of the changing, widening, re-locating,

laying out and opening of said portion of said Highway Route No. 11038, which passes through and over her premises, in the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five (\$175.00) Dollars, which amount should be paid to her by the County of Cambria, Pa., and unless exceptions to this report shall be filed or an appeal taken within thirty days from the date of filing the same it shall be confirmed absolutely.

The petition of Margaret A. Conrad of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, respectfully represents.

FIRST: Your petitioner is a citizen and resident of Allegheny County and her present address is 6102 Walnut Street, Pittsburgh.

SECOND: Your petitioner is the owner of a certain farm situate in Allegheny Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania adjoining lands formerly of Simon Vaught, D. A. McGough, A. E. Farabaugh, Valentine Bishop, George F. Biller, John Boes, F. H. IteI, and Mary Fury, containing 166 acres 17 perches, which your petitioner obtained from Englebert Conrad by deed dated December 28, 1922 and recorded in Cambria County Deed Book, Vol. 357, Page 293.

THIRD: That the Secretary of Highways has caused to be widened and re-located a certain highway in Allegheny Township, Cambria County, known as Route 11038 over and through the lands of your petitioner. That the County Commissioners of Cambria County have consented and approved of the width and location and re-location or change of said highway through the lands of your petitioner, and are liable for any damages sustained by the petitioner by reason of the change of the said width, location and re-location of the said road.

Your petitioner is entitled to damages under and in pursuance of the provisions of an act of assembly approved May 31, 1911 P.L. 468 as amended by the act of April 13, 1933 P.L. 41 for the change of width, location, and the re-location of said highway No. 11038 over the land of your petitioner. A detailed description of the construction, reconstruction and change of width of said road is on file in the office of the Secretary of Highways from which a detailed description may be obtained.

Your petitioner, therefore, prays your Honorable Court to appoint three viewers from among the Board of Viewers of this County, one of whom shall be learned of the law, to assess the damages occasioned to your petitioner as above set forth, in pursuance of the rules adopted for said Board, and make report to the next term of your Court.


DECREE
