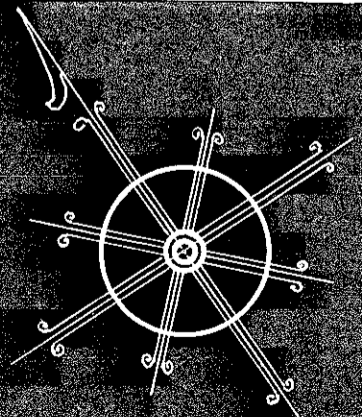

PETITION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF DONOHUE STREETS AND

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The Petition of the Board of Supervisors of Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That upon the Petition of the residents and owners of lots abutting on Donohue Street and Roberts Avenue, dedicated streets in Adams Township, your Petitioners accepted portions of said Donohue Street and Roberts Avenue, more particularly described in the annexed Resolution, subject to the consent of your Honorable Court; as more fully appears by Resolution of your Petitioners, hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT A",

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that your Honorable Court consent to the acceptance of the portions of said Street and Avenue, more particularly described in said Resolution, as public highways of the said Township of Adams.

"EXHIBIT A"

RESOLUTION

Accepting portions of Donohue Street and Roberts Avenue, dedicated Streets in the Township of Adams, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as Public Highways,

WHEREAS, the Plan of Lots in Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania known as "Dunlo" contains a plan of dedicated roads, streets, lanes and alleys, which Plan was adopted, approved, and recorded prior to May 1, 1933 in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Miscellaneous Record Book Vol. 6 Page 23, a print of said Plan being hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT B"; and

WHEREAS, such roads, streets, lanes and alleys as shown on said plan are designated to public use; and

WHEREAS, the said roads and streets are not less than thirty-three feet in width and the said lanes and alleys are not less than fifteen feet in width; and

WHEREAS, the residents and owners of lots abutting on the portions of said Street and Avenue, more particularly described below, have petitioned the Supervisors of Adams Township, requesting that the hereinafter described portions of said Street and Avenue be accepted as public highways, and releasing the said Township from any damages that may result by reason of said acceptance and the opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining of the same, said petition and release being hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT C".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same that Donohue Street on said Plan, a dedicated highway fifty feet in width, beginning at its intersection with Pitcairn Avenue and extending to its intersection with Roberts Avenue, a dedicated highway fifty

feet in width beginning with its intersection with Donahue Street and extending to its intersection with Huff Street, a public highway of the Township of Adams, subject to the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a petition be presented and filed with said Court of Quarter Sessions, praying that the above described portions of Donohue Street and Roberts Avenue be accepted as public highways of the Township of Adams in accordance with the Act of 1935 P.L.1299 Section 2, adding Section 1147 to the Act of 1933 P.L.103,

I hereby certify and attest the above to be a true and correct copy of a Resolution unanimously adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, at a meeting regularly called and held as fully and the same as duly recorded and entered upon the minutes of the said Board of Supervisors, all on the Second day of December, 1937.



PETITION AND RELEASE OF DAMAGES IN RE:
THE OPENING AND GRADING AND MAINTAINING OF
CERTAIN DEDICATED HIGHWAYS IN ADAMS
TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

We, the undersigned, respectfully represent:

That we are residents or owners of lots abutting on Donohue Street from its intersection with Pitcairn Avenue to its intersection with Roberts Avenue and on Roberts Avenue from its intersection with Donohue Street to its intersection with Huff Street in the Village of Dunlo, Township of Adams, Cambria County, Pennsylvania,

That we are very much inconvenienced on account of improper highway facilities to travel to and from our properties,

THEREFORE, we respectfully petition the Board of Supervisors of Adams Township to enact a proper Resolution accepting the above described dedicated highways as public highways of the Township of Adams and to grade, drain, and improve the same,

IN CONSIDERATION of the accepting, opening, grading, draining and improving and maintaining of said dedicated highways above referred to, we, the undersigned owners of the properties abutting thereon, do hereby release the said Township of Adams from any damages we have sustained or may sustain by reason of the said accepting, opening, grading, draining, improving and maintaining of said highways.

DECREE

And now, December 7th, 1937, the within Petition having been duly presented, read and considered, the Court hereby give its consent to the acceptance of Donahue Street from its intersection with Pitcairn Avenue to its intersection with Roberts Avenue, and Roberts Avenue from its intersection with Donahue Street to its intersection with Huff Street in the Village of Dunlo, Adams Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown on the Plan of Dunlo, recorded in Miscellaneous Record Book Vol. 6 Page 23, as public highways by the Supervisors of the Township of Adams; and it is further ordered and decreed that Donahue Street from its intersection with Pitcairn Avenue to its intersection with Roberts Avenue, and Roberts Avenue from its intersection with Donahue Street to its intersection with Huff Street shall forthwith be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of Adams, Cambria County, Pennsylvania; and it is further ordered and decreed that this proceeding be recorded in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
