PETITION OF SUPERVISORS TO ACCEPT STREET

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The Petition of Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and Mickey
Sibert, respectfully represents:

1. That your petitioners are the duly elected, qualified,
and acting Supervisors of Summerhill Township, a Township of the
second class of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

2. That on March 24, 1920, the Beaver Run Land Company
laid out a Plan of Lots on certain of its property located in the
Township of Summerhill, aforesaid, described as a Plan of Beaver-
dale and vicinity, and on March 2, 1921, said Plan having been
adopted, approved and acknowledged, caused said Plan to be
recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, aforesaid,
in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 217.

3. That Cedar Street, among other Streets, appears upon
said dedicated Plan, having a width of approximately fifty (50)
feet.

4. That Cedar Street is located in a built up section
of Beaverdale, but the part of said Street more particularly
referred to hereafter has never been accepted by the Township as
a public highway, although one of the churches of Beaverdale is
located along said unaccepted part thereof.

5. That your petitioners feel that that part of Cedar
Street lying between the northern line of Margaret Street and
the southerly line of what is known as the " Brick Road ", being
the " Brick Road " leading to Stewart Street on said Plan,
said " brick Road " being the Road leading from Wilmore to
Beaverdale, should be accepted by the Township of Summerhill as
a public highway, and they have, accordingly, by a resolution
of the Board, duly adopted by unanimous vote at a meeting of the
Board held on February 23, 1938, accepted same as such,
as appears by a copy of said resolution, duly certified, attached
hereto, and forming a part of this petition as Exhibit " A. "

6. That the part of Cedar Street which your petitioners
desire to accept as a public highway consists of one block
of a length of 150.00 feet, and has a width of fifty (50)
feet.

7. That your petitioners are advised that before said Street can be legally accepted as a public highway they must have the approval of your Honorable Court.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that an order and decree be made approving and assenting to the acceptance of that part of Cedar Street, above described, as a public highway of the Township of Summerhill.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Beaver Run Land Company laid out a Plan of Lots on March 24, 1920, on certain of its lands in Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, describing it as a Plan of Beaverdale and vicinity, and, on March 2, 1921, dedicated the lots, streets, lanes and alleys, appearing on said Plan, to public use by recording the same in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, aforesaid, in Plat Book, Vol. 1 at page 217; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Supervisors of Summerhill Township, that part of Cedar Street, appearing on said Plan, lying between the northern line of Margaret Street and the southerly line of what is popularly known as the "Brick Road", being the road leading from Wilmore to Beaverdale, aforesaid, being the southerly line of said "Brick Road", leading to Stewart Street, appearing on said Plan, consisting of one block of said Cedar Street of a length of ~~278~~.60 feet, with a width of fifty (50) feet, should be accepted as a public highway of Summerhill Township;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by Roy H. Plummer, Frank Frank and Mickey Sibert, Supervisors and corporate authority of the Township of Summerhill, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, that the part or portion of Cedar Street, described as above, be accepted as a public highway of the Township of Summerhill, aforesaid, such acceptance, however, being made subject to its approval by the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, afore-mentioned.

The above resolution moved by Roy H. Plummer seconded by Frank Frank, and unanimously adopted by the Supervisors of Summerhill Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, on 23rd Day, February 1938 A.D., 1938.
