

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNA.

IN RE: The Proceedings to Take Over Certain Roads and Streets, Heretofore Dedicated as Public Roads in the Town of Dysart, Township of Dean, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania.

TO: THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of ELMER E. CROSSMAN, JAMES CUOMO and ROGER CAVALET, Supervisors of Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represent:

1. That your petitioners are the duly elected and qualified and acting Supervisors of Dean Township, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania.

2. That the plans of certain dedicated roads, streets and thoroughfares located in the Town of Dysart, Township of Dean and County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, have been adopted, approved and recorded in Plat Book Vol. 5, Page 12, records of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, effective the 29th day of August, 1951.

3. That all of the improved land abutting said roads, streets and thoroughfares have been conveyed to individual owners, and that they are in possession of the persons indicated on the map attached hereto and made a part hereof.

4. That your petitioners have been requested by many of the individual owners to take over said thoroughfares, so that they would become subject of maintenance and repair by the Township of Dean.

5. That your petitioners consider it to be the duty and obligation of the Township of Dean to comply with said request, and have so indicated by attaching a Resolution setting forth their intention to take over said public thoroughfares, subject, however, to the approval of your Honorable Court.

6. That there is attached hereto and made a part of this petition a description of said roads, and streets, a copy of said Resolution, and a Copy of the Map of

RESOLUTION

ON MOTION OF ELMER P. CROSSMAN, duly seconded by JAMES CUOMO, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, certain streets, roads and thoroughfares in the Town of Dysart, County of Cambria and the Township of Dean, have heretofore been dedicated as public roads, streets and thoroughfares, and

WHEREAS, the lands abutting said roads, streets and thoroughfares are owned and possessed by individuals in the Town of Dysart, Township of Dean and County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, many of the individual owners of said lands, have urgently requested the Township Supervisors of the Township of Dean, through its duly constituted board, to take over said roads, streets and thoroughfares, so that they may be subject to maintenance and repair by the said Township, acting through its duly constituted Board of Township Supervisors, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Dean consider it to be the obligation of the Township to comply with the request aforesaid of the abutting owners, and

WHEREAS, plans of the dedicated streets, roads and thoroughfares have been adopted, approved and recorded in Plat Book Vol. 5, Page 12, records of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, under date of August 29, 1951

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that with the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, the Supervisors of the Township of Dean, on behalf of the Township of Dean, hereby accept the streets, roads and thoroughfares, as

marked and outlines in red on the map hereto attached and made a part hereof, as all and part of the public highways of the Township aforesaid.

Said Roads are described as follows:

No. 1: ALL that section of Front Street situated in the village of Dysart, Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, starting at a survey stake on the South bank of Lost Creek and running north a distance 750' to the north corner of lot of Veto Balzano, known on Survey plan as Front Street, be taken over as Township Road and to be maintained by the Supervisors of Dean Township.

No. 2: ALL the section of street situated in the village of Dysart, Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, starting at a point on the North side of McMullen Street and running North a distance of 300' to the property line on South corner of land of James Munson and known on survey map of Dysart as Second Street, be taken over as Township Road and maintained by the Supervisors of Dean Township.

No. 3: ALL the section of street starting at a Survey stake on the Southwest corner of the Dysart survey plan and running to the north, a distance of 500' to a white oak tree in the center of the street and the property line of James Munson and known on Dysart Survey Plan as Third Street, be taken over as township road and maintained by the Township Supervisors.

No. 4: ALL that section of McMullen Street starting at Third Street and running west a distance of 100' to intersection of State Highway Route 53 and known as McMullen Street on Dysart Survey plan be taken over as township road and maintained by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Dean, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania.

ALL of the aforesaid streets as taken over by the Township shall be 33 ft. in width and shall be according to the plan of Dysart as recorded in Platt Book Vol. 5, Page 12, records of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

DESCRIPTION OF ROADS TO BE TAKEN OVER BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF DEAN

No. 1: ALL that section of Front Street situated in the village of Dysart, Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania starting at a survey stake on the South bank of Lost Creek and running north a distance of 750' to the north corner of lot of Veto Balzano, known on Survey plan as Front Street, be taken over as Township Road and to be maintained by the supervisors of Dean Township.

NO. 2: ALL the section of street situated in the village of Dysart, Dean Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, starting at a point on the North side of McMullen Street and running North a distance of 300' to the property line on South corner of land of James Munson and known on survey map of Dysart as Second Street, be taken over as Township Road and maintained by the Supervisors of Dean Township.

No. 3: ALL the section of street starting at a Survey stake on the Southwest corner of the Dysart survey plan and running to the north, a distance of 500' to a white oak tree in the center of the street and the property line of James Munson and known on Dysart Survey Plan as Third Street, be taken over as township road and maintained by the Township Supervisors.

No. 4: ALL that section of McMullen Street starting at Third Street and running west a distance of 100' to intersection of State Highway Route 53 and known as McMullen Street on Dysart Survey plan be taken over as Township Supervisors of the Township of Dean, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania.

ALL of the aforesaid streets as taken over by the Township shall be 33' in width and shall be according to the plan of Dysart as recorded in Platt Book Vol. 5, Page 12, records of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
