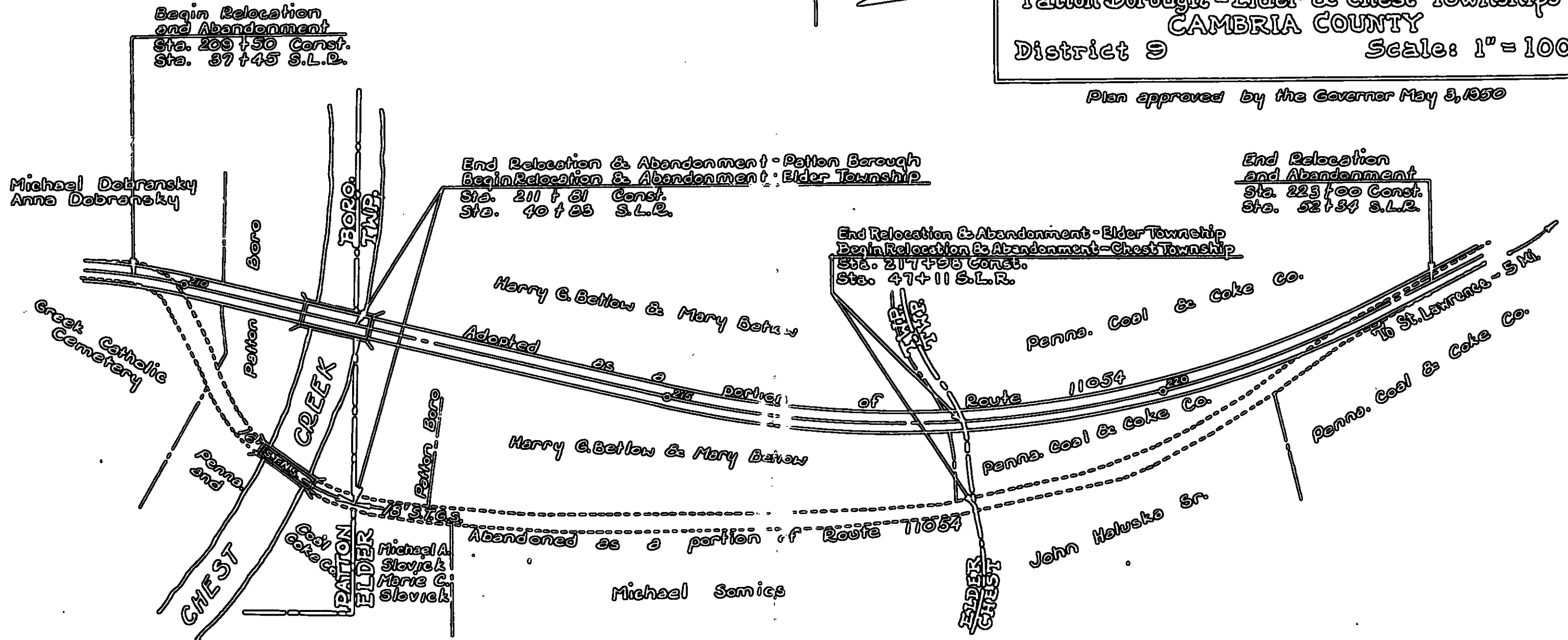

In accordance with the provisions of Article XI of the Act of May 24, 1951, P. L. 370, s 13, et seq., as amended, 53 P. S. 19093 - 1101 et seq., Bernard Thomas, Michael Novak and Jerome Holtz, Supervisors of the Township of Elder, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, hereby make the following report:

That Michael Novak and Jerome Holtz are duly elected, qualified and active supervisors of the said Township of Elder, and that Bernard Thomas is a duly appointed, qualified and active supervisor, having been appointed March 3, 1953 to fulfill the unexpired term of Charles Thomas, deceased.

That Route 11054, in said Township, commences at the Patton Borough-Elder Township line at State Highway Station 40 + 83 and extends for 0.1189 miles to the Elder Township-Chest Township line at State Highway Station 47 + 11. That it is desired to vacate said road because of public convenience. That a copy of a survey of the said road is hereby attached marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof.

That the owners of real estate affected by the abandonment and vacating of said Route 11054 are listed as follows: Harry G. Betlow, Mary Betlow, Michael A. Slovick, Marie C. Slovick, Michael J. Somics Estate, Helen M. Peterson, Adm^r.

That the above named persons were each served on the 14th day of March, 1953, with written notice to the effect that the Supervisors of said Township of Elder, would hold a meeting on the 24th day of March, 1953 at 7:00 o'clock P. M. at St. Boniface School Building at St. Boniface, Pennsylvania, to consider the matter of vacating the said Route 11054. The Notices together with the several Acceptances of Service are hereto attached marked Exhibits B, C, D, E and F, and made a part hereof.

That the Township of Elder was released and forever discharged from any and all claims to damages caused by said vacation of a portion of Route 11054 as is shown by the written release of damages sealed and filed by the aforesaid owners of the real estate. ORDINANCE NO. 2.

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A ROAD KNOWN AS STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 11054, LEADING FROM PATTON BOROUGH FOR A DISTANCE OF 0.1189 MILES TO THE ELDER TOWNSHIP-CHEST TOWNSHIP LINE.

WHEREAS, State Highway Route 11054 is a part of the road system of Elder Township and leads from Patton Borough for a distance of 0.1189 miles to the Elder Township-Chest Township Line.

WHEREAS Route No. 11054 was abandoned by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as part of the State Highway System because of relocation and construction of a new portion of said State Highway Route No. 11054 by the Department of Highways and is not necessary or needed as a township road, and, in the interest of public convenience, the said supervisors have decided to vacate, by ordinance, the said Route 11054 herein described.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of Elder Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION. 1

THAT in the judgment of the Supervisors, for and in the interest of public convenience, the following described road be and the same is hereby vacated:

BEGINNING at State Highway Station 40 + 83 on State Highway Route No. 11054 at the line of the Patton Borough in the Township of Elder; thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route No. 11054, a distance of 628 feet or 0.1189 miles to the line of Elder Township-Chest Township at Station 47 + 11.

SECTION 2.

THAT the Township Solicitor be and hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Clerk of

Courts of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, State of Pennsylvania, together with the name of the owners of property affected, a draft and survey of the road vacated, and a report of the proceedings relating to the vacation of the road hereinabove described.

SECTION 3.

ALL ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
