PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, set forth the following facts:

-1-

That at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll held on the 25th day of July, 1953, a Resolution was adopted by said Board adopting and taking over certain section of roadway in the Village of St. Benedict, Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, a certified copy of which Resolution is attached hereto marked Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof.

That the section of roadway in the Village of St. Benedict, hereinafter described, has been dedicated to public use in the conveyance of the Carrolltown Coal Company to T. F. Dougherty dated June 27, 1945 and recorded in the office of the recorder of deeds in and for Cambria County on July 3, 1946, in Deed Book Vol. 536 at page 665, being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Dunsmore Avenue opposite the Presbyterian Church at the intersection of Dunsmore Avenue with a certain township road, thence by Dunsmore Avenue a width of thirty-three (33) feet to a point immediately beyond Lot No. 15 on the plan of lots for the village of St. Benedict.

A survey showing the above described section of road is attached hereto marked Exhibit "2" and made a part hereof.

That the section of roadway to be adopted and taken over by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township is fully described in the above mentioned Resolution adopted by said Supervisors on the 25th day of July, 1953.

WHEREFORE, the petitioners pray your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over and adopting of the said roadway as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18, A. D., 1935, P. L. 1299 as amended, (Section 17, Act of July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481), in order that such roadway shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of West Carroll.

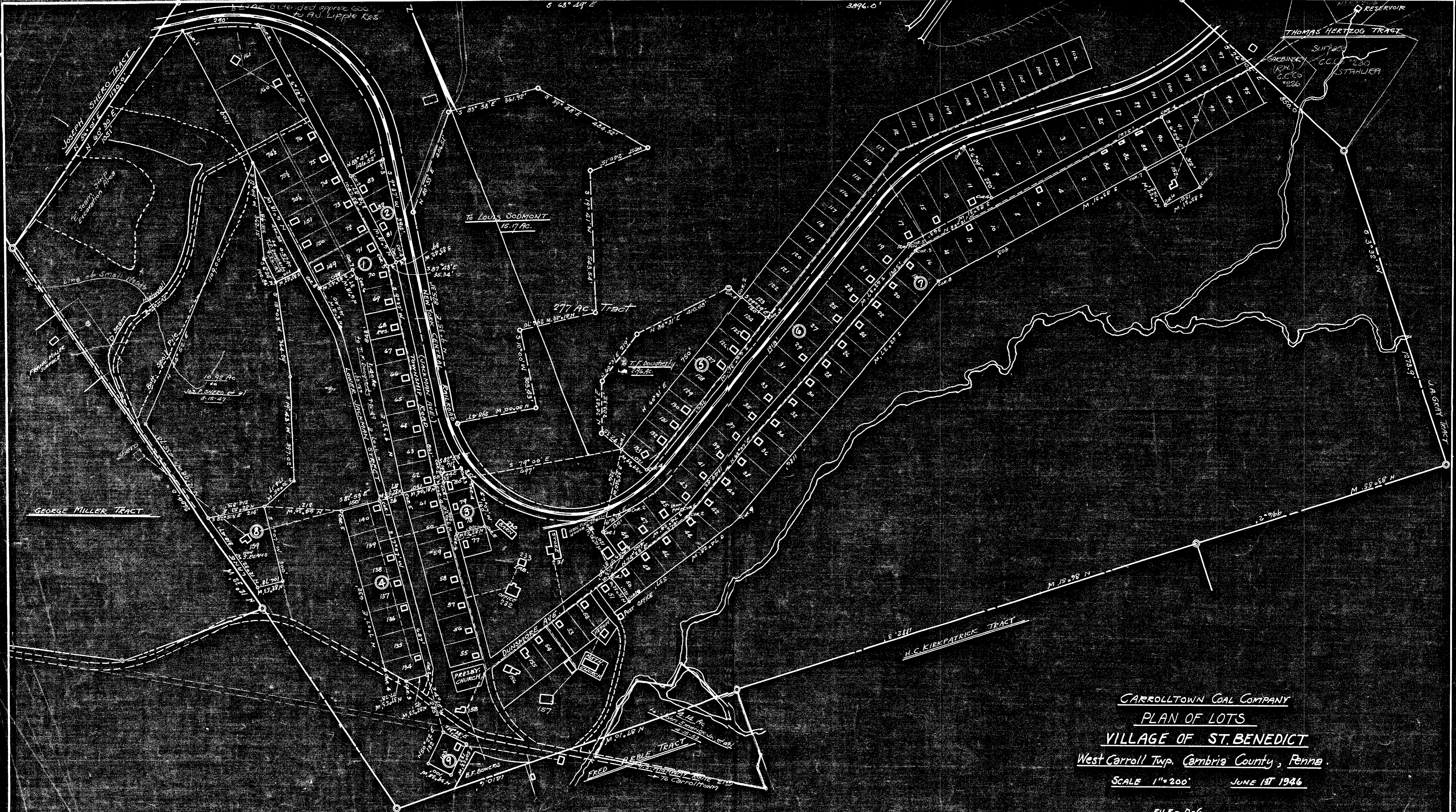
