

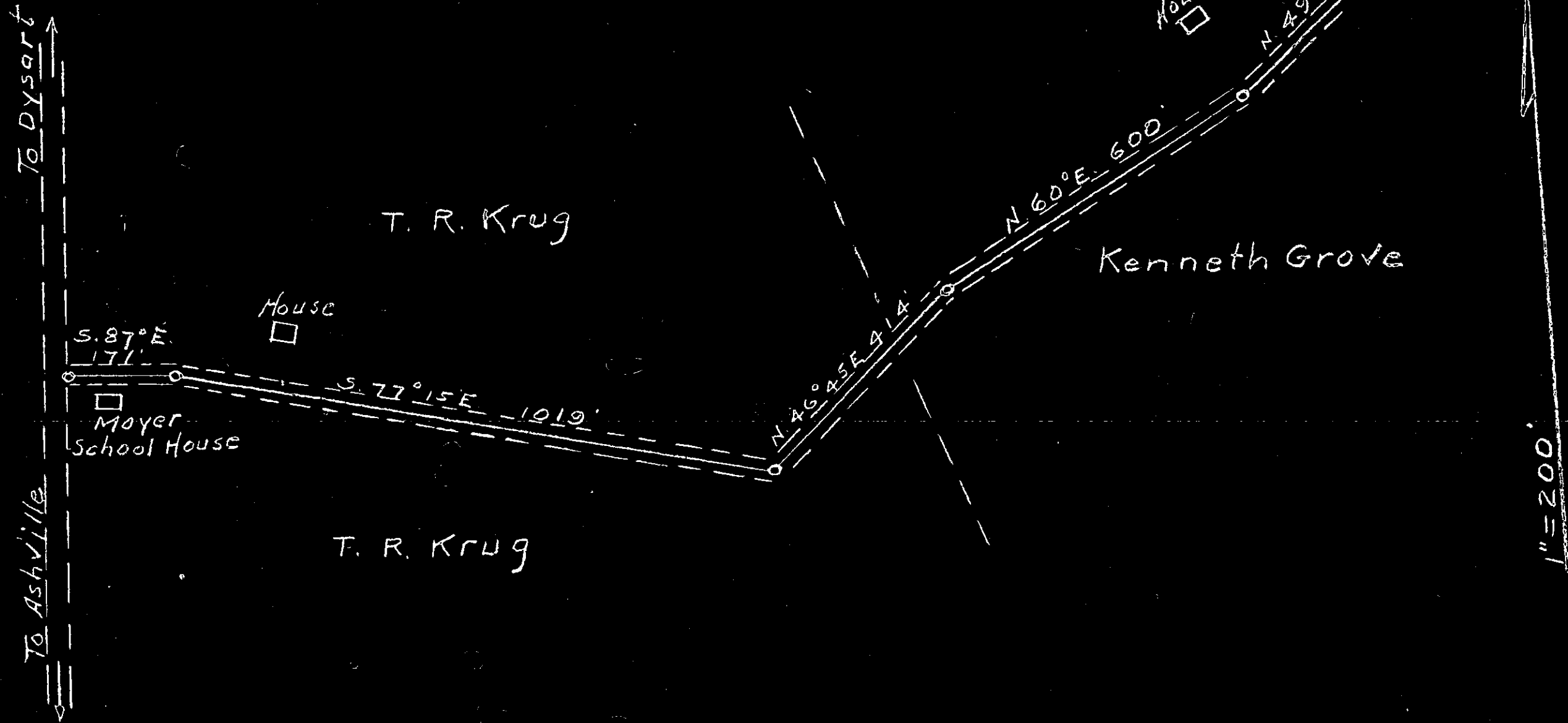

REPORT OF THE SUPERVISORS OF CLEARFIELD TOWNSHIP

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT, AND TO ALL OTHER PERSONS  
CONCERNED:

M. A. McNULTY, JOSEPH SHEEHAN and JOSEPH MARRA respectfully reports:

1. That they are the road Supervisors of the Township of Clearfield,  
County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania.

2. That they propose to lay-out, open and accept a public road  
lying wholly within the Township of Clearfield, County of Cambria and State  
of Pennsylvania more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Legislative Rt. <sup>11040</sup> leading from  
Ashville to Dysart near the Moyer School House; thence  
through the property of T. R. Krug South 87° East 171 feet  
to a point; thence again through the property of T. R. Krug  
South 77° 15' East 1019 feet to a point; thence again through  
the property of T. R. Krug and the property of Kenneth Grove  
North 46° 45' East 414 feet; thence through the property of  
Kenneth Grove the following two courses and distances, North  
60° East 600 feet to a point, North 49° East 436 feet to the  
terminal point. Being 33 feet in width and approximately  
2640 feet in length as shown on the survey of John L. Elder,  
Registered Engineer, dated the 24th day of July, 1954, which  
is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit A.

3. That pursuant to a petition of all the abutting property owners  
on the proposed road as hereinbefore described, which petition is hereto  
attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit B, the Supervisors of Clear-  
field Township, at a regular meeting held the 6th day of August, 1954, upon  
hearing, decided in favor of ordaining the laying-out, opening and accepting  
of the above described road as a public road in the Township of Clearfield,  
which Ordinance is hereto attached, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit C.

4. That the aforesaid petitioners have waived all rights to damages  
and the right of any notice of the time and place of hearing in the matter of  
laying-out, opening and accepting said road.

5. That the Supervisors of Clearfield Township believe that the laying-out, opening and accepting of said road is necessary for the public convenience.

6. That this report and survey attached hereto is made and filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions pursuant to the Act of Assembly approved the 1st day of May, 1933, P.L. 193, as amended.

PETITION FOR OPENING OF TOWNSHIP ROAD

TO THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, CLEARFIELD TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

Your petitioners respectfully represents:

1. That your petitioners are residents of Clearfield Township and all the property owners abutting a certain dirt road beginning at a point on Legislative Route 11040 in the Township of Clearfield, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania where said route passes property of the Clearfield Township School "known as Moyer School" and extending in an Easterly direction approximately one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) mile to the property of Kenneth Grove.
2. That your petitioners have for many years been using said dirt road to gain access to their respective properties.
3. That your petitioners request the Supervisors of Clearfield Township to open said road under the procedure as outlined in the Township Code.
4. That it is necessary for the public convenience of the residents of Clearfield Township that such road be opened.
5. That your petitioners do hereby release Clearfield Township from all damages do to such opening.
6. That your petitioners hereby waive all rights to any notice of the time and place of hearing in the matter of ordaining and opening and accepting said road.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully request that the Supervisors of Clearfield Township open the above described road according to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable thereto and more particularly Section 1101, Article 11, Act of Assembly of May 1, 1931, P.L. 101, as amended.

PETITION for OPENING OF TOWNSHIP ROAD
ROBERT J. CASSIDY ATTORNEY AT LAW 304 MASONIC BUILDING EBENSBURG, PA.

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, KENNETH L. GROVE, T. R. KRUG, CHARLES E. KRUG, MARIE E. GROVE, and CATHRYN KRUG, have petitioned the Supervisors of Clearfield Township to open, lay-out and accept the hereinafter described road, and

WHEREAS, said petitioners have signed a release of damages and a waiver of all rights to any notice of the time and place of hearing in the matter of ordaining, opening and accepting said road, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Clearfield Township are of the opinion that the opening, laying-out and accepting of said road is necessary for the public convenience, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township Supervisors to hereby open, lay-out and accept the hereinafter described road in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania applicable thereto, more particularly the Act of 1933, May 1, P.L. 103, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Supervisors of Clearfield Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, that:

SECTION 1: Be it ordained by the Supervisors of Clearfield Township, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage of this Ordinance that the following public road lying wholly within the Township of Clearfield, County of Cambria, State of Pennsylvania, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Township Road leading from Ashville to Dysart near the Moyer School House; thence through the property of T. R. Krug South  $87^{\circ}$  East 171 feet to a point; thence again through the property of T. R. Krug South  $77^{\circ} 15'$  East 1019 feet to a point; thence again through the property of T. R. Krug and the property of Kenneth Grove North  $46^{\circ} 45'$  East 414 feet; thence through the property of Kenneth Grove the following two courses and distances, North  $60^{\circ}$  East 600 feet to a point, North  $49^{\circ}$  East 436 feet to the terminal point. Being 33 feet in width and approximately 2640 feet in length as shown on the survey of John L. Elder, Registered Engineer, dated the 24th day of July, 1954.

be opened, laid-out and accepted as a public road of the Township of Clearfield, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2: That the Secretary of the Board of Supervisors of Clearfield Township shall give public notice of the passage of the within Ordinance by posting handbills in conspicuous places along the line of said road within ten (10) days after the passage of said Ordinance. Said notice shall contain the date of the passage of the Ordinance, the signers of the petition asking for said passage of the Ordinance, and the fact that the petition contained a release of damages in favor of the said Township of Clearfield, and that any person interested may, within thirty (30) days after the filing of the report of the Supervisors, upon entering in Court sufficient surety to indemnify them for all costs incurred in the proceedings, file exceptions to the report together with a petition for a review.

SECTION 3: Any Ordinance or Resolution, or part of any Ordinance or Resolution, conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
