REPORT OF SUPERVISORS OF BLACKLICK TOWNSHIP

In accordance with provisions of Article XI of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, as amended, 53 P. S. 19093-1101 et seq., Stanley Stupsky, Lloyd McDonald and Frank Sabonya hereby make the following report:

-1-

That they are the duly elected and qualified Supervisors of Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

-2-

That pursuant to a petition of interested citizens they propose to lay out a portion of road in the Village of Nettleton, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, which portion of road is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Township Road No. Th55 leading from the Village of Nettleton, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to the Village of Twin Rocks, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said point of beginning being 0.5 of a mile, Westwardly, from the intersection of said Township Road No. Th55 with Legislative Route 11032; thence extending from said point of beginning North 80° 05' East a distance of 810 feet to a point of ending at land of John Semetosky, Jr., and Delores Semetosky, his wife, and Imperial Cardiff Coal Company, containing in length 810 feet and the width is fixed at 33 feet. A print of a survey of the road is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

That the property owners affected by the proposed laying out of said portion of road were given ten (10) days written notice of a meeting of said Supervisors held on December 6, 1956, at 7:00 P. M., at their office located in Dugan's Hotel, Twin Rocks, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of taking action regarding the laying out of said portion of road.

Copies of said notices with acceptance of service by each of the affected property owners are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That after a hearing at the aforesaid meeting, said Supervisors deemed the laying out of the aforesaid portion of road necessary and adopted an Ordinance laying out the same as a part of the highway system of said township. A certified copy of said Ordinance is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof.

That the aforesaid petition of interested citizens and release of damages executed by the owners of the property abutting on said portion of road is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "C" and made a part hereof.

-6-

That a release of damages executed by Imperial Cardiff Coal Corporation, an affected property owner, is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "D" and made a part hereof.

-7-

That the aforesaid Ordinance was published prior to its passage in the Johnstown Tribune Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the Act of Assembly. Proof of publication of the same is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "E" and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, the aforesaid Supervisors pray that this Report and exhibits attached hereto be filed in the office of the Clerk of Courts of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

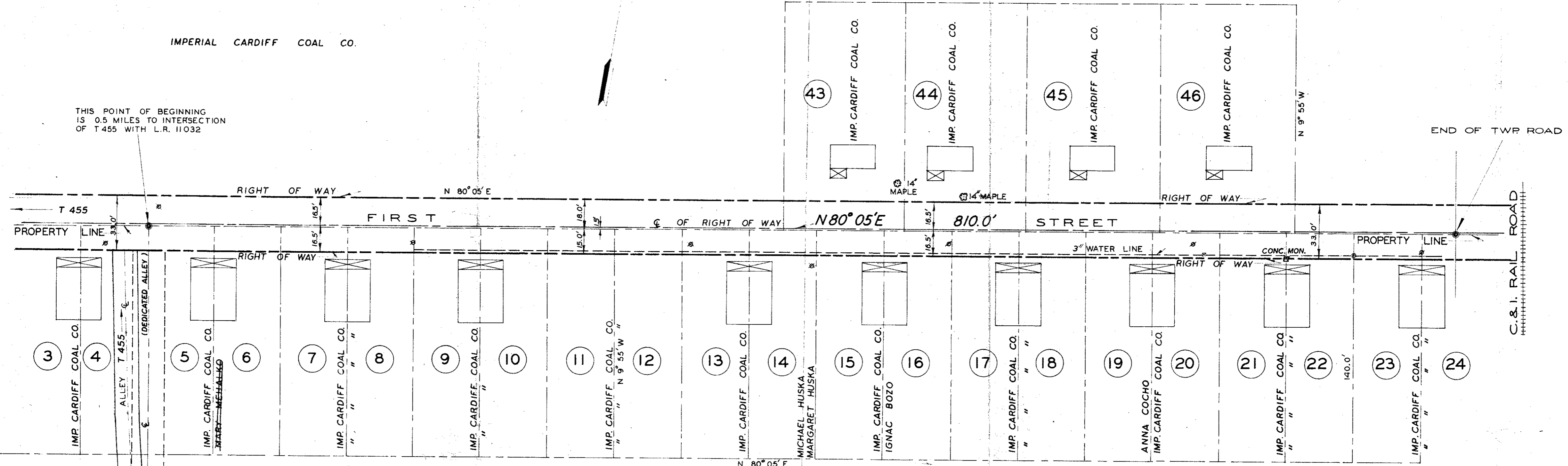

WHEREAS, interested citizens of Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, have petitioned the Blacklick Township Supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out, by ordinance, a section of road herein described; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have decided, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out said section of road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Blacklick Township and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the petition aforesaid, the following described road be and the same is hereby laid out:

Beginning at a point on Township Road No. Th55 leading from the Village of Nettleton, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to the Village of Twin Rocks, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, said point of beginning being 0.5 of a mile, Westwardly, from the intersection of said Township Road No. Th55 with Legislative Route 11032; thence extending from said point of beginning North 80° 05' East a distance of 810 feet to a point of ending at land of John Semetosky, Jr., and Delores Semetosky, his wife, and Imperial Cardiff Coal Company, containing in length 810 feet and the width is fixed at 33 feet. A print of a survey of the road hereby laid out is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Township solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, together with a draft and survey of the road.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

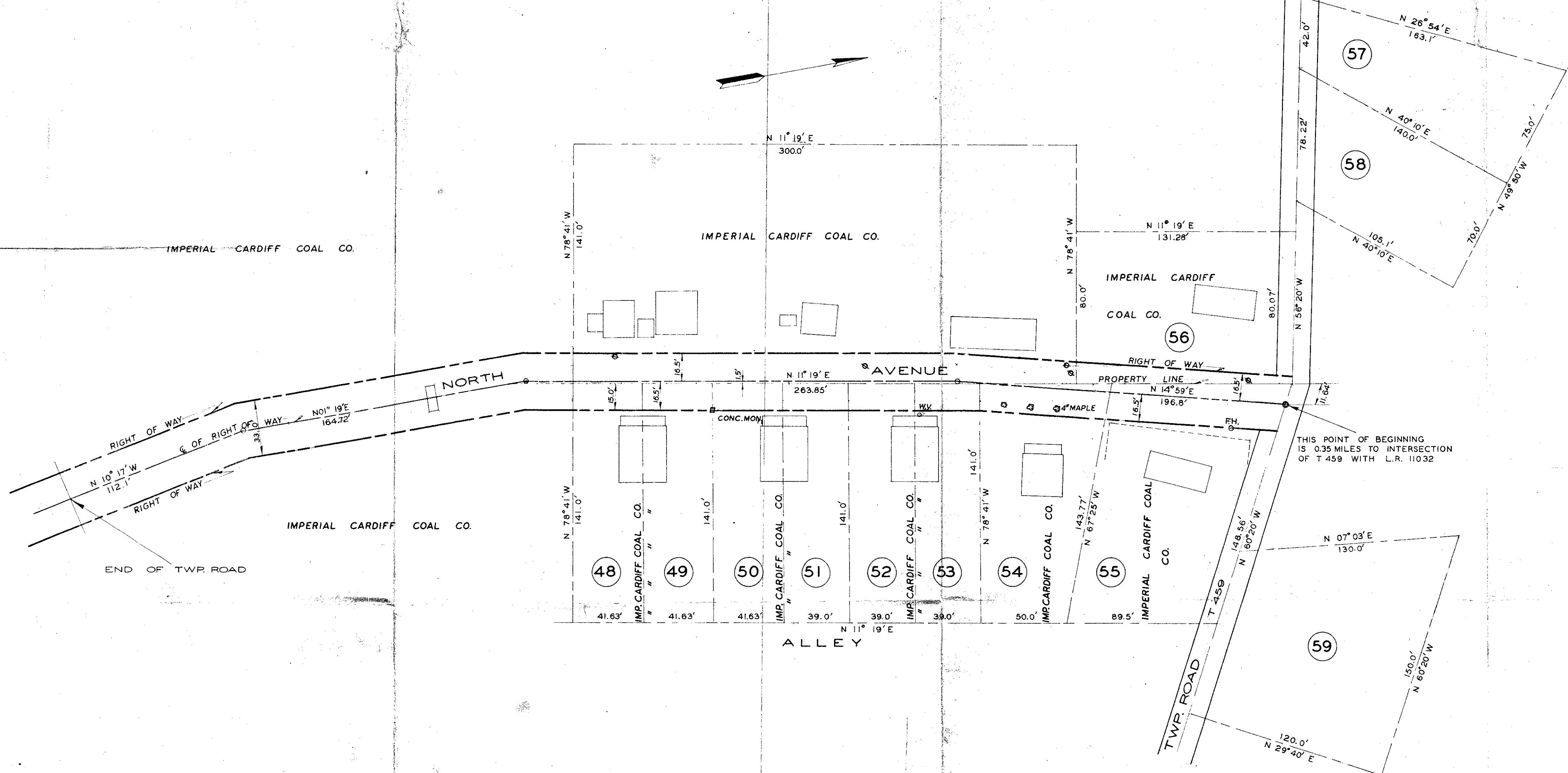
